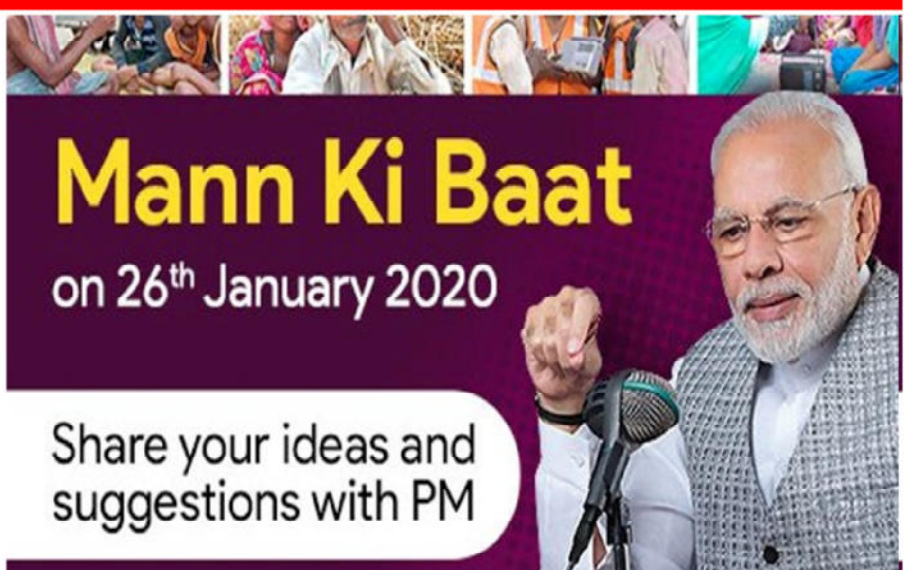

If a driving license is suspended/disqualified, then the Driving License holder is disqualified from driving that category of vehicles during the suspension/disqualification period. All the drivers/motorist have been advised to carry their original driving license while driving their vehicles with immediate effect failing which fine/penalty as per M.V. Act/ Rules shall be imposed on them. If any person whose driving license is disqualified/suspended, is found driving any vehicle during the disqualification period, then severe action would be taken against them, a communication from the Deputy Director (Admn/Vig.), Transport Department said.

Virat Kohli not looking for ODI World Cup loss revenge in T20I against New Zealand

Auckland, Jan 23
Virat Kohli-led Indian cricket team will take on New Zealand in the first of the five-match T20 International series on Friday but the Men in Blue skipper on Thursday said that he cannot really bring himself to think of revenge when the two sides clash for the first time after their One Day International (ODI) World Cup 2019 semi-final tie in England. New Zealand had knocked India out convincingly in the World Cup semis at Old Trafford in Manchester by 18 runs. The loss still rankles him but Kohli has spoken repeatedly about how devastating the loss was for him personally as India had gone into the World Cup as one of the pre-



tournament favourites. The India-New Zealand T20 International is the first clash between the two sides since then. "Even if you want to think of revenge, these guys are so nice you cannot get into that zone. We get along really well with these guys and it's all about being competitive on the field. As I said in England, they are probably one side that has set the example for teams to play international cricket," said Kohli at the pre-match press conference in Auckland. Williamson and his men had drawn effusive praise for their grace in the aftermath of a heartbreaking World Cup final loss to England, a game that was decided on boundary count after scores were tied.

U-19 WC: Confident India look to carry on momentum against New Zealand

Bloemfontein, Jan 23
Already through to the quarterfinals after two resounding wins on the trot, defending champions India will be keen to maintain their unbeaten run when they face New Zealand in the final Group A tie of the ICC U-19 World Cup on Friday.

India, who are atop their group with four points, had cruised to a 90-run victory over Sri Lanka in their opening encounter before outclassing debutants Japan by 10 wickets with disciplined bowling efforts. The Priyam Garg-led side will start as favourites against New Zealand on Friday.



New Zealand, on the other hand, were unlucky to share a point with Japan after their match was washed out in Potchefstroom last week. However, they managed to clinch a late winner against Sri Lanka and book a place in the last eight. New Zealand, who had finished eighth on home soil in 2018, will be looking to follow a similar trajectory as their senior counterparts, who reached the finals of the men's World Cup last year, in this edition of the U-19 showpiece. Having won the warm up matches against Zimbabwe and Afghanistan and the quadrangular series, the Indian team would not want to lose the rhythm at any cost.
