Sixth Governing Council Meeting of NITI Aayog concludes

Cooperative Federalism is the foundation of India's progress: PM

New Delhi, Feb. 20 (PIB)

The sixth meeting of the Governing Council of NITI Aayog was held today under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi via video conferencing. It was attended by 26 Chief Ministers, 3 Lieutenant Governors and 2 Administrators, apart from Union Ministers, who are Ex-Officio Members, and Special Invitees. NITI Aayog Vice Chairman, Members and CEO, Principal Secretary to the PM & other senior officers from PMO; Cabinet Secretary; and Chief Secretaries of States/ Union Territories also attended the meeting. The meeting was moderated by Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh.

Addressing the event, the Prime Minister said that Cooperative Federalism is the foundation of India's progress. Cooperative and Competitive Federalism should be made more effective and taken to the district level, he said. The country succeeded in managing the challenges posed by the Covid-19 pandemic only because the Centre and the States worked together in a spirit of partnership.

As India stands close to completing 75 years of Independence, this Governing Council meeting assumes even more significance as it provides an opportunity to brainstorm and further strengthen Cooperative and Competitive Federalism, which are essential pillars for successful achievement of the national aspirations, the Prime Minister said.

The Prime Minister said that several concerted steps have been taken to empower the poor and bring about a noticeable change in their lives. Since 2014, more than 2 crore 40 lakh houses have been constructed in both cities and villages. Similarly,

over 3.5 lakh rural houses have been provided with piped drinking water within 18 months of the launch of the Jal Jeevan Mission. He added that the Bharat Net Scheme for internet connectivity in villages is bringing about transformational change. The Prime Minister said the Centre and States should work more closely on such schemes to improve ease of living for our citizens.

The Prime Minister said that the positive response to this year's Union Budget reflects the mood of the nation. There is an all-round eagerness to push forward with economic development. He added that the private sector is coming forward with enthusiasm in the development journey of the country, and the Government must honour this enthusiasm by ensuring opportunities for the private investors to capitalize on the Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan. He added that the Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan is a step towards providing opportunities to everyone to fulfil not only our own needs but also cater to the global demand for goods and services.

The Prime Minister emphasized on strengthening MSMEs and start-ups. Every State, every District, has its unique strengths, he added. He said products should be shortlisted from every District and promoted-this will create healthy competition among all Districts and States, which will help in boosting our exports. He said that the Aspirational Districts Programme implemented in partnership with States holds a unique example in this regard.

In his welcome remarks, Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog, said that this forum enables the identification of key strategies for cohesive action.

3913 divyangs issued e-UDID cards in A&N Islands

The Social Welfare Department, A&N Administration is implementing the Govt. of India scheme of Unique ID for Persons with Disabilities in an effective manner to empower people with Disabilities. The Aadhaar-linked Unique Disability Identity (UDID) Card would

ensure their ease to access various Government schemes & benefits. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India had launched this project in the year 2016 with a view to create a National Database for PwDs, and to issue a Unique Disability Identity Card to each person with disabilities.

The Ministry has so far generated 3913 e-UDID cards for A&N Islands and the coverage rate has also increased benefitting the divyangs in all the three Districts i.e. South Andaman, N&M Andaman and Nicobars.

The Unique Disability ID (UDID) smart card contains

Aviation sector in Isles poised for big leap Ministry of Defence waives off landing charges at Port Blair Airport for promotion of International flights

Port Blair, Feb. 20

In view of the larger interest of development of these Islands, the Ministry of Defence has conveyed its decision to waive off the landing charges at Port Blair Airport initially for a period of three years for promotion of international flights by airlines. This has come, as a result of vigorous follow-ups by A & N Administration with Ministries of Home Affairs and Defence to tap the tourism potential of these Islands.

The A & N Islands are favorably located in close proximity of ASEAN Countries like Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Myanmar and Indonesia to attract foreign tourists. The VSI Airport at Port Blair has already been designated as a port of entry into/ exit from India with valid travel documents (including e-visas) for all class of passengers. Also, the Govt. of India has relaxed the Restricted Area Permit (RAP) for foreign visitors travelling to Islands.

