A&N Islands stands 3rd in India in implementing GoI scheme of Unique Disability Identity (UDID) Card generation

Ministry generates 4126 e-UDID cards for Isles

Port Blair, July 21

The Social Welfare Department, A&N Administration is implementing the Govt. of India scheme of Unique ID for Persons with Disabilities in an effective manner to empower people with Disabilities. The Aadhaar-linked Unique Disability Identity (UDID) Card would ensure their ease to access various government schemes & benefits. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India had launched this project in the year 2016 with a view to create a National Database for PWD's and to issue a Unique Disability Identity Card to each person with disabilities.

The Ministry has so far generated 4126 e-UDID cards for A&N Islands,



out of the 4840 Divyangs and the coverage rate has also increased benefitting the divyangs in all the three Districts (South Andaman, N&M Andaman and Nicobars). A&N Islands stands 3rd in India in implementing the GoI scheme of Unique Disability Identity (UDID) Card generation.

The Unique Disability ID (UDID) smart card contains details such as disability percentage, personal details, identity, employment details,

education details and bank account numbers of a person with disability. With UDID card, the divyangs are eligible for free aids and appliances as per their abnormality/deformity from ALIMCO, they will get priority in medical treatment, priority at ticket counters, priorities in hearing of their grievances, free bus passes and free ship tickets in mainland bound ships once in a year and inter islands ships and boats as and when required, scholarship for students etc.

The project has not only brought transparency, efficiency and ease of delivering the government benefits to the person with disabilities, but also ensured uniformity. It has helped in streamlining the tracking of beneficiary at all levels of

Antigen Test (RAT)- a pillar to track COVID in rural areas thereby making testing easier, faster and accessible to people. More than 100 random RAT tests are being conducted in rural areas on a daily basis.

The scheme envisages providing Insurance Coverage to the farmers for crop loss arising out of natural calamities. The PMFBY supports sustainable income in Agriculture Sector by

The PMFBY has been presently notified for implementation throughout A&N Islands for Kharif

Season 2021. Under the scheme, paddy crop is presently notified for insurance. Maximum scale of finance fixed for paddy is Rs. 69506.00 per ha (for high yielding variety) and Rs.65676.00 per ha (for Traditional variety). Total sum that can be insured against possible losses is arrived at, by multiplying the scale of finance with the area covered.

She said, 28 States and UTs have completed the Aadhaar seeding of respective ration cards. 'Insurance Coverage' to farmers for crop loss...

As per the guidelines of PMFBY, 2% of the sum insured is to be paid by the farmers as Insurance premium for availing subsidy under the scheme. However, in case of Andaman and Nicobar, farmers need to pay only 0.5% of the sum insured while the remaining amount is additionally borne as subsidy. PMFBY covers risks of losses arising from either of the possibilities of prevented sowing, sowing to harvesting (due to drought, dry spell, flood, inundation, pest, diseases, landslide, natural fire, lightning, storm, hailstorm, cyclone etc.), post-harvest losses up to two weeks after harvesting. It also compensates the farmers against localized calamities affecting isolated farms in notified area/single peril risk.

Less than expected average yield due to mid-season adversity viz, floods, prolonged dry spells and severe drought etc. is also compensated for under PMFBY. The enrolment under the scheme is voluntary. All farmers including tenant farmers are eligible for coverage. The cutoff date for the enrolment under the scheme for Kharif, 2021 is 15/08/2021. The farmers have to approach the SBI or Co-operative Bank of the concerned areas alongwith land records and enroll under the scheme.

After enrolment, any losses to the crop arising out of risks covered in the PMFBY need to be mandatorily reported within 24 hours to the Insurance Company (National Insurance Company) directly or through Department of Agriculture and/or Department of Revenue.

The farmers of Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been appealed to take maximum benefit of PMFBY scheme, a press release from Directorate of Agriculture said.

carry forward in the next month. Further, all those AAY & PHH ration card holders who have not been able to receive their quota of sugar (12 kg) due to COVID-19 movement restrictions or any other reasons till the month of June, 2021 may now lift their quota of sugar till 31st July, 2021. Since this is one time opportunity, all such leftout AAY & PHH ration card holders have been requested to collect their quota of sugar before 31st July, 2021 after which no further extension shall be provided.

