High Court refuses to entertain the application to recall its Order of 18.06.2020 in COVID related matters

Port Blair, June 22

Today, Double Bench of High Court at Calcutta comprising Chief Justice Thottathil B. Radhakrishnan and Justice Arijit Banerjee while disposing the application filed apparently on behalf of Bar Association, A&N Islands to recall its Order dated 18.06.2020 observed that "we are not inclined to recall the order dated 18th June, 2020" and that "the application taken out for recalling of the order dated 18th June, 2020 is not entertained".

On 18.06.2020, the Hon'ble High Court while disposing the matter in CAN 3149 of 2020 in WP No. 5324(W) of 2020 had observed that "we see no reason to keep the interlocutory application pending", while acknowledging that the Central Government guidelines regarding the quarantining of passengers arriving in the islands issued by the Home Ministry have been framed and the same are being scrupulously followed by UT Administration.

Earlier in similar matters challenging the measures taken by the A&N Administration, the Hon'ble Court was fully satisfied with series of action taken by the Administration in the maintenance of supplies of essential commodities and appreciated the efforts of the A&N Administration in preventing contagion of

COVID-19 in Children Protection Homes in the islands and directed that the procedure followed by the Child Care Institutions in Andaman and Nicobar Islands shall be replicated at all such Homes in West Bengal vide its Orders dated 08.04.2020 and 21.04.2020.

Hon'ble Court had commended the multipronged efforts made by the Andaman and Nicobar Administration to control the crisis caused by the outbreak of the COVID-19 while disposing of the Writ Petition No. 5324(W) of 2020 in its Order dated 15.05.2020, a press release from A&N Administration said.

Reform measure by A&N Administration

Tenders invited by APWD shall be open for all contractors irrespective of their enlistment in APWD or any other Govt. Department

Port Blair, June 22

At present, in Andaman Public Works Department (APWD), the construction works of various magnitudes are invited through open bidding system among enlisted contractors of APWD/ other departments of appropriate class from I to V. In order to promote competition and open avenue for participation of all contractors in the tenders invited by APWD, the Andaman and Nicobar Administration has decided that henceforth, the tenders invited by the APWD shall be open for all contractors irrespective of their enlistment in APWD or any other Govt. Department subject to the condition that they have experience on executing the relevant magnitude of work as per CPWD Works Manual and with other GOI organisations in these Islands and do not have any adverse remarks.

This reform measure by the Administration will dispense with the cumbersome process of getting compulsory enlistment by the contractors, revalidation/extension of validity of such enlistments etc and also simplifies the participation in tenders by contractors without any requirement of enlistment.

Food Safety Index for 2019-20 announced

A & N Islands secures third position under UT Category

Port Blair, June 22

The Food Safety Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands has been adjudged at the third position in the second State Food Safety Index for 2019-20. This was announced during a webinar conducted on the occasion of 'World Food Safety Day' on 7th June, 2020 on the theme 'Food Safety is every one's business'.

The State Food Safety Index ranks states on five parameters. These

parameters are human resources and institutional data, compliance, food testing facility, building and capacity and consumer empowerment. Parameter wise performances by States are judged and scores are allotted.

During this year, FSSAI divided States/UTs into three categories viz. large States, small States and Union Territories. Under UT category, Chandigarh has

scored 73 points and placed at first rank, Delhi at second rank with a total score of 68 and Andaman & Nicobar Islands at third rank scoring 67 points out of 80.

The Food Safety Department is committed to ensure the availability of safe, wholesome and nutritious food to all Islanders and would put in more efforts in the future, in this endeavour, a press release from Joint Commissioner (FS) Andaman & Nicobar Islands said.

