As part of the ongoing 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan', 'Ujjwala Diwas', under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala scheme, was observed in the conference hall of Subashgram Gram Panchayat, Diglipur today. The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray was the chief guest of the programme while the Assistant Commissioner,

Diglipur, Shri Shailender Kumar Singh, was the guest of honor. Free LPG connections distributed to women under 'Ujjwala Diwas' Administration committed to achieve targets under 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan' in Isles: CS

Port Blair, April 20
Alongwith the rest of the country, 'Ujjwala Diwas' was observed in the Islands today as part of the ongoing 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan'. On this day, as many as 15,000 Pradhan Mantri LPG Panchayats were held throughout the country targeting 15 lakhs women for free LPG distribution. In these Islands too, such PMLPG Panchayats were held to distribute free new LPG connections to needy women. In this connection, a similar function was held in the Panchayat Hall Burmanallah, Beodnabad Gram Panchayat this morning, during which the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar distributed 10 new LPG connections to the women beneficiaries. As many as



100 new LPG connections were provided during the camp. Distributing the LPG connections, the chief guest informed the gathering that the three week long Gram Swaraj Abhiyan was launched by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on April, 14, 2018, with the objective

to achieve 100% implementation of various welfare schemes of the Government, which were launched one by one by the Prime Minister himself. The Administration is making all out efforts in implementing the campaign by deputing officials and staff to organize such camp at

High energy swell waves to hit Isles' shores; fishermen advised

Port Blair, April 20
As per the latest multi-model based operational wave forecasting system at INCOIS, Hyderabad, there is a strong indication that high energy swell waves, with heights between 2 to 3 m and periods between 17-22 seconds are likely to be experienced in the seas around India. The higher waves will be first experienced along the west coast of India and Lakshadweep by morning hours of Saturday i.e. 21 April, 2018 and subsequently the Bay of Bengal by Sunday i.e. 22 April, 2018. The wave impact in the Bay of Bengal could be particularly high off the west coast of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, as compared to the east coast of India. In the Bay of Bengal, the high swell wave regime is likely to continue and decrease only by around 24th April, 2018. However, the swell energy is likely to

be higher on Monday in the Bay of Bengal. Due to high energy swell waves, fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea along and off Andaman & Nicobar coasts on 22nd and 23rd April 2018. The general public have been advised to take

precautionary measures and in case of any emergency, they may contact over phone numbers of State Control Room, District Control Room and Emergency Operation Centres viz. State Control Room: 03192-

PBMC selling organic compost at its stall in ITF

Port Blair, April 20
The Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) is making available its compost to the general public apart from the supplying its compost to the green patches i.e., parks & gardens maintained by the PBMC. This is the first of its kind, in which the general public can purchase the organic compost from Stall No.34 of Island Tourism Festival, Marina Park and at the open desk at Flea Market, Girls' School. The stall is also decorated with various 3R policies adopted by the PBMC for

waste management like reuse of old cloth in making of floor mats, foot mats, hanging pockets, etc., reuse of PET bottles as a hanging flower pots. Presently, PBMC has 2 compost yards situated at Gandhi Park & Brookshabad, Port Blair in which about 2 to 3 tons of compost generates every month. One more compost yard is being developed at Dollygunj, which will be ready by the end of April, 2018 and the compost production will be started from the end of May, 2018.

Keeping alive a dying tradition: Soaring kites in sky capture attention of Portblarians

Syed Mohiuddin, popularly known as Bhai Mian is one of the famous personalities in India and abroad when it comes to Kite Flying. He has been instrumental in making and flying kites and achieved various records during his youth. Jamaluddin, his son who is also in this field, shared his passion for this sport which he inherited from his father; during a conversation with 'The Daily Telegrams' today.

Jamal recounted his experience of flying kites not only in different parts of the country but also in various countries such as in The Dubai Shopping Festival where he flew a train of 1187 kites on a single string. He vehemently maintains that Indian Kites are the best in spite of the active Chinese intrusion in Indian Kite market. He described Indian kites as 'fighter kites' as "Indian patangein ungliyon ke ishaare par naachti hai". Passion and creativity has driven this man, who has made kites in all shapes and sizes. His smallest

kite 2.5 mm long and the biggest being 400 Square feet. He takes pride in his collection of carefully crafted kites shaped to look like a peacock, a snake, glider, aeroplane, fish, various birds and animals. His endeavour to better his previous achievement stems from an insatiable desire to do something that has never been done before. "Koi cheez aisee udayen jo sab dekhen to kahein ki yeh to pehli baar udte hue dekhi hai", he says. The family has lovingly preserved some special kites for years. Some of the oldest kites that they



proudly showcase are over 50 years old. Jamal politely admitted the fact that due to social media and internet, kite flying as a sport has declined. Not only have Bhai Mian and his sons been

camps will be organized for all the schemes, so that the target of 100% coverage can be achieved within the timeframe, he said. Some areas are yet to be covered under the welfare schemes; which will be covered during the Abhiyan by May 5, 2018, he said. The Chief Secretary sought the cooperation of the Islanders and said that the target can only be achieved with their cooperation. While speaking, the Adhyaksha, Zilla Parishad, South Andaman, Smt. Baby Fareeda said that the very concern of the Prime Minister about the hard life of women has led to the implementation of the Ujjwala Scheme. Now BPL women are being provided free LPG connection and this had brought great relief to them, she said appealing to the beneficiaries to continue the use of LPG, saying that cylinder is one time free and can be replaced by buying new cylinder at subsidized rate. The Secretary (CS&CA), Shri Ramesh Verma, while speaking on the occasion said, Ujjwala scheme provides free LPG connection to every woman in the house. This will not only take care of their health, but will also save their time and provide them the opportunity to take up other works for the benefit of their family, he said and appealed to the women to come forward and cooperate with the Administration in the successful implementation of Ujjwala scheme during the campaign.

The Secretary cum Director (RD&Panchayats), Shri Udit Prakash Rai, Deputy Commissioner (SA) informed that the Ujjwala Yojana of the Prime Minister has immensely benefitted the BPL women, who otherwise had to face difficulties in cooking with fuel woods, braving hazardous smoke, which have adverse affect on their health. Now the scheme has been extended to not only BPL women but others, who do not have LPG connections, can apply for LPG connection under the scheme, he said. He also mentioned some of the welfare schemes of the Government, which are being implemented during the campaign. These include PMSBY, PMJJBY, Mission Indradhanush and many other schemes, that have been launched by the Prime Minister. The Abhiyan will reach out to remotest village in the Islands, like Kala Pahad and people should come forward and take the opportunity and register themselves and get benefit of the scheme, he said. Shri Vijay Seth, Plant Manager (IOC) gave details of the safety measures to the women beneficiaries and advised them to strictly follow the safety measures to avoid any accident.

Smt. V Shanti, Pradhan Beodnabad Gram Panchayat and Smt. Devanti, the two Ujjwala beneficiaries narrated their history before and after getting LPG connection and thanked the Prime Minister for launching the scheme, which has brought great relief to them.

Earlier, the Plant Manager welcomed the gathering and the function concluded with the vote of thanks, proposed by Shri R P Singh, Secretary (CCS).
