#### Encourages people to appreciate good films & learn the nuances of film-making through workshops

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 22

The first ever month long 'Weekend Film Festival- 'Chalchitra- Andaman Nicobar Film Festival - 2026', being organised by the Directorate of Information, Publicity & Tourism, A&N Administration, in collaboration with the National Film Development Corporation (NFDC) began in the Anthropological Auditorium, Sri Vijaya Puram here this evening.



The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhusan Kumar, IAS, declared the Film Festival open as the chief guest in the presence of the Commissioner-cum-Secretary, IP&T, Ms Chanchal Yadav, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Ms Purva Garg, IAS, other senior officers from the Administration, Ms Shivangi Singh & Shri. ## Farmers advised to adopt integrated measures for control of Mealy Bugs & Ants

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 22

Mealy bug incidence is observed during the hot & dry season in Coconut, Vegetables and Fruit Crops in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Mealy bugs suck plant sap, weaken plant growth and secrete honeydew that promotes sooty mould development. Ants protect and spread mealy bugs from plant to plant in exchange for honeydew, thereby increasing infestation levels. Farmers are therefore advised to regularly monitor their crop and to adopt integrated management practices at an early stage to prevent economic losses.

**Recommended control measures:**

- Regularly inspect plants, especially the undersides of leaves, tender shoots and stems for early infestation.
- Isolate and remove heavily infested plant parts to prevent spread.
- Rake the soil around plants twice and apply Neem cake @ 4 kg/tree.
- Remove weeds and alternate host plants from the field.
- Spray 2% Neem oil. Spraying soap solution (5 gm/ lit.) before the spraying of Neem oil can help in removing waxy layer of mealy bugs.
- Apply Fish Oil Rosin Soap (FORS) @ 25 g/L to reduce pest load.
- Spray Beauveria bassiana @ 5 g/L during humid months in reducing the population of Mealy bugs.
- For small infestations, use insects using cotton dipped in isopropyl alcohol or dislodge them with a strong water spray.
- Control ant movement by destroying ant colonies and applying sticky bands on tree trunks to prevent ants from carrying mealy bugs.

## Directorate of Fisheries in coordination with FSI to organize Access Pass Application Saturation Camp at Fish Landing Centre, Junglighat today

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 22

The Directorate of Fisheries, A&N Administration, has informed all stakeholders of the fishing community that, as per the prevailing provisions for operation of fishing vessels in the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ), all motorized fishing vessels having an overall length of 24 meters and above, and all mechanized fishing vessels, are required to obtain an Access Pass for carrying out fishing operations in the EEZ. Further, motorized fishing vessels exclusively engaged in fishing of tuna and tuna-like species are also eligible for issuance of Access Passes.

The Access Pass is issued through the ReALCraft Portal after verification of vessel documents and seaworthiness, and is essential for ensuring lawful fishing operations, monitoring, surveillance, safety compliance, and conservation measures in the EEZ.

In this regard, the Directorate of Fisheries, in coordination with the Fisheries Survey of India (FSI), Sri Vijaya Puram Base, will be organizing an Access Pass Application Saturation Camp at Fish Landing Centre (FLC), Junglighat on 23/05/2026 at 10 am to ensure

Walk-in interview for enrolment as Civil Defence Volunteers in South Andaman District possessing the requisite qualification and experience etc. to act as first responders in case of disaster situation or hostile enemy attacks in the South Andaman District as detailed here as under.

**Eligibility Criteria**

1. Residence	Should be a Citizen of India and should be a resident of South Andaman District and having one valid identification document (Voter ID/Aadhaar Card/Passport/Driving License/Bank Passbook, or any Employment Identity Card issued by Government-Authority, with a photograph).
2. Age	Must be between 18 to 40 years of age.
3. Education Qualification	Should have passed at least 10 <sup>th</sup> standard and can be relaxed by the Controller at his discretion.
4. Health	Should be found physically fit, mentally alert and also with normal vision/correct vision after wearing spectacles.
5. Experience	Preference will be given to applicants who have served in the National Volunteer Force/Home Guard and in the Armed Forces of the Union.
6. Police Verification	Applicants, who are found otherwise fit, will be eligible for enrolment as Civil Defence Volunteers only after verification of character and antecedents by police. Any person with criminal background and doubtful integrity will not be enrolled as a member of this organization under any circumstance.
7. Last date for submission of application	Last date for submission of application is on or before 06/06/2026 at the District Control Room of South Andaman District.

