PM bats for UN reforms to reflect current realities

Jaipur, Aug 21
 Ahead of the global conference on climate change in Paris, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today made a strong pitch for "concrete and effective" outcome to meet the challenge even as he batted for reform of the UN Security Council to "mirror" current realities. Hosting a summit of 14 island nations located in the strategically important Pacific region here, he said pushed for balancing the global order as he stressed the need for closer cooperation with these resource-rich countries. In his inaugural address at the second summit of Forum for India Pacific Island Countries



(FIPIC), Shri Modi announced the establishment of the FIPIC Trade Office in the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry in New Delhi, while observing that "trade, more than aid, is the enabler for development".

"We are at the cusp of a new era, where oceans, like Space, will become important drivers of our economies. Their sustainable use can bring prosperity; and, give us clean energy, new medicines and food security beyond just

fisheries, he said. "Our global challenges are similar. Climate change is an existential threat to the Pacific Islands. It is also taking a toll on the teaming millions on India's shoreline of 7500 kilometres and its nearly 1300 islands," he said. Referring to the climate conference in Paris to be held later this year, Shri Modi said, "We both seek a concrete and effective outcome." He India and the Pacific island nations should work together for a separate goal on climate change in the Sustainable Development Goals, and in a manner that addresses the interests of developing countries.

Centre declares 2nd & 4th Saturdays as holidays for bank employees

New Delhi, Aug 21
 The Centre has declared second and fourth Saturdays of a month as holidays for the bank employees. The government accepted the long-pending demand of employees, with effect from first of September. Talking to reporters, in New Delhi, All India Bank

Employees' Association AIBEA General Secretary C H Venkatachalam said this will be a big relief to employees and improve the productivity of employees. He also informed that in case of a month having five Saturdays, banks will be closed only on second and fourth Saturdays.

Govt announces revision in tax structure to benefit tourism industry

New Delhi, Aug 21
 Union Minister of Civil Aviation, Culture and Tourism Shri Mahesh Sharma announced revision in tax structure to benefit tourism industry and usher revolution in the sector. Speaking at 31st convention of the Indian Association of Tour Operators yesterday in Indore, Shri Sharma said, India is yet to realise its full tourism potential. The Minister also announced extension of e-visa facility to 36 more nations thereby pushing the total to 113

countries from the existing 77. This would facilitate speedier clearances for tourists. Ministry will discuss the details with the finance ministry to bring in amendments in taxation on tour operators to give boost to tourism industry. Speaking at the occasion, Chief Minister Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan said, that the landscape and weather of Madhya Pradesh is such that it can offer tourism all-round the year, unlike other states of India. Madhya Pradesh has designated 2015-16 as year of tourism.

Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi has issued orders for strict compliance of the guidelines for Idol Immersion as issued by the Central Pollution Control Board, New Delhi to all the States and Union Territories. In this connection, the all concerned are hereby requested to follow the following guidelines for Idol Immersion.

> Idols should be made from the natural material as described in the holy script preferably traditional clay, baked clay; Plaster of Paris should not be used for making idols.

> Idols are to be painted with water soluble and non-toxic natural dyes. Use of toxic and non-biodegradable chemical dyes for painting is strictly prohibited.

> Worship material like flowers, vastras (cloth), decorating material (made of paper and plastic) should be removed before Idol Immersion. Biodegradable materials should be collected separately for recycling or composting. Non-biodegradable materials should be collected separately for disposal in sanitary landfills. Clothes may be sent to local orphan house(s).

> Burning of solid waste comprising of used flowers, clothes, decorating materials etc. is prohibited at the immersion site.

> Idol Immersion should be done between low tide line (irrespective of its depth) in a identified places with permission of District Administration only.

OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR PANCHAYAT AND MUNICIPAL ELECTION (DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, SOUTH ANDAMAN) PRESS NOTE

In compliance of the directions issued by the Election Commission (UTs) the following instructions are being issued with respect to Personnel Management.

All Officers/officials related to election duties including police personnel shall be deemed to be on deputation of Election Commission during election process.

