Jogger's Park reopens as vibrant recreational hub, attracts huge footfall

EPDM track, viewing deck & cultural spaces add to Park's appeal

 The newly renovated Jogger's Park has rapidly emerged as one of the most sought-after recreational destinations in Sri Vijaya Puram, attracting large numbers of residents and tourists alike. Perched atop a picturesque hillock, the park offers stunning panoramic views of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Island, with the iconic high mast at Flag Point adding to its visual appeal and charm.



The revamped park seamlessly blends natural beauty with modern infrastructure, making it an ideal destination for fitness, leisure, and community engagement. A major highlight is the introduction of a 1 km EPDM (Ethylene Propylene Diene Monomer) walking and jogging track, replacing the earlier chequered tile pathway. The EPDM surface provides enhanced comfort and safety, particularly benefiting elderly visitors and regular walkers by reducing stress on joints and helping alleviate knee-related discomfort.

Further strengthening its appeal among fitness enthusiasts, a well-equipped gym has been established within the park, featuring a range of exercise equipment suitable for all age groups. The park also promotes cultural and social interaction through a dedicated mini stage, which serves as a platform for yoga sessions, small gatherings, and nukkad natak aimed at raising awareness on social issues and encouraging community participation.

Information for Public Under Census Act (1948)

Obligation to Answer under Section(8) of the Act.

(1) A census officer may ask all such questions of all persons within the limits of the local area for which he is appointed as, by instructions issued in this behalf by the [Central Government] and published in the Official Gazette, he may be directed to ask.

(2) Every person of whom any question is asked under sub-section (1) shall be legally bound to answer such question to the best of his knowledge or belief:

Provided that no person shall be bound to state the name of any female member of his household, and no woman shall be bound to state the name of her husband or deceased husband or of any other person whose name she is forbidden by custom to mention.

Occupier to permit access under Section (9) of the Act.

Every person occupying any house, enclosure, vessel or other place shall allow census-officers such access thereto as they may require for the purposes of the census and as, having regard to the customs of the country,

may be reasonable, and shall allow them to paint on, or affix to, the place such letters, marks or numbers as may be necessary for the purposes of the census.

An Ayushman Arogya Shivr was conducted yesterday at the Gram Panchayat Hall, Mayabunder. During the shivr, a range of healthcare services was provided to the beneficiaries, including screening for Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) and Tuberculosis (TB), along with General OPD services. As part of the 100 Days Campaign under TB Mukta Bharat Abhiyan 2.0, a Jan Bhagidari event was conducted to strengthen community participation and enhance awareness among the general public, including PRI members. A total of 26 beneficiaries attended the camp, all of whom availed healthcare services. During the camp, 19 chest X-rays were conducted using a handheld X-ray device, out of which, 5 cases showed abnormal findings. Additionally, 17 individuals were identified for sputum examination for further diagnostic evaluation. The entire activity was carried out under the leadership of Dr. Christina Rossity, District TB Officer, North & Middle Andaman, with the dedicated support of the healthcare team from Dr. R.P. Hospital, Mayabunder, a press release District TB Officer, N&MA said.

Fishermen commended for assisting Police in Anti-Poaching Operations

Mayabunder, Apr. 21

In a proactive initiative to strengthen coastal security ahead of the monsoon season, Police Station Kalighat organised an interaction programme at Gram Panchayat Kishorinagar Hall on April 19. The programme witnessed the participation of fishermen from Kishorinagar, Parangara, Srinagar and Kalapahad villages.

The session focused on enhancing operational preparedness against illegal poaching activities during the monsoon period. Baratang Police solve blind hit-and-run case, accused apprehended

Mayabunder, Apr. 21

PS Baratang solved a blind hit-and-run case within five hours, apprehending the accused along with the offending vehicle, demonstrating prompt response and efficient investigation. On 19/04/2026 at around 9 pm, information regarding a road traffic accident near South Creek was received at PS Baratang. A Police team immediately reached the spot and shifted the injured person to PHC Baratang. The victim, Johnson Dung Dung of Amba Kona, had sustained grievous injuries, reportedly caused by a speeding

vehicle that fled the scene.

Upon receipt of the information, an FIR was registered under relevant sections of BNS, 2023. A dedicated team led by SHO PS Baratang, comprising SI Subramani, ASI Muchray Munda, and other staff, launched an intensive overnight operation. Through sustained patrolling, tracking of vehicle movement from Middle Strait and Kadamtala, and analysis of CCTV footage, the suspect vehicle was identified. With swift follow-up, the accused was apprehended within five hours.
