## Legal Provisions under the Census Act 1948

- ▶ Census operations are conducted under full legal backing of the Census Act, 1948.
- ▶ Enumerators/Supervisors have the right to access house, affix numbers, and ask census questions of all persons within the limits of the local area for which he is appointed. (Sections 8 & 9, the Census Act, 1948).
- ▶ Every person, of whom any question is asked under sub-section (1) of Sections 8, shall be legally bound to answer such question to the best of his knowledge or belief.
- ▶ Census records and data are strictly confidential and not open to inspection or court evidence (Section 15, the Census Act, 1948).
- ▶ Census duty period is treated as official duty under the lending employer (15A, the Census Act, 1948).
- ▶ Actions taken in good faith are legally protected (Section 15B, the Census Act, 1948).
- ▶ Non-performance or negligence in census duties may attract penalties.
- ▶ Census duties are both a legal obligation and a national responsibility.

# Island Aspirant's determination pays off in UPSC

## "Patience, Hard Work & Perseverance key to success," says Shiyad

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 20

In a proud moment for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a young aspirant from Wimberlygunj has successfully cleared the prestigious UPSC Civil Services Examination, securing an All India Rank of 743. Shiyad's success not only reflects his personal determination and disciplined approach but also stands as an inspiration for aspiring candidates from the islands. His journey underscores the importance of perseverance, self-belief and consistent effort in overcoming geographical and resource constraints.

In an exclusive interview to 'Daily Telegrams', Shri Shiyad spoke at length about his preparation strategy, the challenges he encountered, the role of family support and his aspirations for the future. Excerpts from the interview:

**Q: How does it feel to clear the UPSC Civil Services Examination and secure this rank?**

**A:** I feel really happy, especially that after years of preparation, I have finally cleared the exam. It is a moment of satisfaction and relief. More importantly, I am happy to make my family proud, as they have supported me throughout this journey.

**Q: Could you share a brief background about yourself and your roots in the Andaman and Nicobar**

Islands?

**A:** I am from Wimberlygunj and belong to a close-knit joint family. My family includes my mother, two sisters, my maternal uncle and aunt, along with their children. Our roots go deep into the history of these islands, my great grandparents were brought as prisoners from Kerala to the Cellular Jail by the British during the early 1920s.

**Q: What inspired you to aim for civil services?**

**A:** Being from a Union Territory, I always felt that

civil services would give me a meaningful platform to contribute towards the development of the Country as well as Islands. The opportunity to serve people and bring about positive change motivated me to pursue this path.

**Q: When did you begin your preparation, and what was your overall strategy?**

**A:** I started my preparation in August 2021. My approach was to first understand the exam thoroughly by analysing previous years' question



papers. This helped me align my preparation with the demands of the exam. Alongside this, consistency, disciplined study and regular revision were key elements of my strategy.

**Q: How challenging was it to prepare from a remote region like the islands?**

**A:** Preparing from a remote region had its own challenges. There was limited exposure to current affairs discussions and competitive environments. However, I

## DBRAIT secures two major R&D Projects worth Rs. 81 Lakh in Emerging Technologies and Advanced Physics

## Tablet-Based FLS-2026 to be conducted across A&N Islands on April 22 & 23

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 20

The Foundational Learning Study (FLS)-2026, mandated by the Ministry of Education, will be conducted in sampled schools across all three districts of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2026. The study aims to assess Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) competencies of students at the end of Grade 3, providing a clear picture of early

learning outcomes in the Union Territory.

This is the first time the survey will be conducted in a fully tablet-based mode, replacing the earlier OMR-based system. The shift to digital assessment is expected to ensure faster, more reliable, and real-time data collection, enhancing the overall quality and accuracy of the study.

implemented through a start-up to be incubated, focusing on design, development, and commercialization, with the objective of supporting tribal coconut farmers, youth entrepreneurs, and women self-help groups in the islands.

