## Andaman Islands Unveil Four Spectacular New Dive Sites in Diglipur, Elevating India as a Premier Marine Tourism and Eco-Diving Destination

Andaman Islands have made a bold move to transform Diglipur into a major marine tourism destination by unveiling four officially surveyed scuba-diving sites, opening fresh opportunities for India's adventure travellers. This initiative comes as a strategic effort to shift tourist footfall from the over-visited southern islands to the pristine waters of North Andaman, providing eco-conscious divers with a cleaner, less crowded underwater experience. Positioned about 320 kilometres north of Sri Vijaya Puram, Diglipur is celebrated for its untouched beaches, dense tropical forests, and vibrant marine ecosystems. With these new dive zones, the region is poised to rival Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep in recreational diving, while also generating economic growth for local communities and



spreading tourism benefits more evenly across the Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The move by the Directorate of Information, Publicity & Tourism, Andaman & Nicobar Administration aims to cultivate Diglipur as a premium diving hub, offering eco-friendly exploration that caters to both novice and expert divers. By highlighting four unique sites—each with

distinct underwater landscapes and depths—the islands promise a fresh, engaging experience for tourists from India and neighbouring countries looking to explore the Indian Ocean's marine treasures.

### The Pristine Shoreline Sanctuary

The first dive site, Pristine Shoreline Sanctuary, is located off the sandy beaches of Ross & Smith Islands. This entry-level site

allows divers to walk straight into the water, eliminating the need for boats. With depths ranging from 2 to 12 metres, it caters perfectly to beginners, underwater photographers, and eco-tourism enthusiasts seeking gentle exploration. Its shallow coral gardens and tranquil waters make it an ideal introduction for international tourists (Contd. on last page)

**The Deep Blue Bridge**

Located northeast of the Ross & Smith sandbar, Deep Blue Bridge offers a slightly deeper, boat-accessible diving experience. Ranging between 3 and 11 metres, it is perfect for certified divers aiming to sharpen their underwater skills. The site features stretches of brain coral, delicate staghorn coral gardens, and vibrant anemone clusters, creating an immersive marine landscape. Divers from Thailand, Sri Lanka, and other parts of Southeast Asia are expected to visit this eco-conscious hub, supporting India's vision to expand sustainable tourism across the Andaman Islands. The site is especially appealing for eco-tourists seeking cleaner, less crowded reefs away from southern hotspots.

**Small Wall Off Ross Island**

Small Wall Off Ross Island introduces divers to dramatic vertical underwater scenery. Starting on an 8-10-metre-high reef shelf, the wall plunges to a depth of 21 metres, creating a thrilling underwater cliff experience. This site is ideal for experienced divers seeking interaction with larger marine life and exploring deeper reef formations. The site's vertical landscape offers unique photographic opportunities, while its relatively undiscovered location preserves its pristine quality. Tourism experts predict divers from Australia and New Zealand will include this in their Andaman itinerary, contributing to international marine tourism growth in India.

**Wall of Craggy/Gentle Slope**

The Wall of Craggy/Gentle Slope is the deepest of the four newly charted sites, offering depths from 8 to 31 metres. It features rare marine fauna including manta rays, eagle rays, and potentially dugongs-the state animal of the Andaman Islands. This site appeals to highly experienced divers, providing an unparalleled adventure experience while maintaining environmental stewardship. The inclusion of this site highlights India's commitment to sustainable marine tourism while attracting global attention from divers across Europe, Japan, and South Korea, ensuring Diglipur becomes a must-visit destination for serious underwater explorers.

**North Andaman's Economic and Tourism Impact**

This strategic development benefits both the environment and the local economy. Previously, scuba tourism revenue concentrated in South Andaman. The mapping of official dive sites in North Andaman now allows communities in Diglipur, Kalipur, and Aerial Bay to participate directly in tourism growth. Local operators can offer guided tours, eco-friendly resorts, and dive certification programs, creating employment and promoting sustainable practices. The initiative aligns with India's broader tourism strategy to balance regional development, while providing tourists with pristine marine experiences. The project also attracts eco-conscious travellers from Singapore, Thailand, Malaysia, and Australia, creating a multicultural tourism influx that reinforces Diglipur's reputation as a world-class scuba destination.


