Apex Court directs Centre, to prepare urgent time bound programme to make payment of wages to workers under MGNREGA

New Delhi, May 19 The Supreme Court has directed the Centre, in consultation with states, to prepare an urgent time bound mandatory programme to make the payment of wages and compensation to the workers under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA). A bench of Justice M.B. Lokur and Justice N.V. Ramana yesterday made it clear and directed that in terms of the MGNREGA



and Schedule II thereof a worker is entitled to the payment of wages within a fortnight of the date on which the work was done. In case of failing it, the

worker is entitled to the compensation. The bench said, the burden of compliance is on the state governments and Union (Contd. on last page)

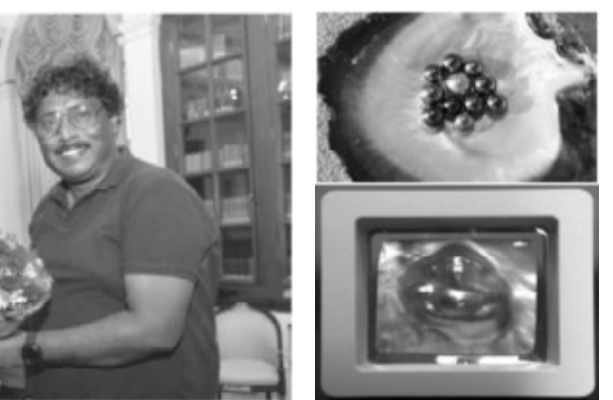

India 3rd largest solar market in world: Mercom

New Delhi, May 19 India emerged as the third largest solar market in the world in 2017 behind China and the US, Mercom Communications India said in a report. "In 2017, India emerged as the third largest solar market having grown at a CAGR of approximately 170 percent since 2010," it said. As per the report, India set a new record with 9.6 GW of solar installations in 2017, which was more than double the

4.3 GW installed in 2016. The robust growth boosted the country's total solar installed capacity to 19.6 GW as of December 2017, it added. "In 2017, larger players started consolidating their positions at the top as India quickly emerged as one of the most important solar markets in the world for suppliers and vendors," Mercom Capital Group CEO Shri Raj Prabhu said. Foreign nations have shown interest in Akash missile: DRDO

Coimbatore, May 19 Several countries have evinced interest in procuring the indigenously developed Akash missile, a top Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) official said here today. There is a growing demand for the Akash, an all-weather medium-range surface-to-air missile, and many nations have shown interest in it, DRDO

Chairman S. Christopher told reporters here. Developed by the DRDO, the Akash missile system has the capability to neutralise aerial targets such as fighter jets, cruise missiles and air-to-surface missiles as well as ballistic missiles. Talks were underway with the countries and "it (orders for the missile) will come", Christopher said without divulging further details.

To a query on the allocation for research and development, he said this year the organisation has a budgetary allocation of Rs 2,000 crore. Christopher, who was here to participate in a function, also said there were export inquiries for the BrahMos missile. BrahMos is a joint venture between the DRDO of India and the NPO Mashinostroyeniya (NPOM) of Russia.

CET for GP Rating Course on June 14

Port Blair, May 19 A Common Entrance Test for selecting candidates to GP Rating Course will be conducted at Dr B R Ambedkar Institute of Technology, Port Blair from 2nd July, 2018. The candidates eligible for the entrance test should have at least 40% marks in aggregate in class Xth from a recognized Board, with Science, English &

Maths as subjects, should be in the age between 17 1/2 to 25 yrs on the date of commencement of the course and having normal color vision 6/6 in both eyes without aids. The Common Entrance Test will comprise of two components viz. Written test for 50 marks and Physical endurance test for 50 marks. The written test would be based on the

syllabus of class X (CBSE) and will consist of four modules - English- 15 marks, Science- 15 marks, Maths- 15 marks and G K (related to geography and shipping)- 05 marks. The physical endurance test will have 5 components viz. 400mts, Push-ups, Sit-ups, Pass under the table and climbing stairs. Donghae City, May 19
In Women's Hockey, India played out a 1-1 draw against South Korea in their final round-robin match of the Asian Champions Trophy at Donghae City. The hosts drew first blood after Cheon scored in the 20th minute. Lalremisiami, then, brought defending champions India on level terms with a goal in the 49th minute. The match can be seen as a warm up to tomorrow's Final, as both teams have made it to the summit clash. The Indian eves, led by defender Sunita Lakra, are unbeaten in the

