## Hon'ble Prime Minister to participate in programme to name 21 Unnamed Islands of Andaman & Nicobar Islands after 21 Param Vir Chakra Awardees on 23<sup>rd</sup> January

### Naming of Islands after the Param Vir Chakra Awardees will be an everlasting tribute to them

### Hon'ble PM to also unveil model of National Memorial dedicated to Netaji to be constructed on Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island

New Delhi, Jan. 21(PIB)

On Parakram Diwas, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will participate in a ceremony to name 21 unnamed Islands of Andaman & Nicobar Islands after 21 Param Vir Chakra Awardees on 23<sup>rd</sup> January at 11 AM via video conferencing. During the programme, Prime Minister will also unveil the model of the National Memorial dedicated to Netaji to be built on Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island.

Keeping in mind the historic significance of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and to honour the memory of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Ross Island was renamed as Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island by Hon'ble Prime Minister during his visit to the Island in 2018. Neil Island and Havelock Island were also renamed as Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep.

Giving due respect to the real-life heroes of the country has always been accorded highest priority by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. Going ahead with this spirit, it has now been decided to name the 21 unnamed Islands of the Island Group after 21 Param Vir Chakra Awardees. The largest unnamed Island will be named after the first Param Vir Chakra awardee, the second



largest unnamed Island will be named after the second Param Vir Chakra awardee, and so on. This step will be an everlasting tribute to our heroes, several of whom had made the ultimate sacrifice to protect the sovereignty and integrity of the nation.

These Islands have been named after the 21 Param Vir Chakra awardees, viz. Major Somnath Sharma; Subedar and Honorary Captain (then Lance Naik) Karam Singh, MM; 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt. Rama Raghoba Rane; Nayak Jadunath Singh; Company Havildar Major Piru Singh;

Capt GS Salaria; Lieutenant Colonel (then Major) Dhan Singh Thapa; Subedar Joginder Singh; Major Shaitan Singh; CQMH. Abdul Hamid; Lt Col Ardeshir Burzorji Tarapore; Lance Naik Albert Ekka; Major Hoshiar Singh; 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt. Arun Khetrpal; Flying Officer Nirmaljit Singh Sekhon; Major Ramaswamy Parameswaran; Naib Subedar Bana Singh; Captain Vikram Batra; Lt Manoj Kumar Pandey; Subedar Major (then Rifleman) Sanjay Kumar; and Subedar Major Retd. (Honorary Captain) Grenadier Yogendra Singh Yadav.

Meanwhile, the mega event to be held at Port Blair includes a cultural programme at the historic Netaji Stadium on January 23 at 5 pm. Hon'ble Union Home and Cooperation Minister, Shri Amit Shah will be the chief guest on the occasion. **Three local residents of N&M Andaman arrested for providing logistical support and for obtaining return gratifications from Myanmar poachers**

Port Blair, Jan. 21

Indian Coast Guard apprehended 46 Myanmar poachers along with 04 Engine Dinghies on 24/12/2022, near East Island and a case under Maritime Zone of India Act, 1981 and Foreigners Act 1946 was registered against them at PS Central Crime Station and is being investigated by Dy.SP (CID) Kumar Abhishek. During sustained interrogation, the Myanmar Poachers revealed that some local residents of Hara Tikrey Village under PS Kalighat Jurisdiction met them several times last year at Hiran Tikrey, Kishori Nagar and provided the poachers various logistical support. In return the poachers had provided these local residents Mobile phones, Solar Panel, Batteries, underwater Torches, watch etc. for providing them logistical support.

From the investigations carried out till now, various articles provided by Myanmar poachers have been recovered from local residents namely Sanju Toppo, Paulus Gari & Rajender Singh from the jungles of Hara Tikrey by a team comprising of SI Parvash, HC S.Baroi, PC Amos George, PC Bijoy Das and these local residents have been arrested in the case. Investigation of the case is under progress and a few other local residents of North & Middle Andaman are also suspected to be involved in the nexus with foreign poachers.

General Public of Andaman & Nicobar Islands are requested not to interact or aid the Foreign Poachers in the Indian Territorial Waters. Foreign Poachers not only plunder our precious marine wealth but also pose serious national security threats.
