Country registers highest number of new cases in a single day; over 2, 95,000 new cases of COVID-19 reported

2023 deaths recorded in a single day

New Delhi, April 21
The Health Ministry said, a record number of over 2,95,000 new cases have been reported in the country within 24 hours. This is the highest number of new cases registered in a single day since the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic in the country. With this, cumulative positive cases crossed one crore fifty six lakh mark.

The Ministry has said, there are over twenty one lakh fifty seven thousand active cases in the country at

Eight areas in South Andaman District declared as 'Containment Zones' to prevent further spread of virus

DC (SA) inspects few Containment Zones

Port Blair, April 21
To tackle the recent surge in the COVID positive cases in South Andaman and to prevent further spread of virus, the Administration has taken various proactive steps. In this connection, few areas in and around South Andaman District have been declared Containment Zones to restrict the movement of suspected cases. The areas notified as



Containment Zones are Haddo part, Junglighat part, Dollygunj part, Prothrapur part, Bathubasthi part, Garacharma part, Bambooflat part, Wimberlygunj part. Team comprising of officials from Revenue, Police, APWD and PBMC have been formed for the areas to maintain strict perimeter control and ensure that there is no movement of people in or out of these zones, except for medical emergencies and for maintaining supply of essential goods and services. Further, only essential activities and services shall be allowed in the containment zones and intensive house-to-house surveillance is conducted by surveillance teams formed for the purpose. Testing shall be carried out as per prescribed protocol and

Activities in places where mainland tourists can spread corona suspended for 4 weeks

Port Blair, April 21
In the wake of the recent surge in COVID-19 cases in A & N Islands and to manage the risk of spread of COVID-19 virus due to overcrowding of tourist places and in the interest, benefit and safety of the people in these Islands, the Directorate of IP&T has suspended all tourism activities in the National Memorial Cellular Jail, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Island, including the Light & Sound show at both these places, all museums, all beaches, Baratang Caves, all Water Sports activities and any other such tourism activities in all the three Districts, for 4 weeks starting from April 22, 2021, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

District Magistrate, N&M issues directives for strict compliance

Port Blair, April 21
In pursuance of powers vested u/s 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in order to enforce strict compliance of the National Directives on COVID-19 in North & Middle Andaman District and to prevent the spread of infections, the District Magistrate, N&M Andaman District has ordered that social/academic/sports/entertainment/cultural/religious/political functions and other congregations should be with explicit approval of the District Magistrate. Gatherings related to marriage not more than 50 persons and for funeral/last rites not more than 20 persons is permitted. Any person/organization violating the above directions will be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.10,000/-.

All persons coming to N&M District must undergo mandatory home quarantine for 7 days: DM (N&M Andaman)

Mayabunder, April 21
In view of the recent surge of COVID-19 cases in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, increased incidences of passengers coming to North & Middle Andaman District from Port Blair after negative (-ve) RAT testing in convoy and then becoming positive (+ve) after few days and to prevent the spread of virus in the district, the District Magistrate, North & Middle Andaman District, in pursuance of powers vested in u/s 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in order to enforce strict compliance of the National Directives of COVID-19 and to contain the spread of COVID-19 in North & Middle Andaman District, has directed that all persons coming to the district must undergo home quarantine for 7 days (seven days) mandatorily from the date of arrival into the district except those who are on Govt. duty. Corona cases in the country as well as in the Islands are rising and with a view to contain the spread of the disease in the Islands, the Administration as a precautionary measure has taken several concrete steps in this regard. Informing the scribes at a press conference held at IP&T today, the Secretary, IP&T, Shri Sunil Kumar Singh said during RAT conducted at Port Blair, 16 flight passengers have been detected corona positive while few others were detected from other places. 10 flights carrying 781 passengers

COVID-19: District Administration outlines precautionary measures to be adhered in buses (public and private) & market areas

Port Blair, April 21
There has been a sudden rise in the COVID-19 positive cases in the South Andaman District and in order to contain its further spread, the District Administration has ordered certain precautionary measures to be strictly complied with in buses (both public and private) and also by the shopkeepers/

vendors in the market areas in South Andaman District. Accordingly, in buses, the bus staff should be screened of ILI/SARI symptoms at least twice a day i.e. at the time of reporting and discharge from duty, by an IR thermometer. Suspect/symptomatic cases should not be allowed to perform duty and

should instead be isolated and referred to the District ILI/SARI Control Room No.03192-238881 for further management and testing for COVID-19. The passengers boarding the buses should be screened by the conductor of the respective bus for ILI/SARI symptoms by an IR thermometer and

