Fifth World Conference of Speakers of Parliament held virtually India urges international community to isolate Pak for sponsoring terrorism

New Delhi, Aug 21 Indian Parliament, led by Lok Sabha Speaker, Shri Om Birla, on Thursday urged the international community to isolate Pakistan for sponsoring terrorism. India yesterday exercised its Right of Reply to the statement by Pakistan at the Fifth World Conference of Speakers of Parliament. In its reply, India said that Pakistan's Prime Minister had admitted



there are nearly 40 thousand militants on its soil. India said Pakistan's aggressions against Jammu and Kashmir in 1965, 1971, 1999, attack on Mumbai and Parliament, Uri, and Pulwama show Pakistan's State-sponsored policy of terrorism as evident in the inaction against likes of Hafiz Saeed, Masood Azhar and Ehsanullah Ehsan. India stated that Jammu and Kashmir has been and will remain an integral part of India. It called

upon Pakistan to end cross-border terrorism. Lok Sabha Speaker, Shri Om Birla led an Indian Parliamentary Delegation to the Fifth World Conference of Speakers of Parliament. The two-day long virtual event was organized jointly by Geneva headquartered Inter Parliamentary Union and the Parliament of Austria with the assistance of the United Nations. (Source: india.gov.in)

New Delhi, Aug 21 (PIB) Election Commission of India has approved the broad guidelines for conduct of general/bye elections during COVID-19 period. These are available at <https://eci.gov.in/files/file/12167-guidelines-for-conduct-of-general-election-by-election-during-covid-19/> After onset of COVID-19 pandemic in India, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA)

and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) have been issuing guidelines from time to time. In their latest circular dated 29th July, 2020, MHA has issued comprehensive guidelines/directives to be followed countywide. Similarly, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has also issued SOP on disinfection, sanitization, and prevention for

containing COVID-19. Earlier, Commission, on 17th July, 2020, had sought views/suggestions of National/State Political Parties till 31st July, 2020, and had further extended the period till 11th August, 2020 on request of the Political parties. Administration's resolve to fight against COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Test made mandatory for incoming passengers from mainland at Port of Entry from today

Port Blair, Aug 21 The Andaman & Nicobar Administration in order to ramp up testing in its constant endeavour in fight against the pandemic has now made it mandatory for testing for all incoming passengers from mainland at the Port of Entry itself with effect from tomorrow (August 22). The passengers will be tested at the point of service through Rapid Antigen Test at the cost of Rs. 500 per head. The cost of the test shall be borne by the passengers themselves. Patients alongwith one attendant returning from mainland after medical treatment shall be exempted from these charges.

Incoming passengers, if tested positive shall be shifted immediately to a COVID Care Facility and those who test negative shall still have to follow home/institutional quarantine for seven days. The Andaman & Nicobar Administration is leaving no stone unturned to provide better health services to the citizens of the Isles and appeals to all to strictly maintain social distancing, follow personal hygiene practices and abide by protocols for quarantine, a press release from Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health) said.

the affidavit online and submission of the same, after taking print, before the RO concerned. For the first time, the candidates will have the option to deposit security amount for contesting the elections online. Keeping the containment guidelines in view, the Commission has limited the number of persons including candidate for door to door campaign to five. Public meeting and road shows shall be permissible with suitable instructions subject to containment instructions issued by the MHA/State. Face mask, sanitizer, thermal scanners, gloves, face shield and PPE kits shall be used during the electoral process ensuring social distancing norms. Hand gloves shall be provided to all the electors for signing on the voter register and pressing button of EVM for voting. The Chief Electoral Officers of concerned States/UTs, shall make comprehensive State/District & AC election plans regarding arrangement and preventive measures following these guidelines taking local conditions into account. These plans will be prepared in consultation with Nodal Officer for COVID-19 in their respective States/UTs.

Oral nanomedicine may bring

Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India, have developed an oral nanomedicine with the help of surface-modified solid lipid nanoparticles based combinational cargo system for combating visceral leishmaniasis. The findings of their study supported by the DST-SERB Early Career Research Award have been recently published in the journals 'Scientific Reports' and 'Materials Science & Engineering C'. According to the INST team, till-date there is no study reported where a combination of two anti-leishmanial drugs has been delivered through nanomodification as a potential therapeutic strategy against visceral leishmaniasis. This work suggests the superiority of as-prepared modified formulation (m-DDSLNs) surface modified with 2-hydroxypropyl-β-cyclodextrin (HPCD) as a promising approach towards the oral delivery of anti-leishmanial drugs.

Recommendations of AYUSH for positive cases of COVID-19:

- Food should be freshly cooked, warm, easily digestible, and in suitable quantity as per individual needs. Spices like Haldi (Turmeric), Jeera (Cumin), Dhaniya (coriander), Lahsun (Garlic), Adrak (Ginger), Pippali (Pepper) are recommended in cooking. Warm soups of lentils /pulses / meat can be taken as per preference. Avoid overeating.
 - Use warm water for drinking (in optimal quantity at suitable intervals).
 - Avoid foods/drinks like curd, banana, cold drinks, ice-cream, refrigerated items; and cold air which may trigger respiratory symptoms.
 - AYUSH Kaadha: Drink 150 ml of Herbal Tea /decoction [made by boiling Tulsi (basil), Dalchini (Cinnamon), Kalimirch, Shunthi (Ginger), Munakka (Raisin) in water] once or twice a day. Jaggery and fresh lemon juice may be added for taste.
 - PratimaarshyaNasya: Apply sesame oil /Coconut oil in both nostrils (Twice a day).
 - Oil pooling (Gandusha): Gargle with warm water twice a day (a tea-spoon full of Sesame oil, half tea spoon Haldi and pinch of common salt may be added to water).
 - Steam Inhalation: Thrice a day (Mint leaves or pinch of Ajwain (Carum seeds) may be added to the water in case of congestion)
 - Half tea spoon of Clove powder or Licorice powder may be used once or twice a day along with honey for dry cough /sore throat.
 - Have adequate sleep, preferably during night hours; avoid day sleep to the extent possible.
 - Use warm water for bathing; and dry your hair thoroughly after head-bath.
 - Stay calm and stress-free with daily practice of Yogasana, Pranayama, Meditation.
 - Most important, think positive. You will overcome this problem.
 - Consult concerned doctors at given numbers if symptoms persist/health condition worsens.

Ayurvedic Immunity Promoting Measures
