Privatization of Power sector in A&N Islands First Steering Committee Meeting held; progress of all UTs to ensure timely completion of privatization reviewed

Privatization to bring in improvement in power quality/reliability & customer service outcomes

Entire process of privatization to be completed by December, 2020

Port Blair, July 20

Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan is the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India for making India a self-reliant nation. As part of the Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Economic Package, which was announced in the background of COVID-19 pandemic, numerous decisions were taken which includes boosting scope for private participation in numerous sectors. Power being a vital sector for the growth of economy and infrastructure, the Ministry of Power has responded to the call of **Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan** and has taken a decision to privatize the distribution sector in all the UTs. The success stories of these UTs will later act as a demonstration for privatizing inefficient State owned DISCOMs.

The rationale for privatization in UTs is to bring in efficiency improvement by bringing down the losses, improvement in power quality/reliability and customer service outcomes and modernization of the distribution system with minimal investment. Pursuant to this decision, there was a joint meeting with the Ministry of Power and Ministry of Home Affairs with all the UTs wherein they were advised to convey the in-principle approval of their Administration for the privatization of distribution system in power sector. Accordingly, the UT Administration of A&N Islands has conveyed the in-principle decision for privatization of distribution system with the approval of Hon'ble Lt. Governor in the month of June, 2020, after which there were number of meetings held with MoP on the subject.

M/s Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu India LLP, Gurgaon has been appointed as the Transaction Advisor for the UT of A&N Islands and shall be responsible for all activities required for privatization like, designing a transaction strategy, assessment of feasibility, financial restructuring and transition financing, baseline data study, AT&C losses, designing a staff transfer scheme, preparation of bid document and providing assistance in conducting bid

process. The Electricity Department has been sharing the required data to the transaction advisor, as per their request for formulating the transaction strategy.

As per the timelines given by the Ministry of Power, the entire process shall be completed by the end of this year i.e. December, 2020. The advantages that are expected from the privatization of the distribution sector is reduction in the losses and increase in the revenue by

improved metering, billing and collection, other technological interventions to improve the power supply quality and its reliability, consumer satisfaction by better management of the consumer related grievances and their fast redressal.

A steering committee has been constituted by the Ministry of Power, to guide & steer the initiative of privatization of the distribution systems in the UTs with the Chief Secretary, A&N Islands, as one of its member. The first steering committee meeting chaired by the Secretary (MoP) was held on virtual platform today, to monitor the progress of all the UTs in order to ensure timely completion of the transaction process and decisions were taken with the objective to complete the entire process of privatization by end of 2020. In future also, such high level

Fisheries Department gears up to implement 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana' in A&N Islands

Deptt. working on utilization of fisheries potential from 30% to 50 % through PMMSY by next 5 years

Port Blair, July 20

The Government of India has announced 'Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) - An umbrella Scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India', with a total investment of Rs. 20,050.00 Crores, with a vision to enhance fish production and productivity in all the States and Union Territories.

The scheme is also aimed at modernizing and strengthening of value chain - post-harvest management and quality improvement with the objective of socio-economic security and doubling of farmers/fishers income; besides generating income and employment.

For the implementation of the scheme in A&N Islands, a Union Territory Level Approval and Monitoring Committee (UTLAMC) and District level committee (DLC) have been constituted. The Department has identified a

tentative proposal amounting Rs.53.78 Crores for the year 2020-2021 and the draft proposals have been placed in the District Level Committees for their recommendation. The final project proposals will be submitted to the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Govt. of India shortly.

The marine fisheries sector will be boosted further with the introduction of deep sea fishing vessels and up-gradation of existing fishing vessels for export competency. Major projects proposed for meeting the infrastructure need includes development of minor fishing harbour at Betapur, Slipway at Junglighat Fish Landing Centre and construction of boat repairing yard at Rangat. Two integrated modern coastal fishing villages have been proposed in N&M Andaman and South Andaman for better social security and empowerment of

Fisher community through participation along value chain.

The mariculture possibilities in the Islands will be explored with the promotion of open sea cage culture, seaweed farming and by facilitating supply of inputs. To overcome the impediment of non-availability of fish seed for mariculture activity, a small marine fin fish hatchery is also proposed to be established in private sector. The urbanized aquaculture practices like Biofloc and Re-Circulatory Aquaculture Systems and Backyard

Ornamental Fish Rearing Units will also be popularized through PMMSY.

Further, specific pilot project in collaboration with CSIR-CSMCRI for identifying suitable species and areas to popularize seaweed farming and documentation of fish catch data and potential analysis by ICAR-CMFRI for future planning and development of fisheries sector will also be implemented

**Enrolment of farmers under PMFBY for Kharif-2020
 Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare
 appeals to farmers to insure crops**

Cut-off date for enrolment in A&N Islands is August 15

New Delhi/ Port Blair, July 20

The enrolment of farmers under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) for Kharif-2020 season is going on in full swing in various States and UTs of the country. The Government of India has made enrolment free for all the farmers who only need to pay premium amount. PMFBY has been presently notified for implementation throughout A & N for Kharif season 2020. The cut-off date for the enrolment under the scheme for Kharif 2020 in A&N Islands is August 15, 2020. Under the scheme, Paddy crop is presently notified for insurance. As per the guidelines of PMFBY, 2% of the sum insured is to be paid by the farmers as insurance premium after availing subsidy under

the scheme. However, in the case of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, farmers need to pay only 0.5% of the sum insured while the remaining amount is additionally borne as subsidy by the A & N Administration. It means that the approximate premium to be paid by farmer in Islands is only Rs. 320-340 per Ha. thereby, availing insurance cover of up to Rs. 68000 per Ha. (approx.).

