President calls for conducive atmosphere to enable people to vote without fear or favour

New Delhi, Oct 20 President Shri Pranab Mukherjee has said that it is important to create a conducive atmosphere to enable people to exercise their franchise without fear or favour and see that the outcome of elections is not vitiated.

He said, democracy will succeed through responsibility of discharging free and fair elections as per the Constitution of the country concerned.

Shri Mukherjee was speaking to the heads of election management bodies and international electoral institutions of different countries attending the 'International Conference on Voter Education for Inclusive, Informed and Ethical Participation' in New Delhi yesterday.

He said, the country has seen consistent rise in voters' participation in



successive elections. The General Elections to the Lok Sabha in 2014 recorded a historic turn out. Shri Mukherjee said that he is happy that the voters also chose a stable political regime by electing

a single party majority government. Shri Mukherjee hoped that the deliberations at the conference will lead to better voters' education and increased voters' participation.

Four wheeler vehicle owners asked to remove tinted glasses immediately

Port Blair, Oct. 20 The Traffic Police has directed all the four wheeler vehicle owners to remove tinted glass from their vehicles immediately. The Superintendent of Police (Traffic) in a press release issued here has stated that in spite of several instructions given through media and other sources, it has been observed that still some four wheeler vehicle owners are plying their vehicle with tinted glass beyond permissible limit

in the Port Blair city. This is in violation of the direction/order of the Supreme Court.

The SP has asked all the four wheeler vehicle owners to remove the tinted glass immediately otherwise suitable action will be taken by the traffic police against the violation of the order as per relevant rules. Altogether, 68 vehicles have been prosecuted for violation of Supreme Court Order this year till date, the release added.

HM assures all necessary support to SSB troops deployed in J&K

New Delhi, Oct 20 Home Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh has directed to provide all necessary support including vehicles, assault weapons on priority basis to the troops of Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) deployed in Jammu and Kashmir. Shri Singh said this while reviewing the work and activities of Sashastra (SSB) in New Delhi as a part of ongoing review of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF). An official release said, Shri Singh discussed the recent attack by militants on SSB troops in Jakura, Srinagar in Kashmir and appreciated the retaliatory efforts made by SSB jawans. He also

appreciated the works and activities of SSB in the Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected areas and in Jammu and Kashmir. The Home Minister said, a contingent of SSB will soon be deployed in United Nations Peacekeeping Operations. Shri Singh also discussed the security arrangements on Indo-Nepal Border and stressed that intensive vigil should be maintained on the border as terrorists may take advantage of the porous border. Minister of State for Home, Shri Kiren Rijiju was also present at the meeting.

Huge haul of IMFL recovered by Police; two arrested

Port Blair, Oct. 20 The A&N Police has seized 146 bottles of IMFL in a raid onboard M.V Badam berthed alongside Cholanga jetty. On a tip-off today, a raiding team comprising staff of Special Branch, CID and PS CCS jointly conducted a raid onboard MV Badam berthed alongside Cholanga jetty and recovered 146 bottles of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) which was supposed to be

transported to Nicobar Group of Islands. In this connection, two persons namely Abdul Salam, 62, Master (N.C.V) M.V. Badam, R/o Lillipur, Haddo and Mohd. Yakoob, 58, Chief Engineer, MV Badam, R/o Telarabad have been arrested under excise regulation.

This is one of the largest haul of IMFL seized by SB (CID) in collaboration with PS CCS staff this year and Police will continue to fight against this menace to

eradicate the illegal trade of illicit liquor and IMFL.

Chong Wei and Hong Kong's Wei Nan. However, B Sai Praneeth, who had clinched the Canada Open in July, lost narrowly to Tanongsak Saensomboonsuk of Thailand. His fight ended with a 17-21

21-19 15-21 loss to Saensomboonsuk. In men's doubles, Rio Olympians Manu Attri and B Sumeeth Reddy suffered 10-21 19-21 loss to Denmark's Kim Astrup and Anders Skarup Rasmussen.

In the first round, while Prannoy defeated Malaysian qualifier Wei Feng Chong, Ajay cruised to the next round beating Thailand's

Chittagong, Oct 20
England skipper Alastair Cook on Wednesday confirmed that fast bowler James Anderson is likely to miss the opening Test match against India in Rajkot. The pacer had already been ruled out of the ongoing Bangladesh tour due to a stress fracture in his left shoulder. He sustained the injury during play against Sri Lanka this summer, and missed the first Test against Pakistan in July. "He won't be ready for the first Test match. He might be ready to do some training, but he won't be ready for the first Test. A decision will be made on when he comes out over the next week or so," Cook was quoted as saying.

Kochi first to get the nod for u-17 WC

Kochi, Oct 20
Kochi was confirmed as a venue for next year's under-17 football World Cup with the delegation from the sport's world body FIFA making the announcement at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium here on Wednesday. "We are pleased to announce that Kochi has been ratified as a venue for the FIFA under-17 World Cup," said Javier Ceppi, the tournament director. Kochi thus became the first city in the country to be confirmed as a venue for next year's World Cup. A 23-member team, half of them from FIFA and headed by Project Leader Tracy Lu,

inspected the Nehru Stadium, the championship's main venue, and the four training grounds here before making the official announcement. The ratification, however, came with a small push. "This ratification, which has been discussed with all the stakeholders, is not a blank cheque," said Ceppi. "There is a sea of things that needs to be completed, we will keep monitoring quite closely, we will come at least once every three weeks." The installation of the bucket seats at the Nehru Stadium will be among the most visible and important things to be done.

India calls for global action against chemical weapons

New York, Oct 20
India has voiced deep concern over terror groups acquiring chemical weapons, asserting that the international community must take urgent measures and decisive actions to prevent possibility of any future use of such weapons. India's Permanent Representative to the Conference on Disarmament, Geneva, Shri D B Venkatesh Varma, said

this at a debate on weapons of mass destruction in United Nations yesterday. He said that it has been New Delhi's consistent position that the use of chemical weapons cannot be justified and the perpetrators of such abhorrent acts must be held accountable. He said that the provisions of the Convention should be implemented in a manner that does not hinder legitimate activities,

especially in countries like India with a large and growing chemical industry.
