New Delhi, Nov 30 The Government has launched a unique initiative called 'Bhasha Sangam' to introduce school students to 22 Indian languages. The initiative, under 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat', was launched on 22nd of this month and will continue till the 21st of December. 'Bhasha Sangam' is a programme for schools and educational institutions to provide multilingual exposure to students in Indian languages. Another objective of Bhasha Sangam is to enhance linguistic tolerance and respect and promote national integration. Resource Development Minister Shri Prakash Javadekar had recently uploaded a video on his Twitter account, about 'Bhasha Sangam'. He said it is just the beginning of a journey meant to create interest in different Indian languages and curiosity to learn more. The Secretary, HRD Ministry, Smti Reena Ray said there are 22 languages listed in Schedule VIII of the Constitution but most students are familiar with only one or two languages. She said millions of school children are now being familiarised with other languages under 'Bhasha Sangam'.

Advisory to tourists visiting A&N Islands Abstain from entering/visiting areas reserved for Aboriginal Tribes

Port Blair, Nov.30 All Tourists visiting Andaman & Nicobar Islands have been advised to abstain from entering/visiting the areas reserved for Aboriginal Tribes. Any violation of such restrictions is a criminal offence and punishable under the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956, as amended from time to time. Any entry into the reserved area for the purpose of taking photographs or making videos of the aboriginal tribes is punishable with imprisonment which may extend to three years and with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees. All the Travel Agents/Tour Operators are also informed that promotion of tourism activities through any advertisement relating to aboriginal tribes, directly or indirectly, is a punishable offence under the Andaman & Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956, as amended from time to time. Any contravention of the Regulation is punishable with imprisonment which may extend to three years and with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees. All Travel Agents/Tour Operators have been requested to encourage the Tourists to take sea route to visit Baratang and other permissible areas in North & Middle Andaman. The Directorate of Shipping Services has already taken many initiatives to make the sea journey more affordable and more convenient. Bajrang, Vinesh, Pooja get Grade A contracts; Sushil, Sakshi in Grade B

New Delhi, Nov 30
Star wrestlers Bajrang Punia and Vinesh Phogat were on Friday included in the top Rs 30-lakh Grade A along with Pooja Dhandra as the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) on Friday rolled out its revolutionary contracts system for the grapplers. It was expected that Bajrang and Vinesh, who won the Commonwealth Games and the Asian Games gold medals this year, will be kept in the top grade. Pooja had become only the fourth Indian woman to win a medal at the World Championship recently. Two-time Olympic medalist Sushil Kumar and Rio Olympic bronze medallist Sakshi Malik, who are struggling with form for quite some time, could not make the top Grade. They will figure in the Grade



B, which will offer a financial support of Rs 20 lakh for one year. The contracts will be reviewed after one year. WFI is the only Indian Olympic Association-affiliated National Sports Federation to offer contracts to its athletes and only the second after the BCCI. The announcement was made by WFI President Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh in the presence of Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Aditya Nath, who inaugurated the senior National

Championship at Nandini Nagar. "Grapplers could move up or down after review in the grades," said Singh. "Sushil changed the face of the sport in the country with his two Olympic medals. We have to have him in the list despite the fact that he is not competing much. Sakshi's performance is also going up and down but wrestlers can jump into the next category with good performance." Vinesh hailed the move saying it will give a huge boost to the sport at the junior level.

AIBA set to introduce 'protest system' at 2019 men's world championships

Lausanne, Nov 30
The International Boxing Association (AIBA) is set to introduce a "protest system" for coaches and boxers in next year's world championship for men, which will also be a qualifier for the 2020 Olympics. Its system of scoring criticised by no less than the International Olympic Committee (IOC), the AIBA Thursday said a provision of protest will be introduced

at the 2019 world event to hold in Moscow. "Noteworthy, is the establishment of a protest system for Coaches and Athletes which has been approved, tested and is set to be implemented in 2019 at the AIBA Men's World Championships," the world body said in a statement. The AIBA said it has worked hard towards reforming its systems, most notably scoring, which has often

been lambasted as opaque by critics. The new system was tested for the first time during the 2018 Youth Olympic Games in Buenos Aires, and at the recent Women's World Championships in Delhi.



AIFF to launch school-level project with FIFA

Mumbai, Nov 30
The All India Football Federation (AIFF) will launch a school-level project by March-April next year in association with the game's world governing body FIFA. This was stated by AIFF General Secretary,

Kushal Das at the Star Sports India Football Forum 2018 organised by SportzPower in Mumbai today. He said the project, schools league', will be launched on a pilot basis. Shri Das said that at the time the Under-17 World Cup

was held in India last year, the AIFF had started a programme called 'Mission Eleven' which was a school contact programme. He said under this programme, the AIFF touched about 15 thousand schools across the country.

I would be in better form for World Tour finals: Sindhu

New Delhi, Nov 30
Indian badminton ace P V Sindhu believes she would be in top form at the BWF World Tour Final as a recent break gave her the time to be well-prepared for the season-ending tournament starting December 12. Olympic silver medallist Sindhu, who finished runners-up at the last edition of the event in Dubai, skipped last week's Syed Modi International in Lucknow to focus on the USD 1,500,000 event to be held at Guangzhou. It is the third time that the Indian ace qualified for the prestigious



event. Sindhu continued her impressive game from this year, claiming silver medals at all the major events - Commonwealth Games, Asian Games and the World Championship, besides finishing runners-up at India Open and Thailand Open.

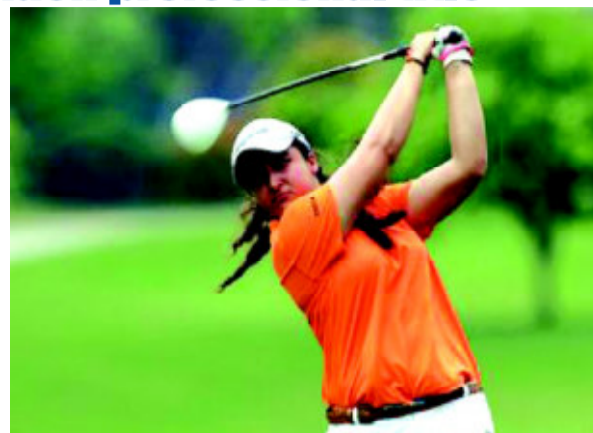
