Cabinet approves 3% DA for Govt. employees

New Delhi, Feb.20

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has given its approval to the release of an additional instalment of Dearness Allowance (DA) to Central Government employees, and Dearness Relief (DR) to pensioners w.e.f. 1.1.2019 representing an increase of 3% over the existing rate of 9% of the Basic Pay/Pension, to compensate for price rise. This increase is in accordance with the accepted formula, which is based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC). This will benefit about 48.41 lakh Central Government employees and 62.03 lakh pensioners.

Vehicle owners asked to remove tinted glass/sunshade net

Special drive to be conducted by traffic police

Despite several instructions through media and other sources, the Traffic Police has observed that some four wheelers are still plying with tinted glass/sunshade net or other materials on windscreen. These are strictly

Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh and Minister for Women and Child Development Smti Maneka Gandhi launched a range of citizen safety initiatives in New Delhi yesterday. It includes the Emergency Response Support System, ERSS, for women safety in 16 states and Union territories.

The 16 States/UTs where the ERSS has been launched are Andhra Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, UP, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Puducherry, Lakshadweep, Andaman, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, J&K.

thrice quickly to activate a panic call to ERC. In case of a feature phone, long press on number 5 or 9 on the phone keypad will activate the panic call. The ERCs are connected to District Command Centres

and the Emergency Response Vehicles, and assistance to victims is facilitated through them. An amount of over 321 crore rupees has been provided for this initiative through the Nirbhaya fund.

Special Camps at Polling Stations for left out eligible voters on Feb. 23 & 24

Port Blair, Feb.20

In view of the ensuing General Elections to Lok Sabha 2019, as per the direction of the Election Commission of India, in order to provide further opportunity in campaign mode to all not enrolled persons to get their names registered in the electoral rolls during continuous updation period, so that no one is deprived of voting right, a special camp will be organized on 23rd February (Saturday) and 24th February, 2019 (Sunday) in each polling station for enrolment of eligible voters. Booth level officers will be present in the camps alongwith copies of the

final electoral rolls and adequate copies of Forms 6, 7, 8 and 8A etc. with him/her to facilitate filling up forms by eligible voters. Also it is informed that the EPIC holders can also check their names in the electoral rolls and fill up Form 6 if their name does not exist in the roll for

some reason. EPIC is only the identification document and does not guarantee franchise if the name of the person is not in the electoral roll of the concerned polling station. All political parties have been requested to avail the facility and depute their BLAs to remain present in

the camp. All interested and left out eligible persons have been requested to avail the facility and enroll their names in the electoral rolls and ensure their participation in the electoral process, a communication from the Deputy Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands said.

Vehicle owners advised to take prior permission before carrying out alteration

It has been noticed that many vehicle owners carry out alteration on their vehicles without taking prior permission from the Registering Authority and ply the vehicles. Owing to such practice, the specifications of the vehicles do not match with the particulars contained in the certificate of

registration or those originally specified by the manufacturer which is violation of section 52 of CMVR. Hence, all the vehicle owners have been advised to take prior permission before carrying out any alteration. If alteration already been done as permissible as per CMVR'1989, then the same

should be intimated to the Registering Authority within 14 days from the date of alteration in the vehicle. Failing to adhere to this provisions, necessary penal action as admissible under the law would be taken against the violators, a communication from the Registering Authority, Directorate of Transport said.

The seventh edition of the global showpiece event for women's T20 cricket will take place across Australia from February 21 to March 8. The tournament will start with



a spectacular opening match between defending champions Australia and India under lights at Sydney Showground Stadium. The final will be played at the

MCG on March 8, 2020 on International Women's Day, presenting a ground-breaking opportunity to set a new world record for attendance at a women's sporting fixture.

IPL 2019 Schedule: IPL schedule announced for first two weeks

New Delhi, Feb 20
Indian Premier League schedule for the first two weeks of the 2019 season has been announced but it will be further assessed when the Lok Sabha polling schedule is released. As per the schedule released on Tuesday (February 19), the season gets underway on March 23 with defending champions Chennai Super Kings (CSK) hosting Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) in Chennai. "This is still subject to the announcement of Lok Sabha 2019 election dates. Once the election dates are released we will address any issues with the first two weeks and also prepare a schedule for the remainder of the season working with

the local authorities around the polling dates."

The current schedule sees 17 matches across the fortnight period with 8 venues of the eight franchises. Delhi Capitals and Royal Challenges will play five matches during this period with the rest playing four each. All teams will play minimum of two home and away games while DC and RCB will be at home at Feroz Shah Kotla and M Chinnaswamy thrice respectively.

"A total of 17 matches will be played during this 2 weeks period across the 8 home venues of the respective franchises. All teams will play minimum of 4 matches with DC and RCB playing 5 matches. Every team will

play minimum of 2 home and 2 away matches with DC playing 3 home matches, while RCB will play 3 away matches," added the statement.

Indonesia submits formal bid to host the 2032 Olympics

Jakarta, Feb 20
Indonesia has submitted a bid to host the 2032 Olympics, officials said Tuesday, after the Southeast Asian nation's widely lauded handling of the Asian Games last summer.

Muliawan Hadad, Indonesia's ambassador to Switzerland, submitted a formal bid letter from President Joko Widodo to the International Olympic Committee (IOC) in Lausanne

last week, the Foreign Ministry confirmed.

"This is the right moment to show Indonesia's capability as a big country," Hadad said in a statement made public this week. Widodo publicly expressed Indonesia's interest in hosting the 2032 event in the capital, Jakarta, during last year's Asian Games - the world's second biggest multi-sport event behind the Olympics. India has also expressed an

interest in hosting the 2032 games while North and South Korea have said they might enter a joint bid.

The IOC will announce the 2032 host by 2025. If successful, Indonesia would be the fourth Asian Olympics host after Japan, South Korea and China. The next Olympics will be in 2020 in Tokyo, while Paris will host it in 2024 and Los Angeles in 2028.

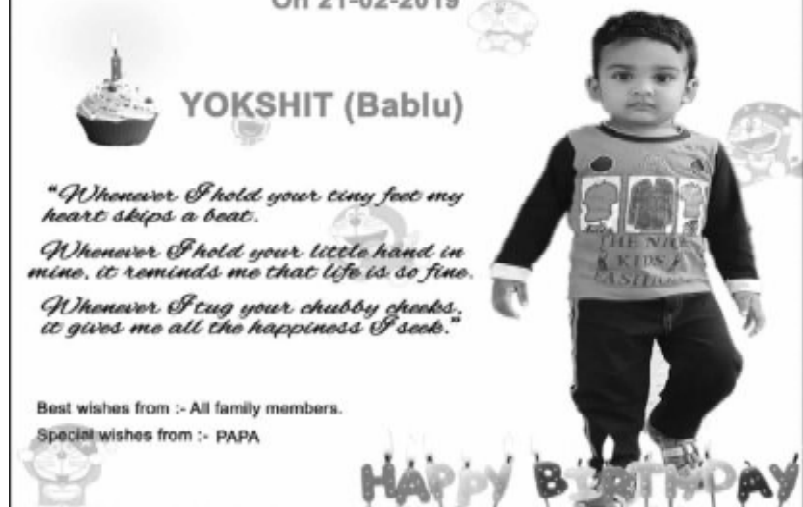
