New Delhi, Mar 22
Parliament gave its seal of approval to the Payment of Gratuity (Amendment) Bill, 2018 with the Rajya Sabha adopting it today. The bill was passed by voice vote during Zero Hour without discussion. The Lok Sabha had already passed the bill last week. Moving the Bill, Labour Minister Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar said it is a very important legislation for employees, especially

women. It seeks to notify the period of maternity leave as part of continuous service and proposes to empower the government to notify the gratuity ceiling from time to time without amending the law. The Bill will enable the government to enhance the ceiling of tax-free gratuity to 20 lakh rupees from the existing 10 lakh rupees for employees falling under the Payment of Gratuity Act. The legislation also allows the government to fix the period of maternity leave

for female employees as deemed to be in continuous service in place of the existing 12 weeks. The amendment to the payment of gratuity law comes in the backdrop of Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Act, 2017 enhancing the maximum maternity leave period to 26 weeks. Briefing reporters in New Delhi, Union Minister Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad termed the bill as historic saying its passage shows NDA government's pro-worker commitment.

Govt removes education fee cap of Rs 10,000 for martyrs' children

New Delhi, Mar 22
The government has removed the cap of ten thousand rupees per month on educational assistance given to children of army personnel martyred or disabled in action. The Ministry of Finance, in an order, said, the educational

concession will continue without cap of ten thousand rupees per month. The order added that educational concession will be admissible for undertaking studies in government or government-aided schools (Contd. on last page)

Shami has been given a Grade 'B' annual retainership contract, which will fetch him 3 crore rupees. He will also be free to play in the Indian Premier League for his franchise, the Delhi Daredevils, starting 7th of next month. The BCCI had decided to withhold Shami's contract after his wife made a series of allegations and lodged a police complaint



against him. The allegations included adultery and domestic violence. Shami has denied all the allegations. The Supreme Court appointed Committee of Administrators (CoA) specifically

asked its ACU chief Neeraj Kumar to investigate charges that the bowler accepted money from one Mohammed Bhai through a Pakistani woman named Alishba.

BWF rankings: Satwiksairaj, Chirag break into world top 20

New Delhi, Mar 22
Ahead of their campaign at the 2018 Commonwealth Games at Gold Coast City, in the southeast of Queensland from April 4-15, the Indian men's doubles badminton pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty have been given a psychological boost by entering the top 20 of the BWF rankings for the first time in their careers. Sattwik and Chirag -

aged 17 and 20 respectively - moved to No. 20 in the latest BWF rankings for men's doubles on Thursday. This means that India now has seven badminton players in the world top 20 - Kidambi Srikanth is currently second in the men's singles followed by HS Prannoy at 12th place and B Sai Praneeth at 15; in the women's singles, PV Sindhu is third and Saina Nehwal 12th. Like the

forementioned shuttlers, Sattwik is also a student of Dronacharya Pullela Gopichand whom he joined at the age of 14. Sattik and Chirag are hopeful of ending the men's doubles drought at the CWG, where they will turn out for the first time at the quadrennial games. Though they have yet to end up on the podium together, Chirag and Sattwik have achieved success on the badminton court.

West Indies beat Scotland by 5 runs via Duckworth-Lewis-Method to qualify for 2019 World Cup

Harare, Mar 22
West Indies qualified for the ICC World Cup after struggling past a gritty Scotland by five runs via Duckworth-Lewis-Method in a Super Six match of the Qualifier at Harare last night. Chasing 199 for a place in the next year's World Cup,

Scotland were 125 for five in 35.2 overs when a heavy downpour prevented further play in the match. While the result ended Scotland's hopes of featuring in their second successive World Cup and fourth overall since 1999, Afghanistan and Ireland

are now back in contention if rain affects today's match between the United Arab Emirates and Zimbabwe. If there is no result, then net run-rate will determine the second qualifier behind the Windies.

