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## Andaman Boosts Marine Tourism, Launches 4 New Dive Sites In Diglipur

This new development marks a strategic shift that could transform Diglipur into India's next big scuba destination

For years, scuba lovers have only travelled to the famous southern hotspots of Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep. But now, North Andaman is finally stepping into the spotlight. In a major push to expand adventure tourism, the Directorate of Information, Publicity & Tourism, Andaman & Nicobar Administration, has officially unveiled four newly explored scuba-diving sites in Diglipur.

This new development has opened up an entirely new underwater frontier for travellers and diving enthusiasts. It marks a strategic shift that could transform Diglipur into India's next big scuba destination, while also helping reduce tourism pressure on the heavily

visited southern islands. Located about 320 kilometres north of Sri Vijaya Puram, Diglipur has long been known for its dramatic landscapes, quiet beaches, dense tropical forests and raw, untouched beauty. Yet despite its stunning marine ecosystems, it remained largely unexplored in India's recreational diving circuit.

**1. The Pristine Shoreline Sanctuary**  
 The first newly charted site is located just off the Coast of Ross & Smith Islands and is ideal for beginners. Here, divers can simply walk from the sandy beach straight into the ocean instead of boarding a boat. The dive depth ranges from 2 to 12 metres, making it perfect for first-time divers, underwater photography, and more.

**2. The Deep Blue Bridge**  
 Located northeast of the iconic Ross & Smith sandbar, this boat-diving site offers a slightly deeper and more immersive experience. With depths ranging between 3 and 11 metres, it is ideal for certification dives and divers looking to sharpen their skills. The reefscape here is expected to feature healthy stretches of brain coral, delicate staghorn coral gardens

and vibrant anemone clusters.

**3. Small Wall Off Ross Island**  
 This location, formally known as "Small Wall off Ross Island," introduces divers to striking vertical underwater scenery. The dive starts on an 8-10-metre-high reef shelf before plunging quickly down a stunning 21-metre wall into deeper blue waters. The thrill of floating next to an underwater cliff surface, often surrounded by larger marine life, is why experienced divers enjoy wall dives.

**4. Wall Of Craggy/Gentle Slope**  
 This site, which is the deepest and most enigmatic of the four, is already exciting experienced divers. It is referred to as the "Wall of Craggy/Gentle Slope" and has depths of 8 to an astounding 31

Further, training & guidance was imparted on life-saving techniques and general safety measures to be followed while at sea and the meetings also provided an interactive platform for fishermen to raise their grievances, complaints and concerns before the concerned authorities, a press release from SP, PMF said.

workshops regularly, and conduct meetings of the Departmental Official Language Implementation Committee.