In order to conduct free, fair and transparent election, it is important that the Presiding Officers do not belong to the area assigned for duty so that they are buffered from local pressure and influence and accordingly has directed rotation of officials to be done in cases of Presiding Officers either inter-District / Tehsil-wise. Accordingly, appointment of staff on election duty shall be done in terms of said directions by adopting randomization process.

The randomization for Tehsils of Port Blair, Ferrargunj, Little Andaman and Campbell Bay shall be done in the office of the Director Panchayat and Municipal Elections (DPME) (Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman) while that for Diglipur, Mayabunder and Rangat Tehsil shall be done by DEO, N&M Andaman (Deputy Commissioner, N&M Andaman) at Mayabunder.

For the purpose of randomization, the software developed by the office of DPME shall be used.

There will be three stages of Randomization. In the **First stage**, required number of polling personnel shall be identified for the district. The place of appointment shall not to be disclosed. Polling personnel will know whether he/she is a Presiding Officer or a Polling Officer, the venue and time of training.

In the **Second stage**, Polling parties shall be formed and assigned to each Returning Officer alongwith 20 percent reserve. At this stage only the Returning Officer will be known to the polling official. Polling Station or the appointment status(regular or reserve) will NOT be known. The second randomization shall carried not before six to seven days from the day of poll. The day of Poll has been declared as 20th September 2015.

In the **Third stage** Orders will be kept in sealed cover to be opened by the Returning Officer at the distribution centre at the time of dispersal of Polling Parties to the Polling Station on 19.09.2015. However polling officials assigned to distant and difficultly accessible polling stations shall be informed on 18.09.2015 to report for collection of Polling Materials.

The first round of training on 26th, 27th August, 2015 for Panchayat election and 29th August, 2015 for Municipal election. The Presiding Officers who are presently posted at Campbell Bay, Nancowry and Little Andaman shall be given training at Port Blair while the polling officials presently posted at L/Andaman shall be imparted with training by the Master Trainers at Little Andaman. The staff drafted from Nancowry and C/Bay Tehsils shall be imparted with training on the aforesaid dates at Campbell Bay by the Master Trainers of Campbell bay.

In case of North & Middle Andaman, staff drafted for election duty shall be imparted with training at respective Tehsils by Master Trainers on the aforesaid dates.

The pattern followed in the first round of training shall be continued in the second round of training also on 13th September 2015 from 1430 hrs onwards & 14th September 2015 from 1000 hrs onwards for Panchayat election and on 14th September 2015 from 1430 hrs onwards for Municipal election.

Appointment orders have been issued to the staff on election duty for Polling Stations of South Andaman District and Campbell Bay Tehsil.

Needless to mention that, if any Officer fails to attend training/perform the tasks assigned to them, penal action, both Civil as well as Criminal will be taken against him/her.

Persons on election duty are entitled for voting through Postal Ballots. Accordingly staff placed on election duty is requested to approach concerned Returning Officer on 10th and 11th September 2015 in their offices. List of Returning Officers have been published. However in case of any doubt interested persons are requested to log on to @ <http://ddp.and.nic.in/stateelection> For the same.

2nd Test, Day 2: Kumar Sangakkara fails on farewell, India lead by 253 runs

Colombo, Aug 21
Retiring legend Kumar Sangakkara failed to get a big knock in his swansong Test appearance but Sri Lanka overcame an early jolt to reach 140/3 after dismissing India for 393 in the first innings of the second cricket Test here today. Resuming at the overnight score of 319/6, India were bowled out shortly after the lunch break and the hosts treaded cautiously to keep the match on an even keel at the end of the second day's play. Opener Kaushal Silva (51 off 117 balls) played a watchful innings to ensure that the early loss of fellow opener Dimuth Karunaratne did not trigger a top-order collapse. His dismissal towards the fag end of the day, however, put the side slightly on the backfoot given that the home team is still 253 runs behind. Sangakkara was given a guard of honour by the Indians as he walked in to bat when the hosts



lost their first wicket with just one run on the board. However, it did not quite turn out to be a fairytale ending for the veteran batsman, who was dismissed by off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin for 32 after facing 87 deliveries. After Sangakkara's departure, Lahiru Thirimanne (28 batting) and Silva added 39 runs for the third wicket before India took the slight edge by snaring the latter. When stumps were drawn for the day, Thirimanne and skipper Angelo Mathews (19) were holding fort for the Lankans.