Australia beat India by 6 wickets in T20I tri-series opener

Mumbai, Mar 22
Australian women's cricket team comfortably beat India by six wickets in the opening encounter of the T20 Tri-series, in Mumbai on Thursday. Batting first, India scored a decent 152 for 5, riding on Smriti Mandhana's 41-ball-67 but the Southern Stars cruised to the target in 18.1 overs with opener Beth Mooney contributing 45 off 32 balls. Skipper Meg Lanning with an unbeaten 35 off 25 balls and Elyse Villani (39 of 33 balls) also



contributed in their team's winning cause. Brief Scores: India 152/5 in 20 overs (Smriti Mandhana 67 off 41 balls, Anuja Patil 35 off 21 balls).

Australia 156/4 in 18.1 overs (Beth Mooney 45 off 32 balls, Meg Lanning 35 off 25 balls, Elyse Villani 39 off 33 balls). Australia women win by 6 wickets.

Serena Williams out of Miami Open as Naomi Osaka wins in straight sets



Miami, Mar 22
Serena Williams crashed out of the Miami Open in the first round here Wednesday, slumping to a straight-set defeat against Japan's Naomi Osaka in the latest setback to the former world number one's comeback. Osaka, who won her first major title in Indian Wells last weekend, was superior throughout and fully deserved her 6-3, 6-2 win in just one hour and 17 minutes. It was Williams' fourth match and second tournament

appearance since returning from 13 months maternity leave yet the American's movement and inability to stay in the rallies suggested her comeback could be more arduous than expected. The defeat was the first time Williams has lost her first match at an American hard court championship for 21 years. Williams, 36, may have been unfairly unseeded here due to her lack of action over the past year could have no complaints with the defeat.

England all out for 58 in Auckland Test

Auckland, Mar 22
England were all out for 58 runs in just over 90 minutes of the first Test against New Zealand on Thursday, with the tourists narrowly avoiding their record lowest score in a Test innings.

New Zealand bowlers Trent Boult and Tim Southee struck early and often on the first day of the day-night Test at Eden Park as England looked as if they might fail to beat the 45 they limped to against Australia in Sydney in 1887. However, Craig Overton, who had been brought in as bowling cover amid concerns about the fitness of all-rounder Ben Stokes, top scored with a counter-attacking 33 not out in a 10th-wicket partnership with James Anderson to avoid the unwanted record.

Elavenil Valarivan wins 10m Air Rifle gold in junior ISSF World Cup, breaks qualification world record

Sydney, Mar 22
Indian shooter Elavenil Valarivan shattered the qualification world record and claimed the gold medal in 10m women's air rifle event of the season's first junior ISSF World Cup in Sydney on Thursday. Besides her individual podium finish, Elavenil also combined with Shreya Agrawal and Zeena Khitta to claim the team gold medal.

Arjun Babuta bagged his second junior world cup medal, claiming a bronze in men's 10m air rifle event. The 18-year-old Elavenil, competing in her second World Cup and first final, shot 249.8 in the women's final to claim the top individual honours. Her 631.4 in the qualification was a new world record. After a 9.6, Elavenil sealed the win with a high 10.7 in the crucial 24th shot, getting the



better of Chinese Taipei's Lin Ying-Shin. Elavenil had also won a bronze medal at the FISU World Shooting Sport Championship last week. China's Wang Zeru managed to win the bronze medal with a score of 228.4 in her first World Cup appearance. India's other finalists in the event — Shreya and Zeena — finished sixth and seventh, respectively, enough to clinch the team gold medal ahead of Chinese Taipei's Lin, Tsai Yi-Ting and

Hung Chen-Ching. The bronze was claimed by Zhu, Wang and Gao Mingwei of China. Babuta, a silver medallist at last year's Asian Championship in Wako City, Japan, finished below Yuqi Liu of China (247.1) and Zalan Pekler (246) of Hungary, with a score of 226.3. The other Indian shooters in the event — Surya Pratap Singh and Shahu Tushar Mane — finished sixth and eighth respectively.

The order said, the concession will also be applicable to students studying in autonomous institutes financed by central or state governments.

Under the scheme, which was initially rolled out in 1972, tuition fee of children of martyrs or those disabled in action were completely waived in schools, colleges and other professional educational institutions. Earlier, Defence Minister Smti Nirmala Sitharaman had requested the Finance Ministry to remove the cap. The Army, the Navy and the Air Force Chiefs, had also written to the Defence Ministry requesting it to remove the cap imposed in July last year.

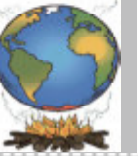
