Minister said, civil servants should always remember that Civil services have power, but with power comes responsibility, accompanied by accountability.

Defence Minister assures IAF of expediting acquisition of fighter jets

New Delhi, Apr 20 Defence Minister Shri Arun Jaitley has assured the Indian Air Force (IAF) of expediting acquisition of fighter jets and other critical systems as part of its modernisation programme. In his inaugural address at IAF's Commanders' conference in New Delhi yesterday, Shri Jaitley also talked of what he called uncertainties in the region as well as on security challenges facing India due to the rapidly-changing geo-political situation. Force for having successfully conducted various military exercises and operations towards humanitarian assistance and disaster relief both within and outside the country. The three-day conference will deliberate on a range of critical issues including modernisation of IAF, its futuristic plans and ways to enhance overall capability of the force.

Govt further extends deadline for deposits under PMGKY to April 30

New Delhi, Apr 20 Government has extended the last date to make deposits under the Pradhan Mantri Garib



Kalyan Yojna (PMGKY) to 30th of this month for those availing the scheme and have already paid tax, surcharge and penalties. The scheme, which opened in December last year, provided last chance to holders of undisclosed income to come clean by paying tax and penalty. The RBI in a release said, the persons who had filed the declaration by

depositing tax, surcharge and penalty under the scheme on or before 31st of March, will be allowed extension of time till April 30 for banks to upload details into RBI's E-Kuber system and for depositors to make commensurate deposits, if not already done. RBI said, the date of deposit and uploading would not be extended beyond 30th of April.

Finance Ministry approves 8.65% interest rate on EPF for 2016-17

New Delhi, Apr 20 Labour Minister Shri Bandaru Dattatreya today said that the Finance Ministry has approved 8.65 per cent interest rate on EPF for 2016-17. He said, the government will immediately issue the notification and credit the rate of interest to



over four crore subscribers. The ratification of the

8.65 per cent on EPF will enable the retirement fund body EPFO to credit this rate of return into the accounts of the subscribers. The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation trustees had approved 8.65 per cent rate on EPF in December last year.

Neil - dawn of new tourist destination Tourism Department to develop eco-friendly resort at Neil Island under 'Swadesh Darshan Scheme'

Neil Island is one of the pristine Islands in the archipelago of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Since last three years, tourism is booming in the Islands and growing at a rate of 30% every year. Andaman and Nicobar Administration as well as the Govt of India is also taking initiatives in the development of Neil Island by protecting sensitive eco system of Neil Island, which is now going through a transformation period as many entrepreneurs are investing for the development of hospitality industry.

The Tourism Department of A&N Administration has



taken an initiative for development of eco-friendly resort at Laxmanpur village, Neil Island, which will help mitigating the growing demands of tourists, who like to stay at Neil Island. Keeping in view the mixed profile of tourists visiting the Islands and to ensure greater occupancy and economic earnings for project



viability, it has been planned to set up both luxury and budget tented accommodations in the first instance. The tented accommodations will be established in one hectare of land initially and will be expanded thereafter. The Tourism Department has received assistance from Ministry of Tourism under 'Swadesh Darshan Scheme' for the development of 8 beaches of the Isles, under which, the Laxmanpur and Bharatpur beaches will be developed by providing facilities like floating jetty for water sport activity, crocodile protection net, toilet, changing room etc. The Andaman Lakshadweep Harbour Works (ALHW) has been entrusted with such tourism development activities here. The ALHW will conduct a demand survey to assess availability and requirement of accommodation in Neil Island and also carry out an economic feasibility study to ensure that the project is financially viable.
