## Vice President asks healthcare professionals, local bodies & communities to join hands to build a Swachh Bharat

New Delhi, May 18  
The Vice President of India, Shri M Venkaiah Naidu today addressed the Annual Convocation of Lady Hardinge Medical College (LHMC) in presence of Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey and Smt Anupriya Patel, Ministers of State for Health and Family Welfare. Addressing the participants, the Vice President of India stated training of young professionals in the sciences and art of medicine is one of the most sacred duties one can ever perform. "You are not only imparting knowledge and helping students imbibe skills but you are also facilitating the internalization of a set of values. Patience, understanding, empathy, soothing expression and skillful assessment are crucial for a successful career in medicine," the Vice President said. In his address, the Vice President further stated that the private sector must not only supplement the efforts



of the government in bridging the urban-rural divide in the health sector, but must adopt a more humane and philanthropic approach and ensure that healthcare is affordable and accessible. Shri Naidu also lauded the government for Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Swasthya Suraksha Mission (PMRSSM) that will provide universal health care to 50 crore poor and vulnerable people. He urged the students to maintain the highest standards of ethics and integrity at every stage. "I

am sure that all the students of the Lady Hardinge Medical College will carry on the legacy of this prestigious institute and contribute towards building a healthy India," the Vice President added. Congratulating the students, Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey, Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare said that the students graduating today must not stop learning and should always enhance their skills and knowledge. They must not also forget their responsibility towards the society and the patients

they are treating. "The main aim of your training is to serve people and poverty should never come in between. "The advice you give to your patients should not result in destitution. No person should be left without treatment due to lack of money," Shri Choubey said. Highlighting the initiatives of the Ministry, Shri Choubey stated that the Government has increased the age of retirement of doctors to 65 years and is setting up of more medical and nursing schools. He further said that the

government is multi-skilling doctors to overcome the shortage of specialists. Shri Choubey said that the introduction of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) would benefit students' fraternity across the country as they will not have to appear in multiple entrance exams and such an exam will lead to greater transparency, reduce the burden on prospective students, mitigate litigation in various courts of law with respect to the examination process and ensure better standards of Medical Education. Shri Choubey further said that suitable amendments have also been carried out in the Graduate Medical Education Regulations and Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations for making common counseling for admission in Medical Colleges mandatory and existing medical colleges are being upgraded by setting up of Super Speciality Blocks in 70 such

**No Day/Night Tests till our players are ready: CoA chief Vinod Rai**

New Delhi, May 18  
The Committee of Administrators (CoA) chief Vinod Rai on Thursday firmly backed the Indian cricket team's decision of not playing Day/Night pink ball Test against Australia during the upcoming tour Down Under at the end of the year. "What's wrong in us wanting to win all the matches? Any team that steps out on a pitch wants to win. 30 years back they said India play Test matches only to draw but they don't say that anymore," Rai said at historian Boria Majumdar's book launch in Delhi. The former CAG said that India will play day-night Tests only when the players are ready. "Till the time Indian

players say that they are ready to play day-night matches there will be no day-night matches that India will play," BCCI CEO Rahul Johri also defended the board's decision. "Who we play, when we play, where we play and how we play is our prerogative. We will back everything for the Indian team to play to win," said Johri. The move by many has been perceived by many as India's win at all costs strategy. Former Australian cricketer Mark Waugh however, has labelled the move as "selfish." "It's a little bit selfish from India's point of view because we need to revitalise Test cricket," Waugh said on Australia's Big Sports Breakfast radio show.

Interestingly, India, who are slated to host West Indies in a two-match Test series before flying to Australia, were expected to play one day-night Test in October which is now not happening. Rai however said that BCCI has done 90 percent things correctly over the years and the 10 percent that needs to be corrected will be done in due course of time. As he was speaking at cricket historian Boria Majumdar's book launch, Rai said: "BCCI had done tremendous work in terms of building infrastructure. Ninety percent of the things that they have done is good work. It is the 10 percent work that needs a course correction and that will be done."

**Indian women's hockey team ready for Korean challenge**

Donghae City, May 18  
Donghae City: The Indian women's hockey team will take on hosts Korea in its last round-robin match at the 5th Women's Asian Champions Trophy. The team led by defender Sunita Lakra remains unbeaten in the tournament, having won against Japan (4-1), China (3-1) and Malaysia (3-2). While playing the World No.9 side in their home ground will be a challenging affair for the Indian team, it will serve as an ideal preparation for the Final on Sunday where they will play Korea who have won two matches (3-1 against Malaysia, 3-1 against China) and drawn one (1-1 against Japan) in the round-robin stage. "Korea is a good team, but our girls have played this tournament with a lot of confidence. We are not so bothered about this being their home ground but want to just focus on ourselves and carry forward the good momentum," stated chief coach Sjoerd Marjine. The team has played this tournament with aggression



and have showcased impressive attack. But playing a highly defensive team like Korea, India needs to ensure they don't make errors. "The Koreans like to play high press. It will be important for us to not let that pressure affect our game and we need to ensure we don't make mistakes in our own half. Besides this, we will need to move the ball fast to create space," added the chief coach on the eve of the match. While India were lethal against Japan and a higher ranked China, having taken a strong lead at the start of the match, India dropped their level against Malaysia. Marjine said, "It is not always easy to play against a team who play with 11 players in their circle. To

