Death toll rises in Indore-Patna express derail; President, PM express condolences

Kanpur, Nov 20
In Uttar Pradesh, over 115 people have been dead and several others injured when 14 coaches of Indore-Rajendranagar express derailed near Pukhrayan district in Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh early this morning. More than hundred passengers were injured when 14 coaches of the train derailed early this morning. The incident took

place at around 3 AM near Pukhrayan, about 100 kms from Kanpur. President Shri Pranab Mukherjee and Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi have expressed heartfelt condolences to families of deceased in the accident. They also prayed for speedy recovery of the injured. The Railways has announced ex-gratia of 3.5

lakh rupees each for families of those killed, 50,000 rupees for seriously injured and 25 thousand rupees for minor injury. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has also announced ex-gratia of two lakh rupees each for the next of kin of those killed and 50,000 rupees for those seriously injured. This is over and above any other assistance.

Govt to ensure benefits of Social Security Schemes reaches every section of working class: FM

New Delhi, Nov 20
Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley has said that one of the major priorities of present Government is to ensure that benefits of Social Security Schemes reach to every section of workers including those working in unorganized sector. Speaking during his

second pre-Budget Consultative Meeting for the Union Budget with the representatives of different Trade Union Groups in New Delhi yesterday, Shri Jaitley said, the Government is sensitive about the welfare of workers and will take all possible measures to ensure that their interest and welfare is fully protected. Most of the Trade Union representative gave a joint memorandum to Shri Jaitley. They have urged that next Budget should help in creating more jobs and employment opportunities and minimum wages to 18 thousand rupees.

Presumption in dowry death to be backed by cruelty proof: SC

New Delhi, Nov 20
The Supreme Court has ruled that the presumption of culpability against an accused in a dowry death case under the Evidence Act will be activated only when there is a proof that a deceased woman had been subjected to cruelty for demand of dowry. The provision to secure

convictions in dowry death cases was inserted in the Evidence Act, which provides that instead of presumption of innocence, the accused will be presumed prima facie guilty in such homicides if a woman dies within seven years of marriage and there is proof of cruelty. (Contd. on last page)

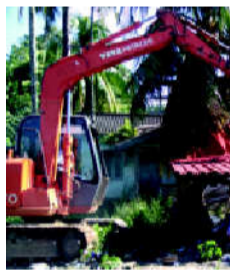

'Zero tolerance' towards encroachment on Govt. land; 49 unauthorized structures removed



Port Blair, Nov. 20
In continuation of the process to set a paradigm towards 'zero tolerance' towards encroachment on Government land and to restore valuable Govt. land under Port Blair Tehsil, the Encroachment Eviction Team of Revenue Department has taken another step towards protection of Government land in Port Blair Tehsil. Accordingly, an eviction Drive was conducted in Port Blair Tehsil by the Encroachment Eviction Team in the villages of Garacharma, Prothapur & Teylorabad recently wherein 49 unauthorized structures in the shape of 40 petty shops, 8 hutments and one semi permanent structure from the road sides and Govt. revenue land were evicted.

Machineries like excavator and trucks were used by the eviction team led by Tehsildar, Port Blair comprising of Revenue Inspector, Area Patwaris and Police officials during the eviction drive. General public have been cautioned to refrain from such unauthorized activities and encroachments, including buying and selling encroached land. In case of any violation found, stringent action will be taken. In case any of fresh encroachments are noticed, the general public can inform the District Control Room on toll free no. 1070, a communication from the Assistant Commissioner, South Andaman said.

China Open 2016: PV Sindhu defeats China's Sun Yu to clinch maiden Super Series title

New Delhi, Nov 20
Ace Indian shuttler PV Sindhu added another feather to her cap on Sunday as she defeated Sun Yu of China 21-11, 17-21, 21-11 in the final of the 2016 China Open in Fuzhou to clinch her maiden Super Series title.
Sindhu, who was playing her first final of a Super Series tournament, was leading 11-5 at first break in the first game. She comprehensively went on to seal the game 21-11.
Even in the second game, despite some early fightback from her Chinese opponent, Sindhu was leading 11-7 at the first break. But Yu fought back hard and leveled scores at 14-14. But since then, there was a shift in momentum as the Chinese stepped up the gas and was leading 19-16 at one point. She eventually won it 21-17. In the decider, Sindhu was leading 10-6, as her opponent looked out of steam. Sindhu once again was leading 11-6 after Yu's cross-court smash



landed wide. Sindhu extended her lead to 15-9 in the match. It was only a matter of time that Sindhu won the third game, which she eventually won 21-11. Earlier, in her semi-final match, the Hyderabad shuttler saved three match points against sixth seeded South Korean Sung Ji Hyun of South Korea in three tough games, 11-21, 23-21 and 21-19 in the second semi-final of the USD 700,000 Super Series Premier event. Yu defeated Tzu Ying Tai of Chinese Taipei 21-8, 23-21 in the first semi-final earlier. Prior to this final match, Yu, seeded eighth, had a 3-2 head-to-head lead over Sindhu. The duo last met at Swiss Open in 2014 with the Chinese girl winning in three games 18-21, 21-12, 21-19.
Sindhu's two wins over Yu came at India Open in 2013 and Asian Youth championships in 2012.
The 21-year-old Indian has now replicated Saina Nehwal's 2015 exploits by winning her first ever Premier title.
Sindhu became the first Indian shuttler to win a Silver medal at Olympics, when she lost to Spain's Carolina Marin in the women's singles final at Rio in August this year.

India get crucial breakthroughs after Cook-Hamid defiance

Vishakapatnam, Nov 20
Indian spinners were thwarted by a splendid display of ultra-defensive batting by England before the hosts edged ahead dismissing rival skipper Alastair Cook on an engrossing fourth day of the second cricket Test. In pursuit of an uphill victory target of 405, England finished the day at 87 for 2, thanks to a dogged defiance from skipper Cook and young Haseeb Hameed, who brought back memories of Hashim Amla and AB de Villiers 'batathon' at the Feroz Shah Kotla, last year. It was fascinating final two sessions where Cook (54, 188 balls) and 19-year-old Hameed (25, 144 balls) added

75 for the opening stand but more importantly consumed 50 out of the 150 overs that England require to bat in their second innings. Cook showed enormous patience en route his 53rd Test half-century which came off 172 balls—his slowest in longest format. The captain's resistance finally ended when Ravindra Jadeja trapped the skipper leg before with the final delivery of the day. England require 318 runs more on the final but they would be very happy if they could even manage a draw. India have three full sessions tomorrow to grab the remaining eight wickets and take a 1-0 lead in the five-match series. England reached

50 in 37.1 overs, a tad faster than their slowest of 38.5 overs in the second innings against Sri Lanka at The Oval in 1998. Ashwin had earlier bowled 8-3-12-0 in his first spell during the second session and with little assistance from the pitch he was brought in only in the 43rd over.

In a major verdict, a bench of Justices Dipak Misra and Amitava Roy has said if prosecution fails to prove by coherent evidence that an accused charged in a dowry death case has harassed the woman to demand dowry, the person cannot be held guilty by taking refuge of presumption under the Act.
The petitioners initially acquitted by a trial court, had approached the apex court against their conviction by the Madhya Pradesh High Court under sections 498-A (husband or relative of husband of a woman subjecting her to cruelty) and 304-B (dowry death) of the IPC.