Further, to promote international flights from Port Blair, the A & N Administration has also relaxed the VAT on ATF from 10% to 0% for international flights. All these efforts have brightened the prospects of International flight services ex- Port Blair Airport, a press release from Directorate of Civil Aviation said.

enterprises. Under the scheme, financial assistance in the form of grant/ seed capital would be provided to individuals/SHG's/Co-operatives/Farmer Producers Organizations (FPOs).
The scheme adopts 'One District One Product (ODOP)' approach to reap the benefit of scale in terms of requirements of input, availing common services and marketing of products. The ODOP identified for the South Andaman District is Marine based Fish products and for Nicobar and North & Middle Andaman District is Coconut based products. Applications (offline) have been invited from SHG's/Co-operatives/FPOs seeking assistance under different components of PMFME Scheme. The format of the applications are available in the Directorate of Industries, Port Blair and Extension Offices of the Department of Industries at Bakultala, Diglipur, Car Nicobar & Little Andaman. The eligible SHG's/Co-operatives/FPOs (existing/new) willing to avail assistance under the scheme may submit their application in offline/ physical mode along with supportive documents. with senior State officials on 6th February, 2021, the feedback for which was duly incorporated while curating the agenda of the meeting.
The Council deliberated on several steps for making India a manufacturing powerhouse, such as reducing compliance burden, initiating reforms at the State level, improving logistics, promoting exports through district-level competition and creating jobs. For improving physical infrastructure, the Chief Ministers expressed the need to raise public capital investment and completing projects under the National Infrastructure Pipeline, while enhancing investments in infrastructure through private and Public Private Partnerships, improving last-mile connectivity, reducing energy costs and configuring an enhanced and efficient role of States in project implementation.
States/UTs also mentioned efforts made to improve water accessibility, supply of quality and reliable power, internet connectivity and bandwidth availability, quality healthcare services, sustainable agricultural practices to mitigate the risks of climate change, undertake suitable reforms to build an advanced manufacturing and innovation ecosystem, thereby bolstering exports through the One District One Product initiative, apart from building on futuristic tech and inclusive governance models. The Chief Ministers also noted marked improvement in the development of physical infrastructure, including digital connectivity, across the North-Eastern region, along with a greater thrust on the Act East Policy, with the aim of providing impetus to the economies of the NE States. Keeping in mind the aspirations of a young country like India, the Prime Minister stressed on the need to build modern infrastructure. He said the youth plays an important role in catalysing change in the country and cited the success of Digital India campaign to emphasise this point. Innovation must be encouraged, and more technology should be used to provide better opportunities for education and skill development.
The Governing Council Meeting seeks to build on the strength of every State so that everyone can learn from each other's best practices. The Council members deliberated on strengthening institutions for skilling, reskilling, and upskilling of workforce. Focus was also laid on improving service delivery at the grassroots level, by ensuring digital infrastructure for the rural regions. Various Chief Ministers presented best practices from their respective States that can serve as templates for replication across the country. The Prime Minister said policy frameworks and better coordination between the Centre and States are very important. He said the Centre and States must synchronise their budgets to ensure multiplier effect. Technology and community partnership are equally important. The Prime Minister said the Central Government has introduced the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for various sectors, thus providing an excellent opportunity to increase manufacturing in the country. He urged the States to take full advantage of this scheme and attract maximum global investments and reap the benefits of reduced corporate tax rates.
The Prime Minister said geospatial data was liberalized recently, which would incentivise entrepreneurial endeavour, start-up innovation and the tech sector in general. Focus must be on ease-of-doing business for the international audience and on ease-of-living for our own people, he added. Even though India is an agricultural economy, it still imports many inputs, the Prime Minister said. He stressed on becoming self-reliant in this area. There are many agricultural products that can be not only produced for the country but also supplied to the rest of the world. For this, he insisted, it is necessary that all States make an agro-climatic regional planning strategy.
The Prime Minister also urged for focus on storage and processing of agricultural products to reduce wastage. Reforms are very important for farmers to get the necessary economic resources, better infrastructure and modern technology, he said. The Prime Minister welcomed the rich discussion and constructive suggestions by the Council members, assuring that they would be carefully considered while taking decisions. He expressed confidence that with collective efforts, the aspirations of the people will be fulfilled. This Governing Council meeting paved the way for synergies across all tiers of the Government, with substantial collaboration and cooperation in the Agenda items. The meeting provided an opportunity to address the objectives of advancing economic, social and demographic welfare.