However, since portability has been implemented in the entire UT, ration card holders are free to collect their entitlement of food grains/ sugar from any FPS of their choice. Further, the migrants of other States living in this UT and are covered under NFSA in their respective States/ UTs can also receive food grains from any FPS of this UT under the 'One Nation One Ration Card' Scheme.

hierarchy of implementation - at village level, block level, District level, State level and National level. The Departments of Health and Social Welfare are coordinating to help the disabled get disability certificate from the notified medical authorities. A divyang with multiple disabilities is assessed by a Medical Board comprising of specialists to assess the percentage of disability and issue the disability certificate after which it is uploaded on the national portal: "www.swavlambancard.gov.in". The Social Welfare Department has urged the left out divyangians to contact nearby PHCs for renewal/new medical certificate for applying for UDID cards online.

The smart card has eliminated the hassles of the disabled to carry their disability certificates for different purposes since detail about the type of disabilities that they suffer from are included in the card. Moreover, the UDID cards will be valid all over the country. As a result, the divyang need not to make multiple copies of documents or carry multiple documents as the UDID card will capture all the necessary details which can be decoded with the help of a reader. The UDID card is the single document of identification, verification of the disabled for availing various benefits, Social Welfare Department sources informed.

Science and Technology is key to achieve Prime Minister Modi's Atmanirbhar Bharat

New Delhi, July 21 (PIB)

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh said Science and Technology is key to achieve Prime Minister Modi's Atmanirbhar Bharat. He said, the confidence of self-reliance will percolate down to the next generation and will help in attracting the best brains in the field of Science and Technology. Dr. Jitendra Singh was speaking after releasing a Review Committee Report on International S&T Cooperation prepared under the leadership of Dr. Anil Kakodkar, former Chairman of Atomic Energy Commission of India.



Dr. Jitendra Singh said that India is already a global power so far Science and Technology is concerned, but at the same time he called for streamlining and exploiting the huge untapped potential in tune with Prime Minister's mandate that scientific endeavour should be citizen-centric. He said, diversification should be taken as an advantage as very few countries are endowed with diverse resources.

Dr. Jitendra Singh said today India has Science and Technology cooperation with 44 countries and this list will be expanded in coming days and months. He also called for subject based, rather than Ministry based projects to achieve fruitful outcomes within stipulated time. The Minister also underlined the need for bringing more and more domain experts in international cooperation and at the same time remain deeply

connected with domestic arena. He said, we have to go beyond the realm of Science and Technology to achieve the true potential of such cooperation.

Dr. Jitendra Singh said that very soon, a new exercise will be initiated to hold brainstorming of each of the Ministries and Departments of Govt of India with the Ministry of Science & Technology, Ministry of Earth Science and CSIR. He recalled that over five years back, on the intervention of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, an extensive brain-storming exercise was held in the national capital wherein representatives from different Ministries and Departments were engaged in an intense interaction with scientists from ISRO and

CBDT extends e-filing of IT Forms 15CA, 15CB till 15th August

New Delhi, July 21

Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has granted further relaxation in electronic filing of Income Tax Forms 15CA and 15CB and extended the date of filing from 15th July to 15th August, 2021. The taxpayers can now submit these forms in manual format to the authorized dealers till 15th of next month. CBDT said that authorized dealers are advised to accept such forms for the purpose of foreign remittances. A facility will be provided on the new e-filing portal to upload these forms at a later date for the purpose of generation of the Document Identification Number. As per the Income-tax Act, 1961, there

is a requirement to furnish form 15CA and 15CB electronically. Presently, taxpayers upload the Form 15CA, along with the Chartered Accountant Certificate in Form 15CB, wherever applicable, on the e-filing portal, before submitting the copy to the authorized dealer for any foreign remittance.

