India and Singapore launch joint digital payment mechanism enabling easy and faster cross-border transactions



New Delhi, Feb.21

India and Singapore have launched a joint digital payment mechanism enabling residents of both the countries to make easy and faster cross-border transactions. Unified Payments Interface (UPI) of India and PayNow of Singapore have made a tie-up to facilitate these transactions.

Termining this launch a gift for the residents of both the countries, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra

Modi said, this will add a new chapter in fintech connectivity. He said, now people can transfer money with their mobile phones in a cost effective, swift and faster manner. He added that professionals, students among others will benefit with this payment mechanism.

Highlighting India's growth in the digital and fintech space, the Prime Minister said, Digital India has facilitated Ease of Living and Ease

of Doing Business in the country. He said, this has also helped in improving governance and public service delivery mechanisms. He said, money was transferred directly in the bank accounts of the citizens during the Covid pandemic. He said, India has become a leading country in the digital payment sector now and UPI has emerged as the favourite payment option in the country. He said, over 7 thousand 400 crore UPI

transactions worth 126 lakh crore rupees were made during the past year.

Prime Minister of Singapore, Mr Lee Hsien Loong appreciated the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi saying that the idea was first conceived when PM Shri Modi visited Singapore in 2018. He expressed happiness that the linkage of two payment systems has become a reality now. Termining this as another step forward

in the direction of ease of financial transaction, he said, it offers economical, faster and convenient money transfer which will contribute in improving trade between the two countries.

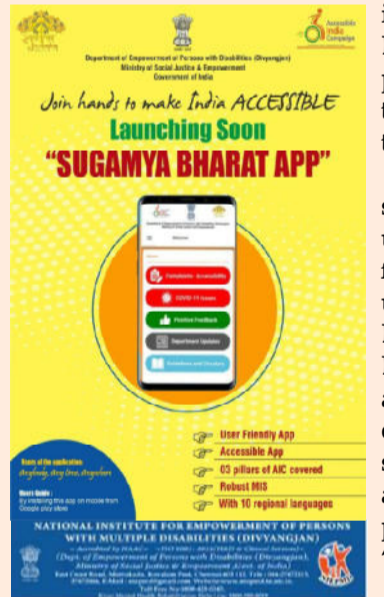

Pangong Tso lake marathon in Ladakh registered as world's highest Frozen Lake Marathon in the Guinness Book

Leh, Feb. 21
In Ladakh, country's first ever Frozen Lake Marathon on Pangong Tso has been officially registered in the Guinness Book of World Records as the world's highest Frozen Lake marathon. It was held on Monday at the world-famous Pangong lake at an altitude of 4,350 meters above the mean sea level. The Frozen Lake Marathon is first of its kind held in the country on Frozen Pangong Lake and is also considered as the toughest due to high altitude and freezing temperatures. The theme of the marathon is 'The Last Run' and is organised with an aim to promote winter as well as border tourism in Ladakh while creating awareness of climate change. India win two Gold Medals in Shooting at ISSF World Cup in Egypt

Cairo, Feb. 21
India clinched two gold medals on the second day of the ongoing ISSF Shooting World Cup at Cairo in Egypt on Monday. Indian 10m Air Rifle Mixed team of Narmada Nithin Raju and Rudranksh Balasaheb Patil and 10m Air Pistol Mixed team of Rhythm Sangwan and Varun Tomar have bagged the yellow metals. Indian rifle team trounced Hungary's Eszter Denes and Istvan Peni 16-6 in the gold medal play-off to bag the top spot on the podium. In the bronze medal contest, the German combination of Lisa Mueller and Maximilian Dallinger got better of Switzerland's Nina Christen and Christoph Duerr 16-12. In the 10m Air Pistol Mixed team event, the pair of Varun Tomar and Rhythm Sangwan routed Serbian pair Zorana Arunovic and Damir Mikec 16-10 to win the gold medal. Germany took third place after beating France 16-6 in the bronze medal play-off. Another Indian team of Divya Subbaraju and Sarabjot Singh missed out on a medal round after finishing fifth. The 19-year-old Varun also won bronze in the 10m Air Pistol Men event after beating compatriot Sarabjot on Sunday. India has so far won three medals in the competition with 2 golds and a bronze.