New Delhi, May 18  
The President of Badminton Association of India (BAI), Himanta Biswa Sarma was today elected as the Vice-President of Badminton Asia Confederation (BAC). The election took place during the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the continental body in Bangkok, Thailand. After the AGM, Mr Sarma thanked all the member bodies of BAC and vowed to contribute more for developing the sport in the region and bringing in better coordination among



Asian countries. He said, his appointment as BAC Vice President was yet another proof of how India is perceived globally when it comes to growth of the sport and in providing visionary leadership. Congratulating Mr Sarma, BAI General Secretary Ajay Kumar Singhania said, this appointment will be a huge boost for Indian badminton.

**Rafael Nadal avenges Denis Shapovalov defeat in Rome; Novak Djokovic through**

Rome, May 18  
Seven-time champion Rafael Nadal methodically wore down Denis Shapovalov 6-4, 6-1 Thursday to reach the Italian Open's last eight and gain revenge over the Canadian teenager. Four-time Rome winner Novak Djokovic reached his first quarterfinal of the year with a 6-1, 7-5 victory over Alberto Ramos-Vinolas. Djokovic next faces Kei Nishikori, who rolled past Philipp Kohlschreiber 6-1, 6-2. The 19-year-old Shapovalov stunned Nadal in the third round in Montreal last year to deny the Spanish player a chance to regain the No. 1 spot. Nadal is also attempting to win the top spot back this week. He'll replace Roger Federer if he wins an eighth Rome title. In a match between two left-handers, Shapovalov saved eight break points in his opening two



service games before finally dropping his serve midway through the first set. "He was really serving big and I had some mistakes with the return," Nadal said. "It was not a comfortable match against a lefty who serves big and goes for his shots. "He's good in all aspects. The only thing he needs is a little bit more time." Shapovalov was stretched to three sets in his opening two matches, against 15th-seeded Tomas Berdych and Robin Haase, and reached the semifinals of last week's Madrid Open. "I didn't feel completely

dead out there but I felt like I could've been fresher," Shapovalov said. Nadal, who hasn't won the Italian Open since 2013, next faces Fabio Fognini, who beat Peter Gojowczyk 6-4, 6-4. Fognini slammed his racket midway through the second set and received a warning from the umpire but otherwise held his composure to follow up an impressive win over Dominic Thiem. Defending champion Alexander Zverev needed eight match points before completing a 7-5, 7-6 (11) win over Kyle Edmund.

**Saudi Arabia to host Formula E's 2018-19 season opener**

London, May 18  
The all-electric Formula E motor racing series will start its 2018-19 season in Saudi Arabia, the world's top oil exporter, organisers said on Thursday. The December race in Riyadh's Ad Diriyah district, on the outskirts of the capital, will be the first involving the season five next generation cars and marks Formula E's debut in the Middle East. The city-based series said it had reached a 10-year agreement with the kingdom's General Sports Authority and national motor federation. "Saudi Arabia is looking to the future and Formula E is the motorsport of the future," Prince Abdulaziz bin Turki Al Faisal al Saud, vice-chair of the GSA, said in a statement on the Formula E website (www.fiatformulae.com). "It aligns perfectly with the



country's 2030 vision and offers the prospect of world-class racing on the streets of the capital for the first time in our history," he added. "This is the latest in a series of game-changing sports events that the people of Saudi Arabia will now be able to enjoy as families, with benefits that go far beyond the sport to deliver a positive impact across our society." Saudi Arabia announced last year that, from June, women would be allowed to drive cars -- ending the world's only ban on female driving. In January, women fans were allowed to attend a men's soccer match for the first time.

"Many other sports are already increasing their presence in Saudi Arabia and we're proud that they've chosen Formula E over other categories in racing," said Formula E founder and chief executive Alejandro Agag. "Most countries are now looking to Formula E, especially Saudi Arabia which is concentrating on the development of new technologies, renewable energies and electric vehicles." Saudi Arabia is targeting 9.5 gigawatts of annual renewable energy by 2023 in line with Vision 2030, an economic reform plan launched in 2016 to diversify the economy beyond oil.