To curb the spread of COVID positive cases in A&N Islands for the safety of the people, the District Administration has revised the existing Corona Curfew timing from 10 pm to 5 am to 9 pm to 5 am. In view of this, the Directorate of Shipping Services has decided to curtail the existing passenger/vehicle ferry service between Chatham-Bambooflat, Chatham-Dundus Point, Phoenix Bay- Bambooflat/Panighat during night hours. The schedule will come into force with effect from 22nd April, 2021. contact tracing shall be carried out in respect of all persons found positive, along with their identification, quarantine and follow up of contacts for 14 days. Surveillance for ILI/SARI cases shall be carried out in health facilities or outreach through telephonic and field surveillance.

Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner (SA) along with Shri Ravi Kumar Singh, SP (SA), Shri Hari Kallikkat, SDM (SA) and Ms. B. Yashaswini, AC (UT) and officials from other line Department inspected few Containment Zones at Lillypur, Haddo, Shivaji Colony and Vinayak Colony at Garacharma and took first hand stock of the situation, in order to ensure the proper implementation of containment zones and to monitor its enforcement.

The DC (SA) further inspected the Control Rooms set up at Zilla Parishad Conference Hall, where field surveillance and comorbid patients are being followed upon on regular basis. He also visited the Control Room setup at State Library, set up for follow up of ILI/SARI cases and Medicine distribution to the suspected cases through contact tracing.

DC (SA) reiterated and urged the officials present along with him to make sure that no stone is left unturned in strictly implementing the norms of containment zones in letter and spirit and also sought the cooperation of general public in maintaining the same and requested them to help the Administration in its fight against COVID-19. He emphasized that the five-fold strategy of Testing, Tracing, Treatment, COVID Appropriate Behaviour and Vaccination will be meticulously implemented in South Andaman, a press release from DC(SA) said.

timing has also been revised from 10 pm to 5 am to 9 pm to 5 am. Coaching centres and tuition centres have also been directed to follow COVID appropriate behavior and protocol.

Speaking about the vaccination drive being conducted in the Islands, he said vaccine doses are being administered smoothly in A&N Islands. He also stated that focus is to vaccinate all above 45 + as early as possible and shift to the next category of 18+ from May 1.

The Director, ANIIMS, Dr. AK Mondal, Director, IP&T, Shri Alok Kumar, Deputy Director, GBP Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De, Deputy Director (IP&T), Shri RS Meena were also present.

suspect/symptomatic cases should be conveyed to the District ILI/SARI Control Room for further follow up. Sufficient sanitizers should be provided in the operational buses for hand sanitization of all the passengers at the time of boarding. COVID appropriate behavior should be ensured in the buses as per the norms/guidelines of the MHA/MoH&FW and no passenger who is without a face mask/cover should be allowed to board the bus. Regular sanitization of the buses should be carried out by Hypochlorite solution/prescribed solution and frequent contact surfaces like hand rails, seat handles, window knobs etc. should be sanitized at regular intervals.

In markets, the vendors should be screened for ILI/SARI symptoms twice a day by the trained staff of the PBMC and i.e. once in the morning and in the evening. Suspect/symptomatic cases should thereafter be referred to the District ILI/SARI Control Room for further follow up. Regular screening of the persons visiting the markets should be conducted by trained persons of the PBMC using IR thermometers. Suspect cases/persons with ILI symptoms should immediately be referred to the District ILI/SARI Control Room for further follow up. Sanitizers should be kept by the vendors for use by the visiting customers and in case of markets/sheds with access control, sanitizers in sufficient numbers should be kept at the entrance for use by the public. It shall be ensured that social distancing norms are strictly followed at the markets as per the norms/guidelines of the MHA/MoH&FW. All shopkeepers/vendors should paint markings at spaces of 6 feet (2 Gaz) so that the customers maintain social distance.

Further, the shopkeepers/vendors should not allow more than 5 persons at a time in their shops to prevent crowding. No vendor/customer shall be allowed in the market without face cover/mask, an Order to this effect issued by District Magistrate, South Andaman said.

including Surveyor, Panchayat Secretaries of the RD Department, police personnel of the rank of the constable and above have been authorised to impose and collect fines as mentioned above. However, this does not bar any other legal action that may be attracted due to violation of any other Act/Law/Rule in force.
