New Delhi, April 20 (PIB)

Port Blair, April 20

Despite the robust vaccination drive being carried out by the Administration in different parts of A&N Islands besides significant increase in the number of testing and strict enforcement of COVID-19 appropriate behavior by Police & concerned authorities, the Islands are witnessing a steep rise in the number of COVID positive cases. A large number of positive cases are seen in the passengers coming from mainland. There have also been

some reports of tampering with RTPCR negative report by the incoming passengers and the Administration has lodged FIR against such errant passengers. In view of this, it was deemed necessary by the Administration to take proactive steps in order to protect the lives of the children, senior citizens and residents of these Islands. The Administration after reviewing the situation arising due to consistent rise in the number of COVID cases has announced measures to contain spread of

COVID-19 cases in the Islands. Accordingly, the following decisions have been taken to curb the spread of COVID positive cases in A&N Islands for the safety of the people:

- Existing Corona curfew has been revised from 10 pm to 5 am to 9 pm to 5 am with immediate effect.
- Activities attracting large gathering like Light & Sound Show at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Island and National Memorial Cellular Jail, water sports activities,

beaches and other such activities have been suspended in all the three Districts for 4 weeks from April 22.

- Cinema Halls to remain closed for a period of 4 weeks with effect from April 22.
- Market places like super stores, grocery stores, malls etc. advised to strictly regulate entry and follow COVID appropriate behaviour protocol.
- For safety of the Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG), people belonging to

COVID vaccination drive in A&N Islands Vaccines are an infallible weapon against novel coronavirus; people above 45+ urged to vaccinate themselves About 90,000 doses of vaccine administered so far

Port Blair, April 20

The response from the people to the COVID vaccination drive launched by the A&N Administration has been overwhelming with more and more eligible citizens getting themselves vaccinated. The vaccination sessions are being held in more than 30 designated vaccination centres set up in different parts of the Islands. Altogether, 77 medical teams today administered Covishield vaccine to the eligible



persons above 45+. The district wise figure administering of COVISHIELD doses to the eligible beneficiaries on April 20 by the Health Department states that in South Andaman, 1927 persons above 45+ were administered the vaccine, in North Andaman, the figure of vaccinated persons stood at 1149 and in Nicobar District, 72 were vaccinated. The total vaccination doses administered to the beneficiaries has now reached 89,986. Today

(April 20), the medical teams in different designated Vaccination Centres have administered 3148 doses of COVISHIELD vaccine to the eligible persons.

For the benefit of the eligible citizens and to cover maximum people above 45+, the vaccination drive is being carried out by the teams of the Health Department on all days of the week including Sundays and holidays. To facilitate the general public, facility for onsite registration has also been created for those who are not able to register their names on COWIN portal.

All Islanders have been appealed to follow appropriate COVID-19 behavior due to the increase in the number of COVID cases in A&N Islands. People have been informed that maintaining social distance, washing hands and face along with wearing face masks appropriately is the key to restrict the spread of COVID cases in Isles.

Defence Minister instructs to utilize defence medical facilities to treat civilian people for COVID-19

New Delhi, April 20
Defence Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh has instructed to utilize the defence medical facilities to treat civilian people for COVID-19. He has also instructed to utilize additional capacity and resources to provide relief to the people in the wake of rising cases of Coronavirus in the country.

The Defence Minister today chaired a meeting to review the Defence Ministry's preparations and response to COVID-19 situation. The meeting was attended by the three Service Chiefs, Chief of Defence Staff General Bipin Rawat, Defence Secretary, DRDO Chairman and Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services. During the meeting, Shri Rajnath said that all the requirements will be fulfilled through emergency purchases. He asked to enhance the oxygen availability for the defence and civilian purpose.

Earlier, Defence Minister spoke to Army Chief General MM Naravane, Defence Secretary and DRDO chief and asked them to offer available facilities and expertise to civilians during the COVID-19 crisis. Shri Singh also directed Army Chief that local commanders must reach out to Chief Ministers and offer all possible help. Following it, the Defence Secretary also issued instructions to 67 Cantonment Board Hospitals across the country to extend medical services to every patient who reaches out to them. production and supply are on at various levels. Measures like installing new oxygen plants, providing one lakh new cylinders, diverting oxygen from the industrial use, Oxygen Rail are being undertaken.