details such as disability percentage, personal details, identity, employment details, education details and bank account numbers of a person with disability. With UDID card, the divyangs are eligible for free aids and appliances as per their abnormality/ deformity from ALIMCO. They will get priority in medical treatment, priority at ticket counters, priorities in hearing of their grievances, free bus passes and free ship tickets in mainland bound ships once in a year and inter-islands ships and boats as and when required, scholarship for students etc. The project has not only brought transparency, efficiency and ease of delivering the government benefits to the person with disabilities, but also ensured uniformity. It has helped in stream-lining the tracking of beneficiary at all levels of hierarchy of implementation-at village level, block level, District level, State level and National level.
The Departments of Health and Social Welfare are coordinating to help the disabled get disability certificate from the notified medical authorities. A divyang with multiple disabilities is assessed by a Medical Board comprising of Specialists to assess the percentage of disability and issue the Disability Certificate after which it is uploaded on the national portal www.swavlambancard.gov.in.
The smart card has eliminated the hassles of the disabled to carry their disability certificates for different purposes since details about the type of disabilities that they suffer from are included in the card. Moreover, the UDID cards will be valid all over the country. As a result, the divyang need not make multiple copies of documents or carry multiple documents as the UDID card will capture all the necessary details which can be decoded with the help of a reader. The UDID card is the single document of identification, verification of the disabled for availing various benefits.

Melbourne, Feb. 20
Japan's Naomi Osaka cemented her place as the outstanding star of the women's singles game by beating American Jennifer Brady in the Australian Open final to win her fourth Grand Slam title. Osaka, has remained unbeaten in major finals after today's 6-4, 6-3 win in Melbourne. Osaka edged the first set when Brady, in her first Grand Slam final, paid for some glaring errors in the final game. The third seed seized control from that point, racing 4-0 ahead in the second set before sealing a deserved victory.
Osaka has now won two Australian Open titles after also triumphing at Melbourne Park in 2019, with her other Grand Slam successes coming at the US Open in 2018 and 2020. She has not suffered a defeat since February 2020 after winning her past 20 matches.
In the Mixed Doubles, Barbora Krejickova of Czech Republic and Rajeev Ram of US clinched the title. They defeated the Australian pair of Samantha Stosur and Matthew Ebden 6-1, 6-4 in the final match later in the day.
The Mens' Singles final will be played tomorrow. The title will set up a blockbuster against World No.1 and defending champion Novak Djokovic as Medvedev searching for his grand slam title.

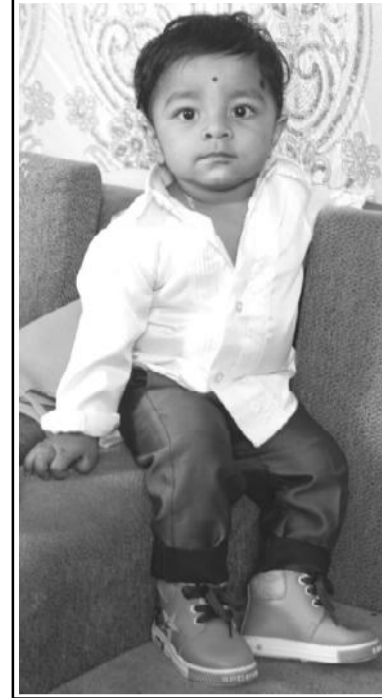
