PM Modi lays out his vision for making India 10 trillion dollar economy

New Delhi, Feb.23
 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today laid out his vision for making India a 10 trillion dollar economy, and the third-largest in the world. Addressing the Global Business Summit in New Delhi, Shri Modi said, he wants the nation to have countless startups, and be a leader in the global drive towards renewable sources of energy. The Prime



Minister said, his government is working hard to create a New India

which fulfils the aspirations and dreams of 130 crore Indians. He said, his vision of new India includes addressing the challenges of the future while also solving problems of the past.

Shri Modi said, his government caters to all sections of the society, irrespective of their economic profile, their caste, creed, language and religion. The Prime Minister asserted that when his government came to power, there was a complete policy paralysis, plagued by runaway inflation and rising current account

deficit. He said, but in the last five years, hesitation has been replaced by hope, obstacles have given way to optimism, and initiatives have replaced issues. Shri Modi said, today while India prepares to send a man to Mars, it is also ensuring that every Indian has a roof over his head. He said, while India is building 100 smart cities across the country, it is also ensuring rapid progress in over 100 aspirational districts. Shri Modi said, while India has made its fastest train, it has also eliminated all unmanned railway crossings.

Lt. Governor to launch PM KISAN scheme in Isles Scheme aims to supplement financial needs of farmers

Port Blair, Feb.23
 The State level launching ceremony of PM KISAN scheme in A&N Islands will be held at Raj Niwas at 11 am tomorrow (Feb.24). The Lt. Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will launch the scheme in the Islands simultaneously with the National Level launching

ceremony by the Prime Minister at 11.30 am from Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh. With a view to augment the income of the small and marginal farmers, the Government has approved a Central Sector Scheme, 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN)', 100 % funded by Govt. of India in the current financial year. The Scheme aims to supplement the

financial needs of the farmers in procuring various inputs to ensure proper crop health and appropriate yields, commensurate with the anticipated farm income. Under the scheme, financial benefit of Rs.6000/- per year will be provided to all small and marginal farmer families, having total cultivable holding of upto 2 hectare, which will be provided in 3 equal

installments of Rs.2000/- each in a period of every four months in a financial year. The benefit shall be admissible for the transfer w.e.f. 01.12.2018. The first installment to eligible beneficiaries during this financial year 2018-19 shall be for the period from 1.12.2018 to 31.03.2019, a press release from the Director of Agriculture here said.

Implementation of PM-SYM scheme; unorganized sector's workers advised

Port Blair, Feb.23
 The Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan (PM-SYM) is being Implemented in the Islands together with the rest of the country. PM-SYM is a voluntary contributory pension scheme. Any worker in the unorganized sector, whose monthly income is upto Rs.15,000/- and who is between 18-40 years of age, shall be eligible to enroll into the PM-SYM pension scheme. He/she shall receive an assured monthly pension of Rs.3,000/- after attaining the age of 60 years for which he/she shall deposit a nominal monthly subscription



ranging from Rs.55/- to Rs.200/- depending on the entry age. The Central Government shall also deposit equal matching share of monthly subscription in his pension account. The facilitation

counters/desks have been set up in all the UT Administration Labour Offices, in the Office of Asst. Labour Commissioner (Central) and LIC Branch Office, ESIC and EPFO office to

ISSF World Cup 2019: After 16 years, Apurvi Chandela wins India's first World Cup gold in Women's 10m Rifle

New Delhi, Feb 23
India's Apurvi Chandela on Saturday broke World Record to register India's first gold medal at the ISSF World Cup 2019. The 26-year-old shooter shot 252.9 in a thrilling 10m Women Air Rifle finale to bag the yellow metal on Day 1 of the tournament at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Range in New Delhi.



Chandela had a slow start in the final. Her first shot went 10.1. After the first two series of five shots, she was at the 7th position. But as the game progressed, she gained the momentum to stay on top. In the final round, Chandela was engaged in a neck-and-neck battle with China's Zhao Ruozhu, who had earlier broken the World Record in the Qualification stage, scoring 634 points. But in the final two-shot

series, Chandela shot a 10.6 and a 10.8 to win the top prize, while Ruozhu had to settle for silver. China's Xu Hong, who gave a tough battle to Chandela for gold, won bronze scoring 230.4 in the final. Speaking about the high intensity clash, Chandela recalled the Munich World Cup last year, when she dropped from the top position to finish 4th. "In Munich World Cup, I was leading and then I dropped down. It was a freak shot, it

wasn't a malfunction. It was my error. But I am glad, I was able to move past that because such things can play in your mind. I think I beat myself in that way." In terms of Olympic quotas, it means little for India, with Chandela and Anjum Moudgil already having the maximum number of quotas available in the event for a country. But the medal win certainly adds to the expectations from the shooting contingent at Tokyo Olympics next year.

Team will respect government decision on India-Pakistan match in World Cup: Virat Kohli

London, Feb 23
Indian captain Virat Kohli today said, his team will respect the government's decision with regards to playing Pakistan in the 50-over World Cup beginning in May in London.



There has been calls to boycott the 16th June World Cup face-off against Pakistan at Old Trafford in the aftermath of the Pulwama terror attack. Speaking on the eve of India's opening T-20 against

Australia at Visakhapatnam, Kohli said, his team's stand is simple. They will stick by what the nation wants to do and what the government and

BCCI decide to do. He also offered his condolences on behalf of the entire Indian team to the families of the martyred soldiers.

India ready to mix and match against Australia in T20s



Visakhapatnam, Feb 23
The Indian team will be aiming to lock in the last couple of available slots in their England-bound World Cup squad, when they square off with familiar foes Australia in a limited-overs series starting with the first T20 here on Sunday.

The seven-match series, comprising two T20 Internationals and five ODIs against a struggling Australian side, will be India's last international assignment before the mega event starting May 30 in England and Wales.

With all but two places sealed, Virat Kohli and Ravi Shastri will also treat these two T20 games as an extended audition for the World Cup hopefuls, who are still on the waiting list. Skipper Kohli is back after a well-deserved three-week break and will be keeping a keen eye on the likes of Rishabh Pant and Vijay Shankar, two players who are strongly tipped to make the final list.

Having edged out Dinesh Karthik in the ODI side in the race to the World Cup, Pant will get a few more chances to

make a strong case for himself. For Shankar, it will be a great opportunity to make his case even stronger in the absence of Hardik Pandya, who is out with a recurring lower back injury. Shankar has shown that he could be explosive with the bat and the question will be how effective he can be with the ball. No one more than Dinesh Karthik will be more keen to make a statement as these two games will effectively be his last chance as he has already been dropped from the ODIs against Australia.
