The President said India has one of the fastest growing services sectors in the world with annual growth rate of above 9% since



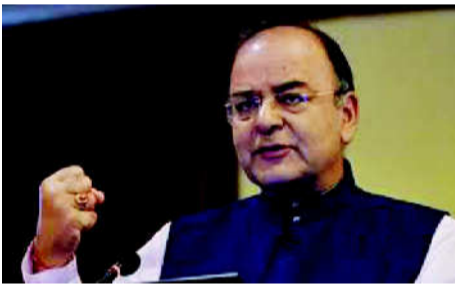

New York, AApr 20  
India has asked the global community to toughen its collective fight against the growing nexus of organised drug trafficking and terrorist networks by disrupting their financial flows.  
Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley, in his address to a special UN General Assembly session on the drug problem, stressed that the growing nexus of drug trafficking and terrorist networks endangers peace, security and stability across regions. He said the



criminal networks and drug syndicates can only be effectively busted by disrupting their financial flows. Shri Jaitley termed as a major challenge, money laundering and illicit financial flows and proceeds of crime generated from drug trafficking and other transnational organised crime.

The District Administration has clarified about various complaints/news carried in local newspapers regarding 'mass earth filling in Tsunami inundated areas', wherein it has been alleged that the people are indulged in filling up their inundated Tsunami plots for commercial use in the areas from Attom Pahad to

Garacharma/Chouldhari. In this context, the Sub Divisional Magistrate, South Andaman District, in a press release received here today, has clarified that spot inspections have been conducted by the SDM along with the team formed to curb and check the unauthorized extraction of earth comprising of revenue and police officials on various dates.

During the surprise inspection on Saturday (Apr 16), one Hitachi (Excavator), 4 trucks were seized which were indulged in illegal transportation to dump the earth in unauthorized site/non permitted site.  
Penalty under the relevant sections of Andaman and Nicobar Minor Mineral Rules, 2012 is being imposed upon dates.

In a notification, the Board has suggested that parents and teachers should ensure that students carry books only according to the time-table. It also said that schools' heads and teachers should discourage senior students from carrying heavy 'reference' books or other such materials. Schools have also been asked to ensure that the curriculum supports more activity-based, information and communications technology-supported learning for all the main subjects in all classes as far as possible. Co-curricular activities should be conducted every day, and scheduled in the time-table accordingly to ensure the balance of bag weight throughout the academic session, CBSE said.

## Bombay High Court allows IPL match in Pune on May 1

Mumbai, Apr 20  
The Bombay High Court on Wednesday allowed one Indian Premier League (IPL) match to be played in Maharashtra. A division bench of Justice V M Kanade and Justice M S Karnik allowed the May 1 to be played between Rising Pune Supergiants and Mumbai Indians at the Pune MCA stadium. Senior Counsel Rafiq Dada appearing for Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) sought consideration from the court citing logistical reasons. The application filed on April 16 points out that Pune has home matches against Gujarat Lions on April 29 and against Mumbai Indians on May 1. So it is practically impossible for BCCI and the franchise to shift the May 1 match to an alternative venue outside Maharashtra and make all the arrangements for the same in just a single day. On April 13, the court granted BCCI and other Cricket Associations 15 days to make all arrangements to shift out. The court said they had

expected the cricket matches. The bench observed that shifting of IPL matches won't solve the problem alone but it can be a beginning so that water used for pitches can be diverted to affected areas.

### BCCI appoints Rahul Johri as its CEO

New Delhi, Apr 20  
The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) on Wednesday announced Rahul Johri as its first-ever chief executive officer (CEO). Mr. Johri, after spending two decades in the media industry, will join the board on June 1. "We are pleased to have Rahul with us and are sure his vast experience and knowledge will benefit the board. His vision, guidance and support will contribute towards the successful working of the BCCI," BCCI president Shashank Manohar said in a



media release. Mr. Johri quit Discovery Networks after spending 15 years with the broadcasting major. He was Discovery Networks Asia Pacific's executive vice-president and general manager for south Asia. Mr. Johri will report to the BCCI secretary.

