## Country's growth is expected to expand at 7.4 % in the next fiscal:RBI Governor

Mumbai, Apr 22 RBI Governor Shri Urjit Patel has said, the country's growth is expected to expand at 7.4 per cent in the next fiscal. Addressing the International Monetary Finance Committee in Washington, Shri Patel said, the Indian economy turned in a resilient performance in 2017-18, and it is expected to accelerate in 2018-2019. He said, the real GDP growth was moderated to 6.6 per cent from 7.1 per cent a year ago, but there was a strong rebound in the second half of the year on the back of a turnaround in investment demand. The RBI Governor said, global demand is now improving, which should encourage exports and

boost fresh investments. He said, this could help accelerate the pace of growth. Shri Patel also said, since November 2016, headline consumer price inflation had generally remained below the medium-term target of four per cent. He added that an unusual spike in vegetables prices pushed up inflation to a recent peak of 5.2 per cent in December, but it eased in subsequent months to reach 4.3 per cent in March. The RBI Governor said, several factors are likely to influence the inflation outlook, including a possible moderation in food prices if the monsoon turned out to be normal and was supported by an effective food supply management.

## National Lok Adalats held Awards passed by Lok Adalats are not appealable before any Court of Law: Chairman DLSA

Port Blair, April 22 The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman and Nicobar Islands held National Lok Adalats in the District Court Building, Port Blair, ADR Centre-'PRAYAS', Port Blair, District Court Building, Mayabunder and J.M.F.C Court Building at Diglipur today. Out of the total 852 pre-litigation, bank recovery cases, one case referred by High Court and 28 cases pending in Courts at Port Blair were referred to the National Lok Adalat. About 65 pre-litigation bank recover cases were disposed involving amount of Rs.44,56,316/- has been settled at Rs.27,47,500/- thus paving a benefit of Rs.17,08,816 to the bank loan customers and earning spot payment of



Rs.1,73,500/- and pending criminal compoundable cases were also disposed in the National Lok Adalat. ## Drivers & conductors of public service vehicle advised to wear uniform

Port Blair, April 22 As per Rule 7 and 23 (a) & (b) of Andaman and Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicle Rule, 2006, wearing of uniform are mandatory by drivers of all transport class vehicles i.e. LMV-GV & cab drivers, auto-rickshaw drivers, truck drivers and bus drivers and conductors of stage carriage buses both STS as well as private. Rule 7 of ANIMVR, 2006 states that the driver of a public service vehicle other than driver of State

Transport Service (STS), while on duty, shall wear khaki uniform with a nameplate in Hindi & English affixed on it. The driver of STS shall wear uniform as prescribed by the STS of A&N Administration. And as per Rule 23 of ANIMVR, 2006, a conductor while on duty shall wear a khaki uniform with the nameplate, written in Hindi/English, displayed prominently above the left hand pocket of the shirt and the conductor of a State

Transport service shall wear the uniform as prescribed by such State Transport Service. The drivers and conductors of public service vehicle, both STS as well as private have been advised to strictly follow these provisions. Penal action would be taken against the violators. The special enforcement drive would be carried out jointly by officials of Transport and Police Department, a communication said.
