Realizing vision of 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' through implementation of PMEGP scheme in A&N Islands

2242 units generating 5730 employment set up under PMEGP so far 205 projects sanctioned by banks for current financial year

Port Blair, Feb. 21

The Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) since its inception in the year 2008 has served as an important tool for employment generation in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The scheme has transformed the lives and dreams of many youth/entrepreneurs from the Islands through its financial assistance. A lot of people from A&N Islands have embraced the scheme, making it the most viable option for starting up self ventures and earning livelihood.

So far, 2242 units generating 5730 employment have been set up by availing the benefits of PMEGP. Special emphasis has been given to women, Scheduled Tribes, OBC, Physically Handicapped and ex-servicemen under the scheme. In order to simplify the process under the scheme, the Ministry of MSME, GoI has discontinued the system of selection of beneficiaries and recommendations of proposals / applications by the DLTF to streamline the

process of selection and expedite the flow of applications under PMEGP scheme. Accordingly, from this financial year onwards, the Programme Implementing Agencies viz. ANIKVIB & DIC are forwarding applications directly to the financing banks for credit decision after preliminary scrutiny and examining the personal and factual details mentioned in the application including project report etc. The details of the simplification in the PMEGP guidelines have already been published in print & electronic media for its wider reach. In addition, the details of the probable activities which could be financed under PMEGP

scheme have also been published for the knowledge of general public and aspiring entrepreneurs from the Islands.

Further, to mobilize more and more youth to become Atmanirbhar, the Industries Department under the guidance of Secretary (Industries) is taking various steps including disseminating information on PMEGP and ventures available under the programme at PRI level. PRIs have also been requested to identify at least 5 beneficiaries under different activities from their area and sponsor their names to the Industries Department for further action in the matter. 'Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakaram': Providing free & cashless services to pregnant women & sick newborns

3595 beneficiaries received benefits during 2019-20 in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Feb. 21

Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakaram (JSSK) is an initiative to provide completely free and cashless services to pregnant women including normal deliveries and caesarean operations and sick new born (up to 1 year after birth) in Government health institutions in both rural & urban areas. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), GoI launched JSSK on 1st June, 2011 in view of the difficulty being faced by the pregnant women and parents of sick newborn along-with high out of pocket expenses incurred by them on delivery and treatment of sick newborn. The scheme is to benefit pregnant women who access Government health facilities for their delivery. Moreover, it will motivate those who still choose to deliver at their homes to opt for institutional deliveries.

According to data received from Directorate of Health Services, entitled benefits were extended to institutional



deliveries under JSSK and altogether, 3595 beneficiaries received benefits during 2019-20 under this scheme in A&N Islands. The scheme has eliminated out of pocket expenses incurred by the pregnant women and sick new born while accessing services at Government health facilities.

The free entitlements for pregnant women include free and cashless delivery, free C-Section, free drugs and consumables, free diagnostics, free diet during stay in the health institutions, free provision of blood, free transport from home to health institutions, free transport between facilities in case of referral and free drop back from Institutions to home after 48 hrs stay.

For sick newborns till 1 year after birth, the free entitlements include free treatment, free drugs and consumables, free diagnostics, free provision of blood, (Contd. on last page)

This 24x7- helpline provides all-round help for the people who are suffering from mental health through a toll-free helpline number (1800-599-0019). This facility has been implemented initially through 25 Institutions spread across the Country.

Through this helpline, people who are suffering from mental health across the country are able to get information sitting at home. Information such as "where will they get the facility from, what medical facility will they get and complete information from the point of view of rehabilitation, are being provided through this



helpline number.

A dedicated mobile number and separate handset provided to each Helpline Centre for uninterrupted service of the Mental Health Rehabilitation Helpline (MHRH). The Regional Centre for Andaman and Nicobar Islands is in Composite Regional Centre for skill development, Rehabilitation and Empowerment of persons with disabilities (CRC), A&N in

Brookshabad wherein 3 dedicated staff are attending to any Mental Health Emergency 24x7. This helpline is available in 13 languages to enable persons to get informations/answers in his/her mother tongue.