Paris, Apr 20

Zlatan Ibrahimovic scored a typically brilliant goal as Paris Saint-Germain beat Lorient 1-0 away in a French Cup semi-final. The Cup holders and Ligue 1 champions will now face either second tier Sochaux or arch rivals Marseille in the final. The Parisians are bidding for a second successive clean sweep of the domestic honours in France and face Lille in the League Cup final this weekend. Ibrahimovic picked up the ball from a Di Maria pass and ran straight at goal from 40 yards out before curling a shot with the outside of his right boot around Lorient goalkeeper Benjamin Lecomte from the edge of the area.

### Irfan Ahmed banned for two and a half years by ICC

Dubai, Apr 20  
The International Cricket Council today announced that it has suspended Hong Kong all-rounder Irfan Ahmed for two years and six months after he admitted to breaching the ICC Anti-Corruption Code. Ahmed was charged with offences under the Code and provisionally suspended by the ICC on November 4, 2015.

## Zlatan Ibrahimovic fires PSG into French Cup final



Everyone had been expecting the Swede to pass but instead he racked up a 43rd goal in all competitions this season. Ligue 1's 11th placed side Lorient had put up little to worry the Parisians until then but second string keeper Salvatore Sirigu made a crucial late save when called upon. Both Ibrahimovic and strike partner Edinson Cavani went close as PSG peppered the Lorient goal in the first half after coach Laurent Blanc had put

out a strong side. PSG midfielder Blasie Matuidi deflected suggestions it had been a close game saying his side had always been comfortable.

### Aaqib Javed steps down as UAE head coach

Aaqib Javed has resigned from his role as the United Arab Emirates Cricket Head Coach effective May 31st 2016. Aaqib joined UAE Cricket as Head Coach in March 2012 and has experienced the successes of guiding the UAE to qualify for the 2014 U19 World Cup, the 2014 ICC World Twenty20 and the 2015 ICC Cricket World Cup, overseeing the UAE gain T20I and ODI status, as well as the recent qualification to compete in the 2016 ACC Asia Cup.

## Govt to form panel to deal with complaints of online shoppers: Minister

New Delhi, Apr 20  
Consumer Affairs Minister, Shri Ram Vilas Paswan has said the government will set up a committee to suggest ways to deal with complaints of consumers who trade on e-commerce platforms. He said the decision has been taken in the wake of several complaints from online buyers related to delay or non-delivery of products and sub-standard goods. After the 30th meeting of

the Central Consumer Protection Council yesterday, Shri Paswan told reporters in New Delhi, the suggestions made by the committee will be incorporated in the rules after the passage of the proposed Consumer Protection Bill in Parliament.

Shri Paswan also said, the committee was of opinion to make celebrities also responsible for products they recommend. He said

celebrities should understand the product thoroughly before endorsing them because there are large number of followers who trust on them.

The Minister said the dual maximum retail price(MRP) for the same product is illegal and strict and prompt action will be taken against owner who charge above the MRP in Multiplexes, amusement parks and other avenues.

## Be cautious with antibiotics to heart patients: IMA to doctors

New Delhi, April 20  
Indian Medical Association (IMA) has asked doctors to be cautious in prescribing antibiotics to the heart patients. IMA Secretary General KK Aggarwal said, certain antibiotics may increase the risk of heart attack in people with underlying heart diseases. Dr. Aggarwal said, prolonged research has indicated that overuse and misuse of antibiotics can cause disease resistance as well as increase one's chances of life-threatening ailments. IMA also



recommended doctors to wait for test results or to see how symptoms develop before prescribing antibiotics. World Health Organization has recently

issued an advisory about the current practice of indiscriminate use of antibiotics leading to resistance to medicines, persistence of infections and treatment failure.
