### Development of Water Aerodromes for Seaplane Operations under Regional Connectivity Scheme-UDAN

### Tender for construction of infrastructure at Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep & Long Island floated

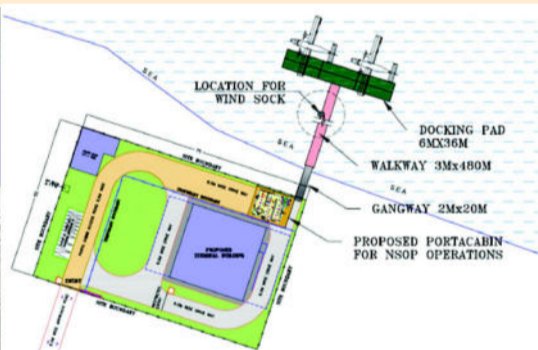
Port Blair, July 22

The Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India in association with A & N Administration and Airports Authority of India (AAI) is developing Water Aerodromes at Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep and Long Island for introducing Seaplane Services under the Central Government's flagship programme Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN.

UDAN, short for 'Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik' is a Regional Airport Development and Regional Air Connectivity Scheme of the Government of India to reach out to the remote areas. With the objective of

letting the common citizen of the country fly, the scheme aims at making air travel affordable and wide spread to boost inclusive economic development, job growth and air transport infrastructure development of all regions. Seaplane operations from coastal/river/canal as well as terrestrial

water bodies will extend connectivity to those areas where no land based airport is available.

Accordingly, to materialize this project, a Consultant

has been engaged for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR), obtaining MoEF clearance and conduct of necessary technical surveys like Bathymetry and

Obstruction Limitation surface surveys to develop Water Aerodromes at Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep and Long Island. After successful completion

of the necessary technical surveys, layout plan/ designs were finalized for the Water Aerodrome infrastructures.

The construction work of infrastructure for the Water Aerodrome at Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep and Long Island will be executed by ALHW at an estimated project cost of Rs. 52.66 Crores. The Water Aerodrome will have sheltered water runway area for the safe landing, takeoff and movement of

production of medical-technology, tele-medicine and diagnostics, he said that now is the best time to expand investment in Indian healthcare sector.

Prime Minister listed several other sectors which offer tremendous opportunities to invest, viz. the energy sector; infrastructure creation including building houses, roads, highways and ports; civil aviation, wherein top private Indian airlines plan to include over a thousand new aircrafts over the coming decade, thus opening up opportunity for any investor who chooses to set up manufacturing facilities in India, and also through setting up of Maintenance Repair and Operations Facilities. He mentioned that India is raising the FDI cap for investment in defence sector to 74%, two defence corridors have been established to encourage production of defense equipment and platforms, and added that special incentives are offered for private and foreign investors. He also mentioned about the path-breaking reforms being undertaken in the space sector.

Inviting investment in finance and insurance, Prime Minister said that India has raised the FDI cap for investment in insurance to 49% and 100% FDI is permitted for investment in insurance intermediaries. He noted that there are large untapped opportunities for increasing insurance cover in health, agriculture, business and life insurance.

**Rising investments in India**

Prime Minister talked about India's rise in Ease of Doing Business rankings of the World Bank. He underlined that each year, India is reaching record highs in FDI, adding that FDI inflows in India in 2019-20 were 74 billion dollars, which is an increase of 20% over the previous year. He highlighted that even during the pandemic, India has attracted foreign investment of more than 20 billion dollars between April and July this year.

**Best time to invest in India**

Prime Minister said that India has what is needed to power the global economic recovery. He noted that India's rise means a rise in trade opportunities with a nation that can be trusted, a rise in global integration with increasing openness, a rise in competitiveness with access to a market which offers scale, and a rise in returns on investment with the availability of skilled human resources. Calling USA and India as natural partners, he said, this partnership can play an important role in helping the world bounce back faster after the pandemic. Reaching out to the American investors, he said that there has never been a better time to invest in India.

**EPFO payroll data: enrolment rates increase; 3.18 lakh net new subscribers registered New establishments registered with EPFO grow by around 72%**

New Delhi, July 22 (PIB)

The provisional payroll data published by EPFO on 20th July, 2020 reveals that net new enrolments has started to make headway for most industry classifications in May, 2020. The subscriber base has grown by 3.18 lakh new net members during May 2020, registered a whopping 218% month on month growth. Despite the lockdown, around 1 lakh net new subscribers were added to social security schemes of EPFO in April, 2020. The data published comprises of all the new members who have joined during the month and whose contribution is received.

The subscriber base growth is on account of increased number of new subscribers, lower exits and higher rejoining



by exited members. The new subscriber joining over April, 2020, with 66 % from 1.67 lakh in April to 2.79 lakh in May, 2020. In addition, the exits from EPFO subscriber base declined by nearly 20% from 2.97 lakh in April to 2.36 lakh in May, 2020.

The number of members who exited and then rejoining, indicates switching of jobs by subscribers within the establishments covered by EPFO. This has also increased by approximately 19% for the month of May, 2020 over April, 2020, with more subscribers choosing to retain membership by transferring funds rather than opting for final settlement. New establishments registered with EPFO also witnessed a growth of around 72% with 8367 new establishments registering in May compared to 4853 establishments in April, 2020.