Displaying exceptional presence of mind, they administered emergency first aid and made all possible efforts to revive her on the spot. Subsequently, she was immediately shifted to PHC Kadamtala for urgent medical treatment. Owing to the timely intervention and dedicated efforts of the PMF personnel, she regained normal breathing and is presently undergoing treatment at PHC Kadamtala, a press release from SP, N&MA said.

**PS Pahargaon solved blind kidnapping case**

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 22

In continued commitment to ensuring the safety and security of women and children, Andaman & Nicobar Police successfully recovered a missing minor girl within 48 hours upon receipt of the information.

On 19/05/2026, father of the victim girl, a resident of Garacharma lodged a report at PS Pahargaon regarding missing of his younger daughter from home on 18/05/2026. Upon this, a case has been registered at PS Pahargaon and a special team was immediately constituted under the supervision of Insp. Sahil Shamsuddin, SHO PS Pahargaon. The team developed leads by analyzing CCTV footage collected from the surrounding areas and conducting criminal profiling of suspects. Further technical analysis and human intelligence inputs led the team to track a suspect in the Bambooflat area. Upon search, the victim girl was safely rescued and the accused was apprehended from Bambooflat area. Further, the victim was handed over to her parents after completion of legal formalities.

The case was solved under the leadership of Shri Deependra Kumar Singh, SDPO South Andaman and overall supervision of Smti Shweta K Sugathan, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District, a press release from SP (SA) said.

**N&MA Police solve robbery case; recovers stolen property**

Mayabunder, May 22

A robbery case was reported at PS Mayabunder by a resident of Swadesh Nagar on 21.05.2026. The complainant alleged that while returning after visiting Dr. R.P. Hospital, he was assaulted near Pokadera Beach by two persons, who snatched his mobile phone, extorted cash, and robbed a gold chain.

Based on the complaint, a case was promptly registered at Mayabunder Police Station and immediate investigation and search operations were launched. As the accused persons had absconded, information was circulated to nearby Police Stations. Acting swiftly on the inputs, Diglipur Police Station detained both accused persons on the same day. PS Mayabunder team subsequently proceeded to Diglipur and, after completing codal formalities, arrested both accused on 22.05.2026. complete coverage of Access Passes for all left-out eligible fishing vessels.

During the camp, the Department shall facilitate on-the-spot handholding support to boat owners and fishers for submission of Access Pass applications through the ReAlCraft Portal, including assistance in verification and uploading of required documents.

All owners/operators of eligible mechanized fishing vessels and motorized fishing vessels engaged in tuna and tuna-like fishing activities, who have not yet obtained the Access Pass, are requested to attend the camp along with relevant vessel documents for availing the facility.

The Department appeals to the fishing community to actively participate in the campaign and complete the Access Pass formalities within the stipulated time to ensure compliance with the regulatory framework governing fishing operations in the EEZ. 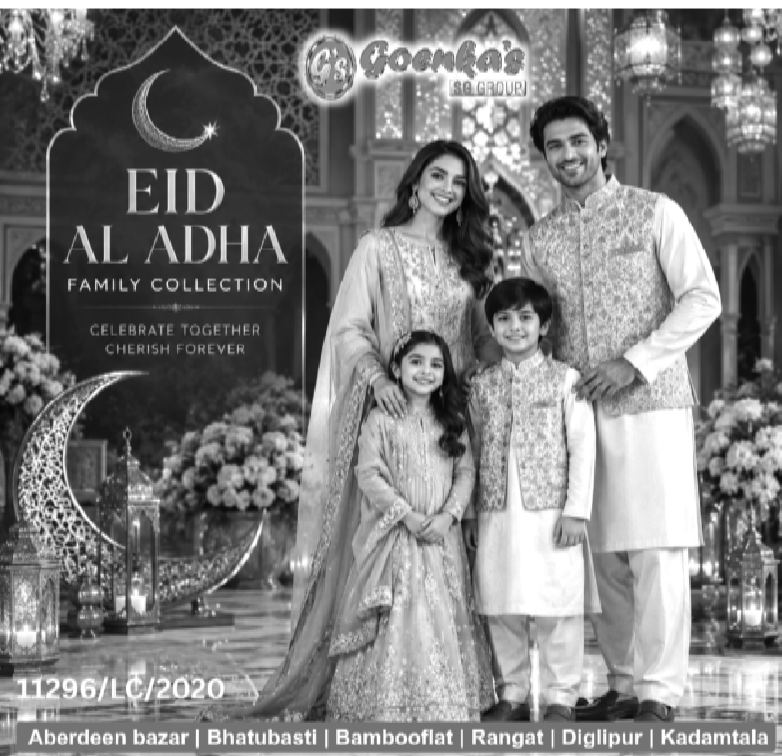