Promoting efficient use of energy in A&N Islands

4 lakh LED bulbs distributed under UJALA Scheme; 35000 conventional street lights replaced with LEDs

Port Blair, June 22

Andaman and Nicobar Islands is one of the developing economic hubs under tourism industry and other hospitality sector. During the recent past, Port Blair has witnessed an increase in power demand. This has led to various challenges in some of the energy intensive sector and forced the local administration to look into areas where the efficient use of energy and its conservation can be promoted. In this regard, the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) alongwith Ministry of Power has launched the initiative to promote efficient use of



energy through its nation-wide schemes like UJALA (Unnat Jyoti Affordable LED for All), SLNP (Street

Lighting National Programme), DSM (Demand Side Management), ECBC (Energy Conservation Building Code).

Accordingly, the Electricity Department, A&N Administration has implemented the UJALA and SLNP schemes in A&N Islands too. Detailing about the UJALA Scheme, a press release from Electricity Department said that about 4 lakh LED bulbs have been distributed to all the domestic consumer of these Islands @ Rs.10/- per bulb. Similarly, under the SLNP (Street Lighting National Programme), 35000

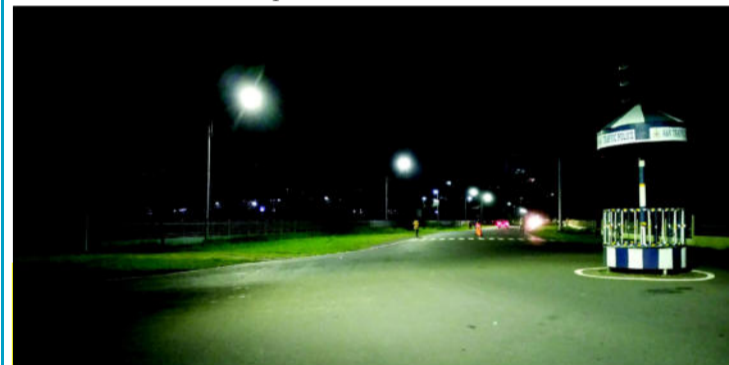
Informing about the progress of the works, the Secretary, PBMC in a press release said that the works have been delayed due to lockdown imposed in connection with spread of COVID -19. However, the work pertaining to Community Halls near Island Bakery, Dairy Farm, Shadipur, Brookshabad & Pahargaon are expected to be completed by July, 2020, he said.

Further, the construction of Community Hall at Chakkargaon has been completed and the renovation of Community Hall at South Point is also expected to be completed by July 2020. With the completion of the renovation works of each community hall, around 4000 to 4500 population will be benefitted, the press release issued by Secretary, PBMC added.

conventional street lights have been replaced with LED Street Lights in entire A&N Islands including Municipal and Panchayat areas. This has contributed in bringing down the peak load demand in all the Islands further effecting saving in the diesel consumption and reduction in carbon footprint.

Under the Model Energy Efficient Village Campaign, 3 villages have been made energy efficient by replacement with energy efficient luminaries and further there is a plan to convert 12 more villages in Chowra and Teressa as energy efficient villages.

In order to phase out the use of filament lamps and encourage the use of LEDs, a filament lamp free campaign has been initiated under which Electricity Department has notified a ban on sale/purchase of filament lamps in A&N Islands, so that such inefficient luminaries can be curbed at the source itself. As a green initiative, MNRE has sanctioned 90% CFA for installation and maintenance of 1100 solar streetlights under off grid and decentralized Solar PV Programme Phase-III. The installation will be completed by December, 2020 in various Islands. In line with this, all the Govt. Offices and buildings under A&N Administration have been taken-up for replacement of conventional luminaries with LEDs.

The Energy Conservation Building Code for commercial buildings has been notified and shall be enforced on such commercial buildings that have a connected load of 50 KW and above. This shall ensure that the upcoming buildings are energy efficient and all the luminaries are LED based.

To achieve a sustainable future, Electricity Department, Andaman and Nicobar Administration is promoting the efficient use of energy in these Islands and solicit the cooperation of all the Islanders to come together in the mission of making these Islands energy efficient through the above DSM Programme, the press release added.
