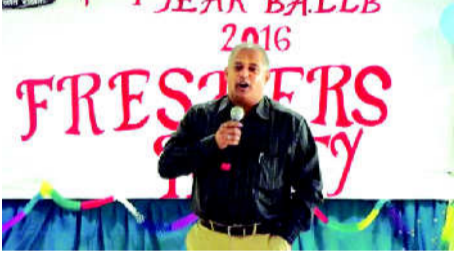

RBI issues guidelines on wedding withdrawals

New Delhi, Nov 22
Reserve Bank has said that banks can disburse 2 lakh 50 thousands rupees to members of public who have a wedding in their family on or before December 30, 2016. In a notification, it said that withdrawal can be made by either of the parents or the person getting married and only from those accounts that are fully KYC compliant. RBI has asked banks to fully verify that the amount proposed to be withdrawn is to be used for payment to persons who do not have a bank account. Evidence of the

wedding, including the invitation card, copies of receipts for advance payments already made, such as marriage hall booking, advance payments to caterers, etc must be produced by the person intending to withdraw the money. Additionally, a detailed list of persons for whom cash payment is required along with a declaration from such persons that they do not have a bank account will be mandatory. RBI has said that banks shall keep a proper record of the evidence and produce them for

verification by the authorities in case of need. In another notification, RBI has asked banks to allow farmers to draw upto 25000 rupees per week in cash from their loan, including Kisan Credit Card limit or deposit accounts subject to their accounts being fully KYC compliant. RBI has also allowed traders registered with APMC markets to withdraw 50,000 rupees cash from their current account if they are KYC compliant and in operation from last three months or more.

'INS Chennai' commissioned into Navy

Mumbai, Nov 22
Defence Minister Shri Manohar Parrikar on Monday commissioned 'INS Chennai', the third indigenously designed guided missile destroyer in the Kolkata class in Mumbai. Built at the Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited in Mumbai, the ship's construction also marks the end of the Project 15A to build Kolkata class guided missile destroyers. Chief of the Naval Staff Admiral Sunil Lanba was present on the occasion.



With an overall length of 164 metres and displacement of over 7,500 tonnes, 'INS Chennai' is one of the largest destroyers in the Indian

Navy's fleet. The ship is armed with supersonic surface-to-surface BrahMos missiles and Barak-8 long range surface-to-air missiles.

Centre forms panel to assess the status of demonetisation drive

New Delhi, Nov 22
Centre has constituted a committee comprising Additional Secretaries, Joint Secretaries and Directors to know the status of implementation of its recent decision to scrap 500 and 1000 rupees currency notes. Finance Ministry in a release said, the committee will visit the States and union territories and submit its report by 25th of this month. Each of the officers will visit different areas of the State and

Union Territories separately and the focus will be on the rural areas. The committee will submit a report on the general outlook and challenges arising out of implementation of the scheme. The team will check the currency availability across the State in the network of bank branches, ATMs and post offices. It will see the facilities at bank branches and post offices for deposit, withdrawal and



exchange of currency. The committee will also check the impact of the decision on various segments including households,

agriculturists, wage earners, traders, transportation, industries, informal sectors and small business.

India successfully conducts twin trial of Prithvi-11 missile

Chandipur, Nov 22
India yesterday successfully test-fired its indigenously developed nuclear capable Prithvi-II missile twice in quick succession as part of a user trial by the Army from a test range at Chandipur in Odisha. In salvo mode, the two surface-to-surface missiles which have a strike range of 350 km and are capable of carrying 500 kg to 1,000 kg of warheads were successfully test-fired in quick succession from mobile launcher from launch complex-3 of the



Integrated Test Range (ITR) at around 9.35 AM, defence sources said. A similar twin trial had been conducted on October 12, 2009 from the same base where both tests were successful. Inducted into Indian

armed forces in 2003, the nine-metre-tall, single-stage liquid-fuelled Prithvi-II is the first missile to be developed by the DRDO under the Integrated Guided Missile Development Programme, defence sources said.

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ORDER

WHEREAS, a disciplinary proceedings under Rule-23 of the Industrial Standing Orders applicable to the Industrial Employees of South Andaman Forest Division [Framed under the Industrial Employment Standing Orders Act, 1946] was instituted against Shri Isack, Mazdoor of Manglutan Range for unauthorisedly absenting from Govt. duty with effect from 06.09.2011 onwards. Accordingly, an article of charge was framed against him vide this Office Memorandum No. 2-2229/LS-2002/273 dated 26.11.2014.

AND, WHEREAS, Shri A.C. Tilak, Assistant Conservator of Forests was appointed as the Inquiring Authority to enquire into the charges framed against the said Govt. worker vide this Office Order No.SA/C/03 dated 6th January, 2015. Shri P.K. Sultan Ahmed, Forest Ranger was also appointed as the Presenting Officer to present on behalf of the disciplinary authority the case in support of the article of charge vide this Office Order No. SA/C/04 dated 6th January, 2015.

AND, WHEREAS, the Inquiring Authority has accordingly conducted the enquiry and submitted his findings to the undersigned vide his letter No. ACF/SA/INQ/12 dated 28th July, 2015.

AND, WHEREAS, the undersigned accepted the findings of the Inquiring Authority and forwarded a copy of the inquiry report dated 28.07.2015 indicating the proposed penalty of dismissal from service to Shri Isack, Mazdoor to his home address at Car Nicobar by Regd. post requiring upon him to make representation/ submission if he so desires within 15 days of receipt of the same vide this office Show Cause Notice No. 2-2229/LS-2002/151 dated 06.08.2015.

AND, WHEREAS, he has submitted a representation on 10.10.2016 wherein he stated that he has got nothing to say on the proposed penalty of dismissal from service and the charges framed against him. He, further, stated that due to some medical problem, he is not in a position to serve in the Department any more. However, he has not submitted any medical certificate in support of his illness. He also requested to take necessary action as deemed fit and also to release all his dues and benefits at the earliest.

AND, WHEREAS, considering the abovementioned facts/ observation, inquiry report, representation of Shri Isack, Mazdoor and other evidences on records, the undersigned hold that all reasonable opportunities were given to Shri Isack, Mazdoor but he could not avail the opportunities provided to him.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned hold that Shri Isack, Mazdoor is guilty of the charges as framed against him vide this Office Memorandum No. 2-2229/LS-2002/273 dated 26.11.2014 and considering the gravity of the misconduct involved in the article of charge, the undersigned hold that he is not a fit person to be retained in Govt. Service. The undersigned, therefore, awards the penalty of dismissal from service, which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment to Shri Isack, Mazdoor with immediate effect.

Other members of India's Test squad to make upwards movements are Cheteshwar Pujara, whose 119 in the first innings in Visakhapatnam helped him move from tenth to ninth; pace bowler Mohammed Shami who gained five places to reach a career-best 21st place; and Ravindra Jadeja who moved up one spot to sixth.