In addition, another major R&D project titled "Unconventional Superconductivity in Moiré Superlattices Beyond the Honeycomb Lattice" has been sanctioned to DBRAIT under the Prime Minister Early Career Research Grant (PMECRG) by ANRF, Government of India. The project, led by Dr. Rajeshkumar O. Sharma, Assistant Professor (Physics), carries a grant of Rs. 40 lakh for duration of three years, including provision for one Junior Research Fellow (JRF). The research focuses on exploring the fundamental mechanisms of unconventional superconductivity in non-honeycomb moiré lattice systems, contributing to advancements in frontier areas of condensed matter physics and strengthening the institute's research ecosystem, a press release from DBRAIT said.

gradually overcame this by focusing on self-improvement and making effective use of newspapers and online resources.

**Q: What were the key difficulties you faced, and how did you overcome them?**

**A:** The major challenges were staying updated, maintaining consistency and dealing with limited guidance. I overcame these by following a disciplined routine, regularly assessing my performance and continuously working on improving my weak areas.

**Q: Did you take coaching or rely on self-study? What resources helped you the most?**

**A:** I did attend coaching classes initially from an IAS Academy in Kerala, but I believe coaching can only guide you, the real effort must come from the individual. I relied on standard books such as NCERT's, Laxmikanth for Polity, Spectrum for Modern India, along with newspapers and other reference materials.

**Q: What, according to you, were the key factors behind your success?**

**A:** Patience, consistency, hard work and perseverance were the most important factors. Staying committed over a long period made the difference.

**Q: How did you stay motivated during setbacks or difficult phases?**

**A:** During setbacks, I focused on self-assessment to understand whether I was improving despite the results. The constant encouragement from my family and friends also played a crucial role in keeping me motivated.

**Q: What message would you like to give to aspirants from the islands and similar regions?**

**A:** The key difference between successful and average individuals lies in their mindset rather than talent. If one remains determined and focused, any goal can be achieved regardless of geographical limitations.

**Q: Which service are you expecting, and what are your future goals?**

**A:** The service allocation is yet to be announced, and I am hoping for a Group A service. However, since my rank is 743, I may not get IAS this time. I plan to attempt the examination again with the aim of improving my rank.

**Q: How do you see your success contributing to the aspirations of youth in the islands?**

**A:** I believe my success will inspire many young aspirants from the islands to believe in their potential. I hope this encourages more youth to aim high, not only in civil services but in other fields as well. One of my favorite lines from the movie 'The Shawshank Redemption' is the simple truth that sometimes all it takes is time and pressure.

**Q: What role did your family and support system play in your journey?**

**A:** My family has been my biggest strength. My mother, uncles, sisters and relatives constantly motivated me and stood by me during difficult times. Their unwavering support gave me the confidence to keep going.

**Q: Looking back, is there anything you would have done differently in your preparation?**

**A:** Perhaps choosing Arts in higher secondary and pursuing graduation in Political Science might have helped me clear the exam earlier. However, I believe everything happens for a reason, and I have no regrets about my journey.

**Q: What are your immediate plans after this achievement?**

**A:** For now, I plan to take a short break and spend time relaxing before the foundation course begins. It has been a long journey, and I think this break is well deserved.

Ancient manuscripts and rare records are invaluable evidence of our intellectual traditions, cultural heritage, and collective memory. Their preservation and transmission to future generations is a shared responsibility. People have been urged to come forward and contribute towards this Mission of the Govt. of India, a press release from Art & Culture Department said.

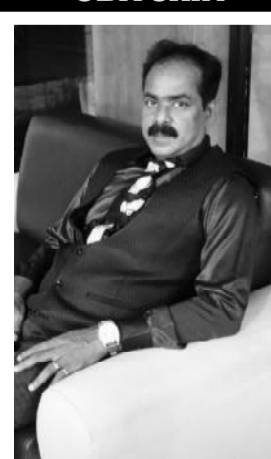

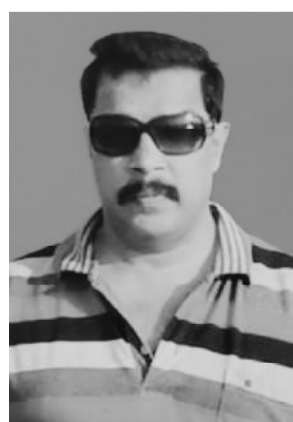
