MoS for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare visits Baratang Interacts with fishers; directs for establishment of Floating Jetty at Baratang

Port Blair, Feb. 22
The Minister of State for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India, Smti. Krishna Raj, who is currently on visit to the Islands, today visited Baratang Island and interacted with the officers of the Department of Fisheries and local fishers at Forest Guest House, Baratang. The fishers of the area put forth various issues like supply of fishing materials by the Department of Fisheries as done earlier, as the present supply of fishing materials by PRIs are not regular. They also requested for establishing a floating jetty at Baratang for safe berthing of fishing crafts. The fishers also informed that they are presently staying in the forest land and requested for their permanent settlement. The MoS patiently heard the grievances raised by the fishers and advised the Director of Fisheries to include the establishment of Floating Jetty in the Annual Plan 2018-19. Regarding settlement of the fishermen, she suggested to settle the fishers at Baratang by exchanging Revenue Land with the Forest Land. The Minister further advised to conduct regular



awareness programme on the various welfare programmes of Govt. of India under Blue Revolution, UT Plan, RKVY and Centrally Sponsored schemes among the fisher community. Dr. Utpal Kumar Sar, Director of Fisheries assured that the works related to establishment of floating jetty shall be taken up during 2018-19 while other issues raised by the fishers will also be attended on priority.

Establishment of Sainik School in Isles under PPP mode

Department of Education invites Expression of Interest

Port Blair, Feb. 22
The Department of Education, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, proposes to establish a 'Sainik School' of 300 students capacity in Swarajgram village of North and Middle Andaman District of Andaman and Nicobar Islands under the PPP (Private Public Partnership) mode. Land measuring 38 acres has been identified for this purpose which need forest / environment clearance for which necessary proposal is under preparation. Total plinth area of the physical infrastructure facilities / buildings of Sainik school shall be around 35000 sqm (approx.) which shall comprise of administrative block, academic block, library building, hostels etc., besides other facilities like basket ball courts, foot ball grounds, horse riding course, swimming pool etc. Initial capital cost would be about Rs. 100 crore in a phased manner. The proposal of Education Department is to create these physical infrastructure facilities of Sainik School on a Private Public Partnership (PPP) mode. Interested parties may submit their proposal for undertaking the project on a PPP basis, by 20th March 2018 to the Deputy Director Education (Plg), Directorate of Education, VIP Road, Port Blair.

China's Wu Dajing wins 500m in world record time

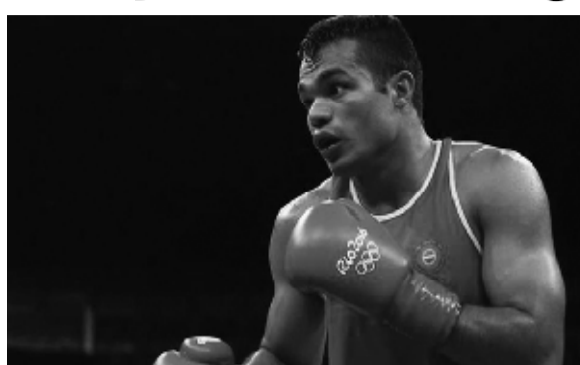
Gangneung, Feb 22
Wu Dajing won China's first Olympic gold medal in the men's 500 metres on Thursday, setting a world record time of 39.584 seconds to beat South Korea's Hwang Dae-heon. Wu, who in qualifying broke the previous record set by American John Celski in 2012, went 0.216 seconds faster in the final, with another South

Korean, Lim Hyo-jun, taking the bronze medal. The 23-year-old Chinese skater clenched his fists above his head in celebration as he took a victory lap around the rink at Gangneung Ice Arena. Wu won silver in 500m at the Sochi Olympics four years ago behind Russian Viktor Ahn, and he put in a flawless display in Korea, leading the

race from the start and finishing 0.27 seconds ahead of Hwang. Wu has dominated the distance since Sochi, winning 10 men's 500m races at world championships and in the World Cup. He failed to make it to the final of either the 1,000m or 1,500m after picking up penalties in qualifying.

Vikas Krishan, Amit Panghal in quarters of Strandja Memorial boxing

Sofia (Bulgaria), Feb 22
The seasoned Vikas Krishan and the fast-rising Amit Panghal advanced to the quarterfinals of the 69th Strandja Memorial Boxing Tournament for men and women here on Wednesday. Former World and Asian Games medalist Vikas (75kg), who is making a comeback after recovering from a hand injury, defeated Morocco's Amer Gnifid to make the last-eight stage. World Championships quarter-finalist Amit (49kg), a gold-medallist from last month's India Open, won his last-16 stage bout, getting the better of Mauritain Sharvin Kumar. Also advancing to the quarterfinals was Manish Panwar (81kg), who beat Morocco's Mohammed Amin.



However, it was early ouster for veteran Manoj Kumar (69kg), a former Commonwealth Games gold-medallist. The 31-year-old went down to Morocco's Abdelkadir Bellassek in his pre-quarterfinal bout, which was also his first of the tournament. India are assured of four medals so far in the tournament courtesy women boxers -- Seema Punia (+81kg), Saweety Boora (75kg), Mena Kumari Devi (54kg) and Bhagyabati Kachari (81kg). While Saweety and Meena won their quarterfinal contests, Seema and Bhagyabati got byes. Later in the evening session, Shiva Thapa lost an evenly-contested bout to Kazakhstan's Adilet Kurmatov. The Indian was the more attacking of the two but went down in a split verdict.

Saina faces Tai Tzu test, Sindhu gets easy opener in All England

Birmingham, Feb 22
Saina Nehwal faces her nemesis Tai Tzu Ying in the first round while P V Sindhu has got an easy opener against Thailand's Pompaewee Chochouwong after the Indian shuttlers were handed a tricky draw at the \$1000,000 All England Championship next month.



World No. 11 Saina, who had reached the finals at the 2015 All England Championship and lost to the Taiwanese World No. 1 Tai Tzu at the Indonesia Open last month, will get a chance to avenge her loss and better her dismal head-to-head record against the defending champion. Sindhu is expected to cross the first hurdle without much of a problem and in that case, she may get a chance to settle scores with American Beiwen Zhang Zhang in a likely second round clash. Zhang had defeated Sindhu at the India Open final. World No. 3 Kidambi Srikanth, also seeded third, had a rampaging run last season when he won four titles and he would face Frenchman Brice Leverdez in the opening round of the BWF World Tour Super 1000 tournament slated for March 14-18.

However, B Sai Praneeth and HS Prannoy will face tougher opponents in the opening round in men's singles. Singapore Open champion Praneeth will square off against former world number one Korean Son Wan Ho, while World No. 11 Prannoy, who is still recovering from the foot infection that saw him struggle at the India Open, will clash with eighth seed Chou Tien Chen of Chinese Taipei, who had finished runners-up twice at the India Open. In the doubles events, Chirag Shetty and Satwiksairaj Rankireddy, who had reached the semifinals of Indonesia Open, will face Takuro Hoki and Yugo Kobayashi of Japan, while India Open semifinalists Pranaav Jerry Chopra and N Sikki Reddy will take on Germany's Marvin Emil Seidel and Linda Efer in opening round. Manu Attri and B Sumeeth Reddy will meet England pair of Marcus Ellis and Chris Langridge, while Ashwini Ponnappa and Sikki will have to fight it out against second seeded Japanese combo of Misaki Matsutomo and Ayaka Takahashi. Rising women's doubles pair of Jakkampudi Meghana and Poorvisha S Ram will face fifth seeded Japanese pair of Shiho Tanaka and Koharu Yonemoto.