Ghungroo - an indigenous breed of pig origin of North Bengal is popular among the local people because of its high prolificacy and ability to sustain in low input system. This

breed produces high quality pork utilizing agricultural byproducts and kitchen wastes. Ghungroo pigs are mostly black coloured with typical bull dog face appearance, with a litter size of 6-12 piglets

and adult pig weight about 90-110 kgs. Both sexes are very much docile and easy to handle. In the breeding tract they are maintained under scavenging (Contd. on last page)

system and mainly act as insurance to the rainfed agriculture. At the Departmental Cattle Holding Farm, Dollygunj these pigs are maintained under intensive system of rearing with standard breeding, feeding and management system and found that this indigenous breed of pig is performing very well in terms of productive and reproductive efficiency. Since pig farming is a lucrative venture it can be a prospective self-employment among the farmers.
Piglets of these pigs are available at Cattle Holding Farm. Interested farmers can contact the farm to adopt pig farming. Rearing pigs in urban area should be with the farmer's responsibility to maintain bio-security and hygiene and open range system of rearing is objectionable, a press release from Cattle Holding Farm, Dollygunj said.

India have announced their Twenty20 International squad against England for the upcoming five-match series. The five games will be held at Ahmedabad from March 12. Wicket-keeper batsman Rishabh Pant, all-rounder Axar Patel and pacer Bhuvneshwar Kumar have returned to the squad. Ishan Kishan, Suryakumar Yadav and Rahul Tewatia have earned their maiden India call. Varun Chakravarthy, who missed the Australia series due to an injury, has also been named in the team.

Novak Djokovic wins his 9th Australian Open title

Melbourne, Feb. 21
Defending Champion Novak Djokovic has won his ninth Australian Open Tennis title, beating Daniil Medvedev 7-5, 6-2, 6-2 in a one-sided final at Melbourne Park today. Victory takes Djokovic's grand slam singles tally to 18 - just two behind Roger Federer and Rafael Nadal.
Earlier, in Men's doubles, ninth seeded Croat-Slovak pair Ivan Dodig and Filip Polasek won the title today. They defeated defending champion and fifth seeded pair British Joe Salisbury and American Rajeev Ram 6-3, 6-4. This was their first Grand Slam as a team.

searching his bag, 650 grams of Methamphetamine was found from his possession. The drug was seized and the accused identified as Auobindo Biswas, S/o Shri Govindo (21Yrs), residing at Rama Krishna Pur, Little Andaman was arrested on the spot under relevant sections of law. Accordingly, a case U/s 22 (C) of NDPS Act 1985 has been registered against the accused. The entire raid took place under the Supervision of Shri Kalaivanan R, SDPO (Bambooflat).
In another incident, PS Hutbay team arrested one accused namely Biman Paul S/o Shri Bimal Paul, (34Yrs) residing at R.K. Pur, Little Andaman with 630 grams of methamphetamine from his garden. A case U/s 22 (C) of NDPS Act 1985 has been registered against the accused. The entire raid took place under the Supervision of Shri Abishek Gupta, SDPO (Swaraj Dweep).
It is to mention here that these drugs got washed to the shores of the Islands from the Myanmar vessel which was intercepted by the Indian Coast Guard in 2019. Possessing this deadly drug is a serious offence punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term of 10 to 20 years. Till date from the interception of the Myanmar vessels, a total of 537 kg 163 gms of methamphetamine has been recovered from the shores and through registration of NDPS Act cases against those trying to sell this drug.
Meanwhile, the general public have been requested to share information pertaining to any crime or other illegal activities to police at 112, 03192-232100 & 03192-233077. The identity of the informant will be kept secret, a press release from SPSA said.

been taken up with all Branch Managers of financing banks along with copies of the modified guidelines, probable activities which can be financed under the captioned scheme and target fixed etc. They have been requested to identify suitable beneficiaries under different activities from their area and sponsor their names to the implementing agencies for further action on the matter.
In order to provide clarifications, clear doubts and information on PMEGP 'phone in programmes' were organized by All India Radio in the current Financial Year 2020-2021. As such 45 awareness campaigns and People's Education programmes on PMEGP were organized at different Islands through which the first generation entrepreneurs were appraised about the benefits available under PMEGP scheme. Apart from this, interested beneficiaries were guided for preparation of project report and online submission of loan proposals under the captioned scheme.
As against the target of 96 units proposed to be financed under the PMEGP Scheme for the current financial year 2020-21, and on constant review at the level of Secretary (Industries) altogether 412 projects were sponsored to different scheduled commercial financing banks till 12/02/2021. Out of these, 412 sponsored cases, 205 projects have already been sanctioned by banks of which 101 projects have been financed with a total financial involvement of Rs. 448.64 lakh as total project cost. Out of these 101 financed cases, margin money subsidy of Rs. 103.29 lakh have been released in favour of 89 projects with an anticipated employment generation of 205 persons by these units. The progress is being reviewed with the all the banks at the level of Secretary (Industries), a press release from Directorate of Industries said.