In order to motivate the farmers, the Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar has appealed to them to get enrolled under PMFBY through a video message and requested all farmers to protect themselves against financial loss due to crop failures/damages

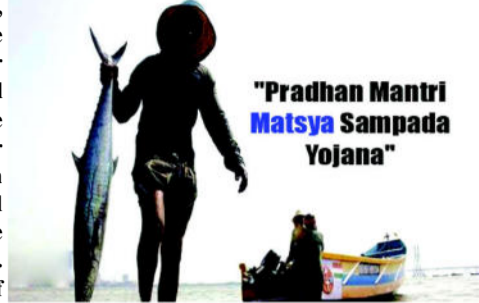

meetings shall be held regularly as the whole activity of privatization of the distribution system is being monitored at the highest level, a press release from Electricity Department said.

marketing network, suitable schemes have been proposed for extending financial assistance to the stakeholders for procurement of fish transport vehicles and establishment of ice plant/cold storages. The empowerment of



women by extending support to develop value added enterprises and to open Kiosk by forming SHGs/Co-operatives/Fish Producer's Organizations in a cluster mode would be encouraged. This will enable branding and marketing of fishes and value added products in the domestic as well as export market. .

The social security of fishermen will also be taken care by covering all the active fishers (Approx.15,000 Nos.) with insurance in case of death or permanent disability while fishing. The Premium towards insurance will be met under PMMSY. The safety of fishing vessels while at sea is also being ensured through insurance premium subvention.

The linkage between Department and stakeholders for better dissemination of information on PMMSY will be strengthened by engaging 'Sagar Mitras' in all major fishing villages of the Islands. All beneficiary oriented activities under PMMSY will be popularized in all by organizing state and district level special awareness drives by the Department. The proposed scheme would benefit fishers/fish farmers/fish vendors/unemployed youth/cooperative societies/self help group and women beneficiaries for the development of aqua-entrepreneurship through participatory approach.

The PMMSY implementation is expected to elevate the level of potential utilization from the present 30% to 50 % in the next 5 years. The infrastructure creation will promote direct export with the objective of doubling fisher's income, a press release from Fisheries Deptt. said

advertisements, impose penalties on manufacturers/endorsers/publishers of misleading advertisements. Shri Paswan further said that the rules for prevention of unfair trade practice by e-commerce platforms will also be covered under this Act. The gazette notification for establishment of the Central Consumer Protection Authority and rules for prevention of unfair trade practice in e-commerce are under publication.

Shri Paswan further said under this Act, every e-commerce entity is required to provide information relating to return, refund, exchange, warranty and guarantee, delivery and shipment, modes of payment, grievance redressal mechanism, payment methods, security of payment methods, charge-back options, etc. including country of origin, which are necessary for enabling the consumer to make an informed decision at the pre-purchase stage on its platform. He said that e-commerce platforms have to acknowledge the receipt of any consumer complaint within forty-eight hours and redress the complaint within one month from the date of receipt under this Act. He further added that the new Act introduces the concept of product liability and brings within its scope, the product manufacturer, product service provider and product seller, for any claim for compensation.

The Minister further informed that the new Act provides for simplifying the consumer dispute adjudication process in the consumer commissions, which include, among others, empowerment of the State and District Commissions to review their own orders, enabling a consumer to file complaints electronically and file complaints in consumer Commissions that have jurisdiction over the place of his residence, videoconferencing for hearing and deemed admissibility of complaints if the question of admissibility is not decided within the specified period of 21 days.

The Minister said an Alternate Dispute Resolution mechanism of Mediation has been provided in the new Act. This will simplify the adjudication process. A complaint will be referred by a Consumer Commission for mediation, wherever scope for early settlement exists and parties agree for it. Mediation will be held in the Mediation Cells to be established under the aegis of the Consumer Commissions. There will be no appeal against settlement through mediation. He said, as per the Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission Rules, there will be no fee for filing cases upto Rs. 5 lakh. There are provisions for filing complaints electronically, credit of amount due to unidentifiable consumers to Consumer Welfare Fund (CWF). The State Commissions will furnish information to Central Government on a quarterly basis on vacancies, disposal, pendency of cases and other matters.

Shri Paswan further informed that the new Act also introduces the concept of product liability and brings within its scope, the product manufacturer, product service provider and product seller, for any claim for compensation. The Act provides for punishment by a competent court for manufacture or sale of adulterant/spurious goods. The Court may, in case of first conviction, suspend any licence issued to the person for a period of up to two years, and in case of second or subsequent conviction, cancel the licence.

as a result of natural disasters. PMFBY covers risks of losses arising from either of the possibilities of prevented sowing, sowing to harvesting (due to drought, dry spell, flood, inundation, pest, diseases, landslide, natural fire, lightning, storm, hailstorm, cyclone etc.), post-harvest losses up to two weeks after harvesting. It also compensates the farmers against localized calamities affecting isolated farms in notified area/single peril risk.

The enrolment under the scheme is voluntary. All farmers including tenant farmers are eligible for coverage. The farmers in A&N Islands have to approach the SBI or Co-operative Bank of the concerned areas alongwith land records and enrolls under the scheme.

After enrolment, any loss to the crop arising out of risks covered in the PMFBY need to be mandatorily reported within 24 hours to the Insurance Company (National Insurance Company) directly or through Department of Agriculture and/or Department of Revenue.

For any assistance or queries, farmers are encouraged to approach the Officers/staff of the Department of Agriculture in various zones. Farmers of A&N Islands have been appealed to take benefits of PMFBY. (PIB news with inputs from Agriculture Department, A&N Administration.)