A person making remittance to a Non Resident or a Foreign Company has to submit form 15CA. It is used as a tool for collecting information of payments which are chargeable to tax in the hands of the recipient non-resident. Form 15CB is the Form which is required to be signed by a Chartered Accountant. (Source: india.gov.in)

Mithali Raj back on top of ICC Women's ODI Player Rankings

India batting star Mithali Raj is back at the top of the ICC Women's ODI Player Rankings, the ninth time she is number one among batters since first occupying the spot more than 16 years ago, after West Indies captain Stafanie Taylor slipped to fifth position. In Tuesday's weekly update, which takes into account performances in the last three matches of the five-match series between the West Indies and Pakistan that Taylor's side won 3-2, the West Indies captain has lost 30 points after scoring 49 and 21 in the two times she batted.

Taylor who had reclaimed the number one position last week courtesy her unbeaten century in the first match of the series, has also lost her top position among all-rounders to Australia's Ellyse Perry and slipped three places among bowlers after going wicketless in the three matches.

Kyshona Knight (up 11 places to 42nd) and Britney Cooper (up 22 places to 81st) are the batters to move up the rankings for the West Indies while off-spinner Anisa Mohammed's six wickets see her advance three places to 23rd among bowlers. Hayley Matthews (up two places to 32nd) and Chinelle Henry (up 14 places to 67th) have also moved up that list.

For Pakistan, Ornaima Sohail's scores of 62, 61 and

34 have helped her jump 19 places to a career-best 36th position while Sidra Ameen (up five places to 62nd) and Muneeba Ali (up 20 places to 68th) have made progress among batters.

Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India amends Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Insolvency Resolution Process for Corporate Persons) Regulations, 2016

New Delhi, July 21 (PIB)
The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) notified the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (Insolvency Resolution Process for Corporate Persons) (Second Amendment) Regulations, 2016 on 14th July, 2021. The amendment regulations enhance the discipline, transparency, and accountability in corporate insolvency proceedings:

* A corporate debtor (CD) may have changed its name or registered office address prior to commencement of insolvency. The stakeholders may find it difficult to relate to the new name or registered office address and consequently fail to participate in the CIRP. The amendment requires an insolvency professional (IP) conducting CIRP to disclose all former names and registered office address(es) so changed in the two years preceding the commencement of insolvency along with the current name and registered office address of the CD, in all its communications and records.

* The interim resolution professional (IRP) or resolution professional (RP) may appoint any professional, including registered valuers, to assist him in discharge of his duties in conduct of the CIRP. The amendment provides that the IRP/RP may appoint a professional, other than registered valuers, if he is of the opinion that the services of such professional are required and such services are not available with the CD. Such appointments shall be made on an arm's length basis following an objective and transparent process. The invoice for fee shall be raised in the name of the professional and be paid into his bank account.

* The RP is duty bound to find out if a CD has been subject to avoidance transactions, namely, preferential transactions, undervalued transactions, extortionate credit transactions, fraudulent trading and wrongful trading, and file applications with the Adjudicating Authority seeking appropriate relief. This not only claws back the value lost in such transactions increasing the possibility of reorganisation of the CD through a resolution plan, but also disincentivises such transactions preventing stress to the CD. For effective monitoring, the amendment requires the RP to file Form CIRP 8 on the electronic platform of the

Board, intimating details of his opinion and determination in respect of avoidance transactions. The IBBI has specified the format of CIRP 8 through a Circular issued yesterday. This Form needs to be filed in respect of every CIRP ongoing or commencing on or after 14th July, 2021. The amended regulations are effective from 14th July, 2021. These are available at www.mca.gov.in and www.ibbi.gov.in.

Department of Space in order to work out how best space technology could be utilized as a modern tool for supplementing, improving and expediting infrastructural development as well as implementation of various welfare schemes. Following this, he said, space technology is now being used in diverse sectors including Railways, Roads and Bridges, Medical management/telemedicine, procurement of timely Utilization Certificates, disaster forecast and management etc. Dr. Jitendra Singh asked the scientists of different Ministries and Departments to further enhance collaboration in the field of Research & Development and step up activities and collaboration with industries and corporate houses. The Minister pointed out that while different Science Ministries are making noteworthy contributions to nation building, they should not be working in isolation. He said, COVID taught us more about the value of coordination and collaboration not at the domestic level but also on a global scale.
