Andaman and Nicobar: India's Unsinkable Aircraft Carrier in the Indian Ocean

Andaman and Nicobar Islands are a vital strategic and economic asset for India. Intrepid sailors have for centuries berthed at these islands which are an irreplaceable geographic asset at the crossroads of global trade. They are uniquely positioned in the Indian Ocean, prompting their being labelled a natural and unsinkable aircraft carrier.

For India, the islands are a God-given gift. Seafaring nations have long recognised their importance and the Dutch, Danes, British and Japanese have, for varying durations, occupied it, but the British ruled it since the mid-19th century. In fact, as British rule in India drew to a close in 1947, officers of the Admiralty in London argued that the Andaman and Nicobar Islands were strategically important

and should not be handed over to independent India but retained by the British. One argument maintained that the Indians would not realise it was theirs! Finally, the British viceroy ruled that all possessions should be handed over to the Indian government. The British Admiralty's interest was simple: they understood that whoever controlled these islands would possess a commanding position over the eastern Indian Ocean

and the maritime approaches to Southeast Asia.

India can no longer afford to neglect the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The islands have shifted from being viewed as a peripheral outpost to becoming India's crucial forward defence line. Yet, major projects like the Great Nicobar Project (GNP) have predictably ignited debates on development versus conservation. India has to balance the protection of the

National Immunization Day for Polio on June 28

Children in the age group of 0-5 years to be administered polio drops in Isles

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 22
India has remained free of wild polio cases since January 2011, and India's unprecedented progress against polio has led to the certification of South East region, including India by WHO in March 2014 as polio-free. As per the recommendations of the India Expert Advisory Group (IEGA) one Single Polio National Immunization Day (NID) will be conducted on 28th June, 2026, covering all the children in the age



group of 0-5 years of age by administering two drops of bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) at Booths followed by house to house visits by the staffs in the next two days to search and vaccinate the missed out /unimmunized children with the goal is to ensure that no child will ever again suffer

from the crippling effects of polio in the entire world.

Dr. Avijit Roy, Deputy Director (Health) and State Immunization Officer, led the briefing, emphasizing the Administration's commitment to maintaining India's polio-free status and

expanding preventative healthcare for adolescent girls. This year, it is estimated that around 19343 children will receive the vaccine during the round in 447 booths across these Islands. A booth in the airport, Sea-port and other transit points has also been set up.

All tourists and people living in forest areas will also be covered under this program. Our Target is to cover 100% of eligible children, and we also appeal to the general

Backyard poultry farming is being actively promoted by the Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services as an important tool for income generation, women empowerment, and nutritional upliftment in rural and semi-urban areas of the Islands. The Vanaraja and Guinea Fowl breeds have been specifically chosen for their adaptability to local climatic conditions, good disease resistance, and dual-purpose (egg and meat) production potential, a press release from Dept. of AH&VS said.

inspections of pharmacies by Drug Inspectors in South, North & Middle Andaman to ensure compliance with drug regulations and deter the unauthorized sale of drugs, including anti-TB medications and antibiotics without valid prescriptions. He emphasized that medicines should not be sold above the Maximum Retail Price (MRP), as overcharging places an undue financial burden on patients and constitutes a violation of regulatory provisions. He also directed that Look-Alike Sound-Alike (LASA) drugs should be maintained separately and clearly identified to minimize the risk of dispensing errors and ensure patient safety.

Further, he stressed that medicines such as Aspirin and Disprin, which may pose health risks if used inappropriately, should not be dispensed without proper medical advice or prescription. Furthermore, he highlighted that the sale of MTP (Medical Termination of Pregnancy) pills in private shops without proper medical supervision poses a significant risk to the health of mothers.

Dr. Ganesh Samadder, Deputy Director (Medical), expressed his concerns on the results of surprise inspections conducted by Drug Inspectors, which included sale of drugs by unauthorized person, improper management of records of drugs like Schedule H & H1 drugs register with prescription copies, sale of sedative drugs including cough-syrup, Alprazolam, Nitrazepam, Clonazepam, Diazepam etc., and about repeated dispensing of medications based on a single prescription.



Shri Ashok Biswas, Nodal Officer (Prohibition), Directorate of Social Welfare, stated that if any suspicious activity or signs of substance abuse among young children and adolescents are noticed, the information should be promptly shared with the Social Welfare Department at phone number 9933283106 for appropriate intervention and support.

Shri Manoj Lall, Sub Inspector (CID) Anti-Narcotics and Shri. Vivek Mishra, President of A&N Chemists and Druggist Association also spoke on the occasion.

The general public have been requested, to pass the information to the Health Department at phone number 9434266561, if any drug abuse is noticed in and around the retail pharmacy stores, a press release from DHS said.
