Hon'ble Prime Minister to unveil model of National Memorial dedicated to Netaji to be constructed on Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island & also name 21 Unnamed Islands of A&N Islands after 21 Param Vir Chakra Awardees via video conferencing today

Hon'ble Union Home and Cooperation Minister, Shri Amit Shah to grace the occasion at DBRAIT

New Delhi, Jan. 22(PIB)

On Parakram Diwas, Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will unveil the model of the National Memorial dedicated to Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose to be built on Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Island tomorrow (January 23) at 11 AM via video conferencing. This will be followed by a short video showcasing the proposed memorial to be set up at NSCB Island. During the programme, Hon'ble Prime Minister will also name 21 unnamed Islands of Andaman & Nicobar Islands after 21 Param Vir Chakra Awardees. A short video on the naming of 21 Islands of Andaman & Nicobar will be screened on the occasion. The event will take place in the Auditorium of DBRAIT, Port Blair. Hon'ble Union Home and Cooperation Minister, Shri Amit Shah will grace the occasion and present mementos to 21 Param Vir Chakra Awardees/family members on the occasion. Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency will also attend the function. Giving due respect to the real-



life heroes of the country has always been accorded highest priority by the Prime Minister. Going ahead with this spirit, it has now been decided to name the 21

unnamed Islands of the Island group after 21 Param Vir Chakra Awardees. The largest unnamed Island will be named after the first Param Vir Chakra

Awardee, the second largest unnamed Island will be named after the second Param Vir Chakra Awardee, and so on. This step will be an everlasting tribute to our heroes, several of whom had made the ultimate sacrifice to protect the sovereignty and integrity of the nation.

These Islands have been named after the 21 Param Vir Chakra awardees, viz. Major Somnath Sharma; Subedar and Honorary Captain (then Lance Naik) Karam Singh, MM; 2nd Lt. 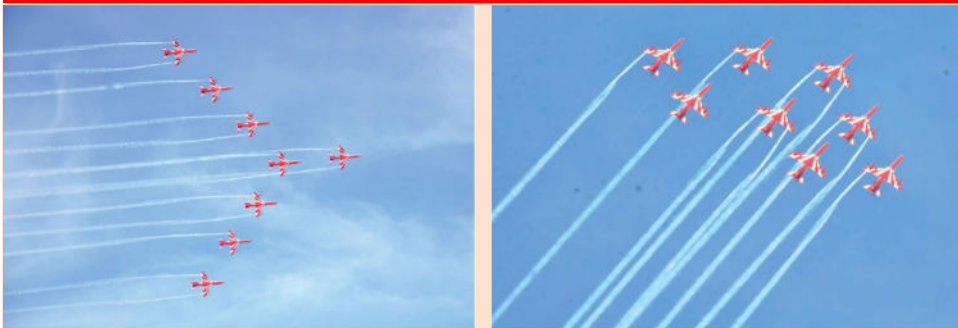

A scintillating performance was put up by aerobatic team of Surya Kiran (SKAT) at Marina Park here this afternoon, as part of the various events being organized by A&N Administration under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav Iconic Events Week celebration to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence & Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's 126th

Birth Anniversary, to pay tribute to Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. The display was open to the general public and thousands of people lined up the Marina Park area to watch the aerobatics demonstration. The Suryakiran Aerobatic Team of the Indian Air Force put up a stunning air show in Port Blair today as people came out on balconies and terraces besides gathering on roads to watch the aerial display. This was

the first ever air show by Suryakiran Aerobatic Team in A&N Islands. The aerobatic team of Surya Kiran left the audience enthralled with their daredevil stunts and precision maneuvering. The crowd watched the nine aircraft skimming overhead in different directions amidst loud cheer. The perfect crosses and breathtaking maneuvers executed by the pilots were a treat to the eyes. The figure

created in the sky by the aircraft in smoke pods was the testimony to its high-level skill of flying. A special heart shape figure created by the aircraft in the midst air, drew loud applause from the gathering. The Surya Kiran Aerobatic Team (SKAT) was formed in 1996 and is a part of 52nd Squadron of the IAF. The team has since performed numerous demonstrations usually with nine aircraft.

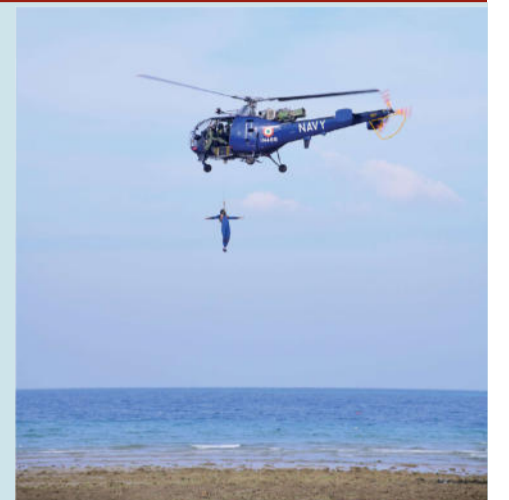
Naval Band delights gathering with patriotic rendition at Marina Park

Indian Navy to commission fifth Kalvari class submarine 'Vagir' today

New Delhi, Jan. 22

The Indian Navy is set to commission the fifth Kalvari class submarine Vagir tomorrow (Jan. 23). The submarine, built in India by Mumbai's Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Limited in collaboration with France-based M/s Naval Group, will be commissioned by Chief of the Naval Staff, Admiral R Hari Kumar.



According to an official press release, Vagir has the distinction of having the lowest build time among all indigenously manufactured submarines to date. Vagir will boost

Indian Navy's capabilities as it is capable of undertaking diverse missions including anti-surface warfare, anti-submarine warfare, intelligence gathering, mine laying and surveillance

missions.

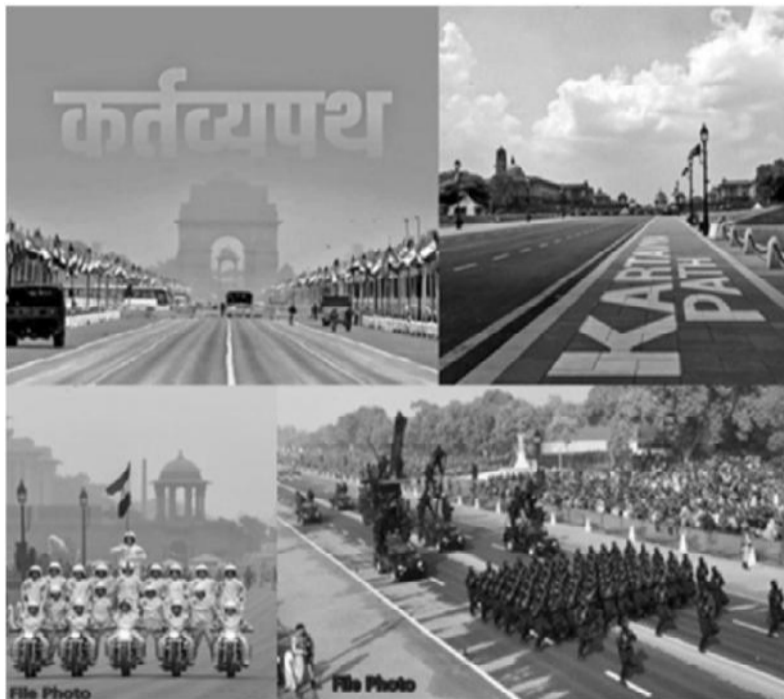
Movement of inland tourist vessels operating from Aberdeen Jetty diverted to Junglighat Jetty in view of Republic Day celebration


