FM presents Union Budget 2021-22 in Parliament

Focuses on AatmaNirbhar Bharat
Announces slew of taxation reforms
Capital expenditure steeply increased to provide 5.54 lakh crores

New Delhi, Feb. 1 (PIB)

The Union Minister for Finance & Corporate Affairs, Smt Nirmala Sitharaman presented the Union Budget 2021-22 in Parliament today, which is the first budget of this new decade and also a digital one in the backdrop of unprecedented COVID-19 crisis. Laying a vision for AatmaNirbhar Bharat, she said this is an expression of 130 crore Indians who have full confidence in their capabilities and skills. She said that Budget proposals will further strengthen the Sankalp of Nation First, Doubling Farmer's Income, Strong Infrastructure, Healthy India, Good Governance, Opportunities for youth, Education for All, Women Empowerment, and Inclusive Development among others. Additionally, also on the path to fast-implementation are the 13 promises of Budget 2015-16-which were to materialize during the AmrutMahotsav of 2022, on the 75th year of our Independence. They too resonate with this vision of AatmaNirbharta, she added.

The Budget proposals for 2021-22 rest on 6 pillars viz. Health and Wellbeing; Physical & Financial Capital, and Infrastructure; Inclusive Development for Aspirational India; Reinvigorating Human Capital; Innovation and R&D and Minimum Government and Maximum Governance.

There is substantial increase in investment in Health Infrastructure and the Budget outlay for Health and Wellbeing is Rs 2,23,846 crore in BE 2021-22 as against this year's BE of Rs 94,452 crore, an increase of 137 percentage. The Finance Minister announced that a new centrally sponsored scheme, PM AatmaNirbhar Swasth Bharat Yojana, will be launched with an outlay of about Rs 64, 180 crore over 6 years. This will develop capacities of primary, secondary, and tertiary care Health Systems, strengthen existing national institutions, and create new institutions, to cater to detection and cure of new and emerging

diseases. This will be in addition to the National Health Mission. Provision of Rs 35,000 crore made for COVID-19 vaccine in BE 2021-22. The Pneumococcal Vaccine, a Made in India product, presently limited to only 5 states, will be rolled out across the country aimed at averting 50,000 child deaths annually.

The Finance Minister announced that the Jal Jeevan Mission (Urban), will be launched for universal water supply in all 4,378 Urban Local Bodies with 2.86 crore household tap connections, as well as liquid waste management in 500 AMRUT cities. It will be implemented over 5 years, with an outlay of Rs. 2,87,000 crore. A voluntary vehicle scrapping policy to phase out old and unfit vehicles was also announced. Fitness tests

have been proposed in automated fitness centres after 20 years in case of personal vehicles, and after 15 years in case of commercial vehicles. Finance Minister announced that more than 13,000 km length of roads, at a cost of Rs 3.3 lakh crore, has already been awarded under the Rs. 5.35 lakh crore Bharatmala Pariyojana project of which 3,800 kms have been constructed. By March 2022, Government would be awarding another 8,500 kms and complete an additional 11,000 kms of national highway corridors. To further augment road infrastructure, more economic corridors are also being planned. She also provided an enhanced outlay of Rs. 1,18,101 lakh crore for Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, of which Rs.1,08,230 crore is for capital, the highest ever.

Under the pillar of Inclusive Development for Aspirational India, the Finance Minister announced to cover Agriculture and Allied sectors, farmers' welfare and rural India, migrant workers and labour, and financial inclusion.

Dwelling on agriculture, she said that the Government is committed to the welfare of farmers. The MSP regime has undergone a sea change to assure price that is at least 1.5 times the cost of production across all commodities. The procurement has also continued to increase at a steady pace. This has resulted in increase in payment to farmers substantially.

Early this year, Hon'ble Prime Minister had launched SWAMITVA Scheme. Under this, a record of rights is being given to property owners in villages. Up till now, about 1.80 lakh property-owners in 1,241 villages have been provided cards and the Finance Minister proposed during FY21-22 to extend this to cover all States/UTs.

Directorate of Education issues order for reopening of schools/classes for students of Class IX

Students shall be permitted with written consent of parents/guardians; attendance not mandatory but voluntary

Port Blair, Feb. 1

The Directorate of Education, A & N Administration has issued order for re-opening of schools/classes for the students of class IX in Government, Government Aided, Private Unaided and Local Body Schools for the academic session 2020-2021 from Feb.4, 2021 subject to certain conditions i.e. online/digital platform shall continue to be preferred mode of teaching. However, students of class IX shall be permitted to attend schools with 50% attendance on each school day with the written consent of parents/guardians.

Attendance of students in school will not be mandatory but voluntary in nature. Head of Institutions, in consultation with PTA body of the school concerned, may stagger the class timing of each class for maintaining physical distance in the school premises during opening and closing of classes.

The details of subjects to be taught through classroom transaction/digital mode and subjects to be learnt by way of self learning through digital mode are given below:

intervention of Agriculture Department. He also regularly attends the trainings and demonstration programmes conducted under ATMA & HVADA.

After attending the training programme on honey bee keeping and its benefits, he evinced keen interest in bee keeping activities. Dharma started practicing apiculture and initially started bee keeping activities with just 5 bee hive boxes with colonies. With his dedication, gradually the bee colonies were multiplied and as on date he is having about 50 bee hive boxes with colonies and is in the process of running an apary.

