PM leaving on two-day visit to Iran today

New Delhi, May 21
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi is leaving on a two-day visit to Iran tomorrow. Prime Minister's visit will mainly focus on connectivity and infrastructure, energy partnership with Tehran and boosting bilateral trade. It will help in promoting regular consultations on peace and stability, particularly in the region and extended neighbourhood. During the visit, Shri Modi will meet Supreme Leader of Iran Ayatollah Ali Khamenei and President Hassan Rouhani on Monday. Developing connectivity, infrastructure and encouraging people to people contacts will be the other priorities of Prime Minister's visit to the Gulf nation. Talks will be held on security and peace issues between the Indian Prime Minister and Iranian President during their meeting. India, Iran and Afghanistan

will sign an agreement on developing Chabahar port on 23rd. The port will be a game changer for regional connectivity, especially for Afghanistan, which can find an assured and reliable alternative access to India via sea. The route will also significantly enhance prospects for India's connectivity with Afghanistan, Central Asia and beyond through synergies with other initiatives touching the

Virat Kohli's RCB face do-or-die situation in IPL Play-Off race against Delhi Daredevils

Bangalore, May 21
The stage is set for a virtual knockout as a rampaging Royal Challengers Bangalore, led by inspirational skipper Virat Kohli, lock horns with an inconsistent Delhi Daredevils in their final IPL Twenty20 cricket match in Raipur on Sunday. After 13 matches, RCB are at the third spot with 14 points, while Delhi have as many points but are placed sixth in the table, lagging behind RCB only in net run-rate. In fact, two-time champions Kolkata Knight Riders and Mumbai Indians too have 14 points each with just one match to go in their league stage. With a hat-trick of wins, Bangalore have been on a roll



with skipper Kohli enjoying one of the best phases of his career as he has four centuries under his belt. He is the only batsman to score more than 800 runs in a single edition and has 865 runs from 13 matches thus far. Despite sustaining a split webbing in his left hand while fielding against Kolkata Knight Riders, Kohli has shown no signs of relenting.

India likely to announce Hockey Squad for Rio Olympics on July 5

Bengaluru, May 21
India are likely to announce the national men's hockey squad for the Rio Olympics on July 5, chief coach and country's High Performance Director Roelant Oltmans said in Bengaluru on Friday. "The national selectors are likely to meet on July 5 to pick the final squad for the Olympics. We will start the national camp on July 11 which will be a two-week camp. After that we leave for Madrid to play two friendly matches with Spain and then head to Rio and play a friendly with Spain and New Zealand. I believe we have entered a very exciting period in the lead up to the Olympics."



Oltmans said. "Starting June 5, the team will be away for almost a month playing two different tournaments in two different countries. Everything we do in this period will be demanding not just physically but also mentally," Oltmans said. "Though we are entering an exciting period and looking forward to the Olympics, it was important to take off for a week and be in a different environment," said the Dutchman, who is also the High Performance Director of Indian Hockey in London.
