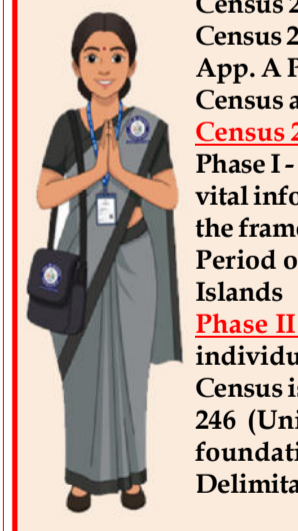

**ORDER**

(U/s 163 of BNSS, 2023)

WHEREAS, it has been reported by the Assistant Commissioner, Diglipur vide Letter No. 4-14/Rev/AC(NA)/DP/2025-26/350 dated 31.03.2026 that improvement work of the rural road from main road to Badur Tikrey at Gandhinagar village is to be undertaken by APWD under SFA scheme.

AND WHEREAS, it has been stated that the said road is presently being used by heavily loaded vehicles which may adversely affect the quality and timely execution of the work and may pose safety hazards.

AND WHEREAS, it has also been reported that there is no alternative route available and the said road serves as the only means of connectivity for the residents of Gandhinagar village.

AND WHEREAS, it has been proposed that restriction of movement of heavy vehicles is necessary for smooth execution of the work while allowing limited movement of two-wheelers and STS buses to minimize inconvenience to the general public.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 163 of BNSS, 2023, do hereby order that:

1. Movement of heavy vehicles on the Badur Tikrey road at Gandhinagar village shall remain temporarily restricted for a period of twenty-five (25) days with immediate effect.
2. Two-wheelers and STS buses shall be permitted during morning hours and for return trips, so as to minimize inconvenience to the general public.
3. The Executive Engineer, APWD, Diglipur shall ensure proper barricading, signage, and necessary safety measures at the work site during the execution of the work.
4. The Deputy Superintendent of Police, Diglipur shall ensure strict compliance of this Order.

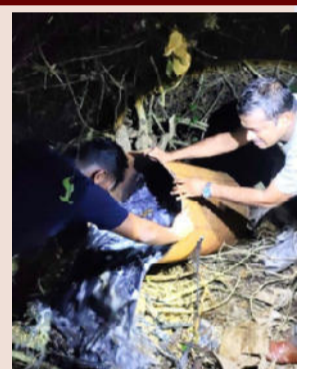

**PS Billiground busts illicit brewing, 450 ltrs destroyed**

On 21.04.2026, acting on credible information about illicit liquor brewing in a dense forest near Govindapur Village under Nimbudera, a police team of PS Billiground, led by SI Manickam, SHO PS Billiground, conducted an intensive search operation in the suspected area. During the operation, approximately 450 litres of illicit Lehan (fermented wash), concealed at multiple locations within the forest, was detected and recovered. However, no claimant or suspected person was found at the spot. No.71/2026/F.No. 34-725/2026-Rev.- Whereas it appears to the appropriate Government that a total of 87.7902 hectares land is required in the Campbell Bay, Govind Nagar, Joginder Nagar, Vijay Nagar, Laxmi Nagar and Gandhi Nagar villages of Campbell Bay Tehsil of Nicobar District for public purpose, namely the Acquisition Land for the Project of Trunk Infrastructure at Great Nicobar Island.

The Social Impact Assessment (SIA) was carried out by Social Welfare Department through M/s Probe Research and Social Development Pvt. Ltd., Delhi and a report submitted / preliminary investigation was conducted by a team constituted by Collector as laid down under Rule 4 of the said Rules vide Order No. 17 dated 03.12.2025 and Social Impact Assessment report was received vide Letter dated 14.11.2025. The copy of SIA Report, copy of Expert Group Report and copy of Committee Report have been annexed as 'Annexure-I', 'Annexure-II' and 'Annexure-III' respectively.

The summary of the Social Impact Assessment Report / Preliminary investigation is as follows:  
This development of Trunk Infrastructure is for Public Purpose. Hence, as per the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 Section 2-(1)-(a & b), the acquisition of land for the project serves public purpose.

The Committee finds that the public purpose of the proposed Trunk Infrastructure project is immense. The project not only holds substantial benefits for the local community including the people affected by the land acquisition, but also serves a larger purpose for the nation as a whole. The strategic location of the Nicobar Islands, coupled with improved connectivity, will enhance economic, social, and defence-related integration, thereby bolstering national security and development.

A total of 201 families are likely to be displaced due to the land acquisition. The reason necessitating such displacement is that as per findings of the committee, the acquisition of land for the aforementioned project serves public purpose and after going through all the required technicality of the Trunk Infrastructure construction by the experts, SIA team and all stakeholders have selected the Campbell Bay, Govind Nagar, Joginder Nagar, Vijay Nagar, Laxmi Nagar and Gandhi Nagar villages as the most suitable site.

The Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District is appointed as Administrator for Rehabilitation and Resettlement vide A & N Administration Notification F. No. 34-725/2017-Rev. dated 14.11.2017 under Section 43 of the Act for the purpose of rehabilitation and resettlement of the affected families. The copy of the Notification is annexed as 'Annexure-IV'.

Therefore, it is notified that for the above said project in the Campbell Bay, Govind Nagar, Joginder Nagar, Vijay Nagar, Laxmi Nagar and Gandhi Nagar villages of Campbell Bay Tehsil under Nicobar District, a piece of land measuring 87.7902 hectares of standard measurement, whose detailed description are annexed as 'Annexure-V-A', 'Annexure-V-B' and 'Annexure-V-C', is under acquisition.

This Notification is made under the provisions of Section 11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (30 of 2013), read with Notification No. 11-197(E), dated 23.06.2017 of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, to all whom it may concern.

A plan of the land may be inspected in the Office of the Collector and Tehsildar during the working day and working hours.  
The Government is pleased to authorize Officer Tehsildar and his revenue field staff to enter upon and survey land, take levels of any land, dig or bore into the sub-soil and do all other acts required for the proper execution of their work as provided and specified in Section 12 of the said Act.

Under Section 11(4) of the Act, no person shall make any transaction or cause any transaction of land i.e. sale / purchase, etc. or create any encumbrances on such land from the date of publication of such Notification without prior approval of the Collector. Objections to the acquisition, if any, may be filed by the person interested within 60 (Sixty) days from the date of this Notification as provided under Section 15 of the Act before Collector.