During his visit to Kanyakumari, he met some of the progressive farmers and acquired knowledge and skill about the adaptation habits of honey bees. By practicing bee colonies, not only his income has increased, but the production of crops as well, thereby enabling him to lead a sustainable life. Under the National Horticulture Mission Scheme (NHM) Pollination Support through Bee Keeping of MIDH, he was extended financial assistance amounting to Rs. 80000/- for setting up 50 Bee hives with colonies. With his own interest and hardworking nature, he started manufacturing bee hive boxes & multiplying bee colonies for sale to local farmers.

Apart from this, he also provides training to his fellow farmers and teaches them the benefits of bee keeping. Now, he is planning to extend his bee keeping business commercially, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

Finance Minister proposed substantial investments in the development of modern fishing harbours and fish landing centres. To start with, 5 major fishing harbours - Kochi, Chennai, Visakhapatnam, Paradip, and Petuaghat - will be developed as hubs of economic activity.

Government has launched the One Nation One Ration Card scheme through which beneficiaries can claim their rations anywhere in the country. One Nation One Ration Card plan is under implementation by 32 States and UTs, reaching about 69 crore beneficiaries - that's a total of 86% beneficiaries covered. The remaining 4 states and UTs will be integrated in the next few months.

The Finance Minister said that the National Education Policy (NEP) announced recently has had good reception, while adding that more than 15,000 schools will be qualitatively strengthened to include all components of the National Education Policy. She also announced that 100 new Sainik Schools will be set up in partnership with NGOs/private schools/states. She also proposed to set up a Higher Education Commission of India, as an umbrella body having 4 separate vehicles for standard-setting, accreditation, regulation, and funding. For accessible higher education in Ladakh, Government proposed to set up a Central University in Leh.

Government has set a target of establishing 750 Eklavya model residential schools in tribal areas with increase in unit cost of each such school from Rs. 20 crore to Rs. 38 crore, and for hilly and difficult areas, to Rs. 48 crore. Similarly, under the revamped Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for the welfare of Scheduled Castes, the Central Assistance was enhanced and allocated Rs. 35,219 crore for 6 years till 2025-2026, to benefit 4 crore SC students.

Government will undertake a new initiative - National Language Translation Mission (NTLM). This will enable the wealth of governance-and-policy related knowledge on the Internet being made available in major Indian languages.

The Finance Minister proposed to take a number of steps to bring reforms in Tribunals in the last few years for speedy delivery of justice and proposes to take further measures to rationalised the functioning of Tribunals. Government has introduced the National Commission for Allied Healthcare Professionals Bill in Parliament, with a view to ensure transparent and efficient regulation of the 56 allied healthcare professions. She also announced that the forthcoming Census could be the first digital census in the history of India and for this monumental and milestone-marking task, Rs. 3,768 crore allocated in the year 2021-2022.

In Part B of the Budget Speech, the Union Minister seeks to further simplify the Tax Administration, Litigation Management and ease the compliance of Direct Tax Administration. The indirect proposal focuses on custom duty rationalization as well as rationalization of procedures and easing of compliance.

The Finance Minister provided relief to senior citizens in filing of income tax returns, reduced time limit for income tax proceedings announced setting up of the Dispute Resolution Committee, faceless ITAT, relaxation to NRIs, increase in exemption limit from audit and relief for dividend income.

The Budget seeks to reduce compliance burden on senior citizens who are of 75 years of age and above. Such senior citizens having only pension and interest income will be exempted from filing their income tax return. The paying Bank will deduct the necessary tax on their income. The Budget proposes to notify rules for removing the hardship of non-Resident Indians returning to India on the issue of their accrued incomes in their foreign retirement account. The Budget proposes to make dividend payment to REIT/InvIT exempt from TDS.

The Finance Minister proposed to extend the eligibility period for claim of additional deduction for interest of Rs. 1.5 lakh paid for loan taken for purchase of an affordable house to 31st March, 2022. In order to increase the supply of affordable houses, she also announced extension of eligibility period for claiming tax holiday for affordable housing projects by one more year to 31st March, 2022. For promoting supply of affordable rental housing for the migrant workers, the Minister announced a new tax exemption for the notified affordable rental housing projects.

In order to incentivize start ups in the country, Smt. Sitharaman announced extension in the eligibility for claiming tax holiday for start ups by one more year till 31st March, 2022. In order to incentivize funding of start ups, she proposed extending the Capital Gains exemption for investment in start ups by one more year till 31st March, 2022.

The Finance Minister said that delay in deposit of the contribution of employees towards various welfare funds results in permanent loss of interest/income for the employees. In order to ensure timely deposit of employee's contribution to these funds by the employers, she announced that late deposit of employee's contribution shall never be allowed as deduction to the employer.

Hence, it is once again requested to all the NFSA and APL ration card holders to get theirs & other left out family members seeded in the database through their respective FPS or at the Card Section of the Directorate of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs by 15th February, 2021. Further, all FPS dealers have been directed to facilitate all such card holders or members whose Aadhaar number has not yet been seeded in the database as per the list provided to them, a press release from Directorate of CS&CA said.




