## Hon'ble Lt. Governor calls on Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Apprised Hon'ble Prime Minister of recent award of several PPP-mode contracts in five-star luxury eco-tourism hotel segment and also proposed long-term measures for water security

New Delhi, Mar. 20

Admiral D. K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency, called on Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi, today.

During the call, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor apprised the Hon'ble Prime Minister of the recent award of several PPP-mode contracts in the five-star luxury eco-tourism hotel segment. These projects, structured with percentage revenue sharing and annually escalating lease fees, are designed as net revenue-generating models for the A&N Administration.

The Hon'ble Lt. Governor also proposed long-term measures for water security, noting that with the increasing population and the operationalisation of mega infrastructure projects, the number of consumers is expected to rise significantly in the coming years.

Further with around 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the country's EEZ and 1/4<sup>th</sup> Coastline, A&N Islands is potentially a major contributor in Blue Economy and proposals for progressing studies particularly for sea bed minerals were also advanced.

To handle increasing number of tourist arrivals, additional Green Field Airports at the selected sites, consideration for Small Modular Reactors for scalable power generation on selected Islands locations and positioning A&N Islands as a ship repair and construction hub in IOR were also proposed, a press release from Lok Niwas said.

## Hon'ble Lt. Governor attends Power Minister's Roundtable chaired by Hon'ble Minister of Power, Housing and Urban Affairs

New Delhi, Mar. 20

Admiral D. K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency, attended the Power Minister's Roundtable chaired by Hon'ble Minister of Power, Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Manohar Lal Khattar, at the Bharat Electricity Summit 2026 today.

In his intervention, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands strongly recommended the consideration of Small Modular Reactors (SMRs) for selected island locations in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. He noted that with mega infrastructure projects such as the International Container Transshipment Terminal and new greenfield airports soon to be commissioned, peak power demand is expected to increase several times compared to current requirements.

Highlighting that many countries located in Seismic Zone-V are successfully operating similar power plants, including offshore barge-mounted floating nuclear plants, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor underscored the advantages of rapid scalability, along with the additional benefit of freshwater generation from cooling plants. He also emphasised the need for early resolution of power privatization



issues, which will be a primary consideration for unfolding power matrix roadmap of A&N Islands, a press release from Lok Niwas said.

➤ Aadhaar Usage Highlights by Shri Vivek Chandra Verma, Deputy Director General, Aadhaar Usage Division. Lt. Col. Praveen Chaudhary also conducted a live demonstration of Aadhaar verification.

➤ Use of Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) schemes by Shri Saurabh K Tiwari, Additional Secretary, DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India.

Each session was followed by interactive question-and-answer segments, contributing to engaging and lively discussions.

The curriculum covered a wide range of subjects including Introduction to Tourism & Eco-Tourism, Professional Tools for Tourist Guides, Principles of Eco-Tourism, Eco-Tourism in India, Understanding Group Behaviour, Communication Skills and Personality Development, Code of Conduct for Eco-Tourist Guides, Travel Formalities, Tourism Products of India and Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Handling Difficult Tourists, Emerging Areas in Tour Guiding, Facilities and Amenities for Tourists in A&N Administration, Agro-Tourism, Tribal Culture and Anthropology, Biodiversity and Ecology of the Andaman Coast, Etiquettes and Professional Conduct, and Eco-Tourism with special focus on bird watching in the islands.

As part of the practical exposure, the participants were taken to key heritage and eco-tourism sites






