PM launches recruitment drive 'Rozgar Mela' for 10 lakh personnel

Several steps taken to provide employment in last 8 years: PM

New Delhi, Oct. 22 Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched a mega recruitment drive, Rozgar Mela, for ten lakh personnel today. On this occasion, appointment letters for various posts of Central Government were handed over to 75 thousand of newly inducted appointees in the first tranche.

While addressing the new appointees through video conferencing, the Prime Minister said, this is another step to provide employment opportunities to youth. He said, several steps have been taken by the Government to provide employment and self employment opportunities in the last eight years. He said, India is marching

He said, the Government has set a target to spend 100 lakh crore rupees on infrastructure development in the country. He said, works for creating robust

Port Blair, Oct. 22 The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, IAS, along with Shri Dilkhush Meena, IAS, Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SA), Smti Pramila Kumari, Adhyaksha, Zila Parishad, Tehsildar, Ferrargunj, Zilla Parishad member, and concerned Gram Pradhan, Ward members visited the areas predominantly inhabited by Ranchi community in Mithakhari, Namunagar, Brindaban, Tushnabad

Gram Panchayats. During the visit, the DC (SA) interacted with the Ranchi community residents in these areas. The common issues raised during the interaction were frequent power cuts, irregular distribution of LPG cylinders, water supply, construction/repair/maintenance of roads etc.

In Mithkhari GP, the people raised the issue of electricity cut due to which activities of people were affected badly. The residents further requested for set apart of land for

playground and PHC, separate Power Sub-Station, separate feeder for the Gram Panchayat and shifting of one of the transformer from Surya Chakra. Regarding the issue of irregular supply of LPG cylinders, DC (SA) directed the concerned distributor to prepare monthly schedule for LPG cylinder distribution and strictly adhere to the schedule. The Tehsildar, Ferrargunj and the area Patwari were also directed to handover the unutilized old building constructed under MPLAD fund to the Gram Panchayat, so that it can be used for multipurpose activities. It was informed that the road work towards Boating house and Boating house complex will be undertaken by Zilla Parishad, South Andaman for which estimate has been prepared already.

Nicobar Islands, Shri Mohit Shisodia, Air Commodore, A&N Command, Shri Bhisham Sharma, Inspector General, Coast Guard and other senior officers of Andaman & Nicobar Police paid tribute to the brave souls by placing the wreaths & flowers at the 'Shaheed Smarak'.

21st October is observed as 'Police Commemoration Day' every year. 'Commemoration Day Parade' is conducted by the police forces of

States/UTs and different Central Police Organizations to pay homage to 10 policemen, who were killed in Ladakh in the face-off with the Chinese Army in 1959 and all other police personnel who have sacrificed their lives in the service of the nation. Since 1947, nearly 36000 brave policemen have made supreme sacrifice while protecting the nation and its citizens from crime, terrorism and insurgency.