Italian Open: Marin Cilic Beats Pablo Carreno Busta To Reach Semis

Rome, May 19
Fifth-ranked Croatian Marin Cilic rolled past Spain's Pablo Carreno Busta 6-3, 6-3 to reach the semi-finals of the Italian Open tennis tournament and book his first-ever berth in the final four of a clay-court ATP World Tour Masters 1000 event. The 2014 US Open champion, a big server whose greatest success has come on hard and grass courts, needed just an hour and five minutes to clinch his third win over the 11th-ranked Spaniard in as many career matches, reports Efe news agency. The 29-year-old Cilic won the contest in a straight-forward fashion, not facing a single break point on serve and going three-for-three on his break-point chances. "I'm feeling great (after



reaching) my first semi-final on clay at a Masters 1000 event," Cilic said. "I was waiting many years for it to happen, so it's definitely a happy moment for sure." Cilic, who is eyeing a second Masters 1000 title following his 2016 Cincinnati Masters triumph, will next take on either

German defending champion and world No. 3 Alexander Zverev or 10th-ranked Belgian David Goffin. Nearly all of tennis' top men's and women's players are in Rome to tune their games for the year's biggest clay-court tournament, the French Open, which gets underway on May 27.

Italian Open: Rafael Nadal To Meet Novak Djokovic In Semifinals

Rome, May 19
Novak Djokovic set up an Italian Open semi-final blockbuster against old rival Rafael Nadal after both former world number one players battled back in thrilling last-eight clashes on Friday. The Serb fought back against Kei Nishikori to earn a 2-6, 6-1, 6-3 win while top seed Nadal continued his clay court domination with a 4-6, 6-1, 6-2 defeat of Italy's Fabio Fognini. On a dramatic and exhausting day in the Italian capital, there were also quarter-final wins for three-time winner Maria Sharapova and defending men's champion Alexander Zverev. Djokovic, seeded 11th after his elbow injury problems, beat Japan's top player for the 12th time in succession. "It was a fantastic match, we



went toe-to-toe all the way to last shot. He started, he was flawless from both ends," said Djokovic who will face Nadal for the 51st time, holding a narrow 26-24 advantage. Nadal beat Djokovic in their last meeting in May in 2017 in a Madrid semi-final and the Serb will be out for revenge after winning seven in a row prior to that. "We will see tomorrow. I've not played so many matches in

the last six months," said Djokovic whose last semi-final spot was in Eastbourne on the eve of Wimbledon in 2017. Nadal dropped the opening set to Fognini in an hour but regrouped effortlessly as he swept past the Italian in the one-sided second and third sets. "I'm not used to playing so early," Nadal said of his midday start. "But I'm very happy to be in the semi-finals."

India's Shivangi Pathak has become youngest women of the country to scale Mt Everest from Nepal side.

16-year-old Shivangi successfully stood atop world's highest mountain on Thursday morning. Born in Hisar of Haryana Shivangi climbed Mt Everest to spread the message that women could overcome any

obstacle to achieve their goals. She was inspired by Arunima Sinha, the first Indian amputee to climb Mt Everest. In 2014, 13 year old Malavath Pooma from India had climbed Mt Everest from Tibet side and

became youngest girl in the world to summit at Everest. Meanwhile, two more mountaineers from India, Bhagwan Chawale and Prajit Pardesi have also successfully scaled tallest peak on the earth on Thursday.

Ahmedabad, May 19
In Gujarat, 19 people including women and children, were killed and 6 others injured in a road accident near Bavalyali village on Bhavnagar-Ahmedabad highway today. The accident occurred when a truck carrying about 25 people, turned turtle and fell into a ditch. The injured have been admitted to Bhavnagar Government Hospital.

Over 100 killed in plane crash near Havana airport



Havana, May 19
In Cuba, more than 100 people have died after a Boeing 737 airliner crashed near Jose Marti International Airport in Havana. A Cuban-operated airliner with at least 110 people aboard crashed and burned in a cassava field just after takeoff from the airport yesterday. According to state media, three people have survived but are in a critical condition. Airport sources said the jetliner was heading from the capital of Havana to the eastern city of Holguin. The cause of the disaster was under investigation. Authorities said there were 104 passengers and nine crew members on the flight, operated by Cubana, the state airline. Four crash survivors were taken to Havana hospital, and three remained alive.