Earlier, resuming at the overnight score, India were bowled three overs after lunch as Rangana Herath took 4/81. Wicketkeeper-batsman Wriddhiman Saha, who had scored a 60 in the first Test, played a 56-run knock to take India past the 350 figure. The Indians scored at a slow pace in the morning session as Saha shepherded the lower order to avoid a below-par total in the first innings of this match. The visiting side could pull off a mere 67 runs in this first session of play in 23.4 overs.

Djokovic beats Goffin to reach Cincinnati quarters

Cincinnati, Aug 21
Serbian tennis star Novak Djokovic found himself against the ropes against Belgium's David Goffin but rallied in time to pull off a 6-4, 2-6, 6-3 victory to reach the quarterfinals of the Cincinnati Masters here. The 13th-seeded Goffin on Thursday afternoon won nine of 11 games to win the second set and take a 3-0 lead with two service breaks in the decider. But top seed Djokovic was able to get

his game back on track just in time and take advantage of the 24-year-old Belgian's inexperience to reel off the final six games of the one-hour, 46-minute contest, Efe reported. The 28-year-old world No.1, a four-time finalist here, the only ATP World Tour Masters 1000 event that has eluded him thus far in his career, will next take on fifth-seeded Swiss Stanislas Wawrinka in one of Friday's quarterfinal matches.

HIL-4 players auction to be held on Sept. 17

New Delhi, Aug 21
A total of 135 Indian and 142 foreign players will go under the hammer when the players auction for the fourth edition of the Hockey India League (HIL) gets underway at city hotel in New Delhi on September 17. The six franchisees will bid for players from India, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, USA, England, South Africa, Netherlands, Germany, Belgium, Scotland, Malaysia, Japan and Korea to complete their teams. Earlier in August this year, HIL had

provided all the franchisees the option to retain upto three Indian and as many foreign players, while releasing the rest of the squad. A total of 276 players are listed for the auction and among them, 135 players are from India and 142 players belong to other leading hockey nations. Under the new rules and regulations, franchisees can build a team of 20 players, which allows each franchisee to have 12 Indian players and 8 foreign players.

Indians set sight on athletics World Championships

Beijing, Aug 21
Asian Athletics Championships shot put gold medalist Inderjeet Singh and discus thrower Vikas Gowda are among the most notable names in the 17-member Indian squad for the athletics World Championships starting here on Saturday. The Championships will begin on August 22 and will continue till August 30. The Indian squad, which comprises ten women and seven male athletes, will be competing in nine events in the biennial event at the Bird's Nest stadium here. Shot putter Inderjeet is in good form having won gold

medals at every event he has taken part in this year. The towering left-hander has won a staggering eight gold medals this year and has already qualified for the 2016 Rio Olympics. He emerged champion at the Asian Championships and Asian Grand Prix in June before finishing at the top of the podium at the World University Games last month. Gowda, who won silver at the 2014 Asian Games in Incheon, South Korea, is also one of India's best bets for a medal in Beijing. But he needs to do much better than his season's best of 65.14 metres in order to finish on the podium.

Swaraj Dweep arriving on Aug 23

Dedicated Eastern Freight Corridor to be operational in 2019

New Delhi, Aug 21
Dedicated Eastern Freight Corridor of the Railways connecting Ludhiana in Punjab and Dankuni in West Bengal will be operational in 2019. Addressing the Bharat Chamber of Commerce in Kolkata this afternoon the Railway Minister Shri Suresh Prabhu said that the Cabinet has approved the revised estimates for the project of 82 thousand crore rupees. He said

that tender of 15,000 crore rupees have already been floated and within next 8 months bidding process will be over. Shri Prabhu said that the dedicated corridor will help to earn more revenues and the capacity for transporting freights will be increased to 1.5 billion tons. To eliminate corruption in Railway recruitments Mr. Prabhu informed that all examinations in future will be taken on-line.