The Prime Minister said that our scientists came out with the vaccine in a very short time and today India has the cheapest vaccine in the world which is compatible with the cold-chain available in India. Due to this team effort, India has embarked upon the world's largest vaccination drive with two 'made in India' Vaccines. From the very first phase of the vaccination drive, it has been emphasized that the vaccine reaches the maximum areas and to the people who need it. India gave first 10 crore, 11 crore and the 12 crore vaccine doses in the shortest time in the world.

Speaking about the yesterday's vaccine related decision, the Prime Minister said that after 1st May, every person above 18 years of age can be vaccinated. Half of the vaccine produced in India will go directly to the states and hospitals. By opening vaccination for 18 years and above population, vaccine will be available quickly for the workforce in the cities. The Prime Minister said that we have much better knowledge and resources to meet the challenge than the initial days of the first wave. Shri Modi credited the people of India for a good and patient fight. He said, with the strength of people's participation, we will be able to defeat this wave of Corona too. He saluted the contribution of social organizations who are helping the people in the time of need and called upon everyone to move forward to help the people who require help.

The Prime Minister, called upon the youth to help in maintaining COVID appropriate behaviour in their areas and neighbourhood. This will help in avoiding containment zones, curfews or lockdowns. He also asked children to create an atmosphere where their family members avoid going out unnecessarily.

Police have been asked to intensify their enforcement drive against people not following COVID appropriate behaviour viz. not wearing masks, not maintaining social distancing and crowding at places.

Keeping in view the convenience of the people at large, shops, markets, grocery stores, etc. will remain open but the residents are advised to minimize their movements and help the Administration in controlling the spread of COVID-19 in Isles. Door to door collection of segregated waste by PBMC

The Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) has already implemented door to door collection of segregated waste to achieve 100% processing of waste by means of waste transportation & proper disposal mechanism. All concerned household Govt. & Pvt./Institutions and other establishments hazardous waste in their premises / establishments to support our municipal workers for further segregation in an effective manner.

The user charge against collection of waste by PBMC as per the provisions of PBMC Solid Waste Handling & Management (SWHM) Bye-Laws, 2017 will be collected from each and every household & all other establishments as per schedule-I of by-laws. In order to maintain the city clean & Swachh, all the Officials not below the rank of Sanitary Inspectors have been authorized to take action by penalizing on the spot under the said bye-laws for household waste that is not segregated. Any violation of Bye-Laws/directions of PBMC will be viewed seriously and necessary action will be initiated against the violators under PBMC SWHM Bye-Laws, 2017. Measures to contain spread of COVID-19 infection

Only emergency & semi emergency surgeries to be performed at GB Pant Hospital

Port Blair, April 20

In view of sudden surge in COVID-19 cases and to contain the spread of COVID-19 infection effectively, the competent authority has decided to implement the following restrictions in the GB Pant Hospital, Port Blair.

As per an order issued by Medical Superintendent, GB Pant Hospital, all elective surgeries will be discontinued forthwith and only emergency and semi emergency surgeries shall be carried out by observing extant COVID-19 protocol until COVID-19 protocol improves considerably.

Only genuine emergency cases that cannot be treated at home under any circumstances will be considered for admission in the Hospital. The cases of ILI/SARI reporting in the OPD will be isolated and admitted in Nursing Home.

Every attempt will be made to discharge admitted patients at the earliest so that large parts of the Hospital can be earmarked for the treatment of COVID patients and a bare minimum number of wards/beds are spared for use of non-COVID patients in the unlikely event of an exponential rise of moderate to severe cases of COVID-19 infection in these Islands.

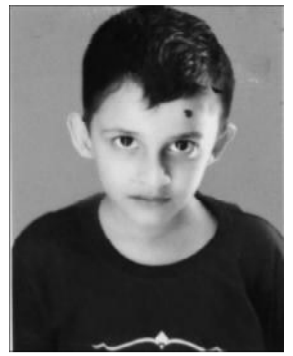

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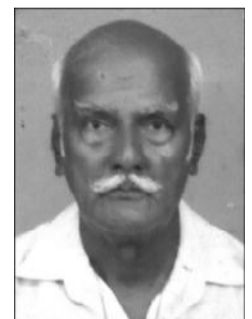
