Port Blair, Aug 22 The Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) is an attempt to make the rural areas socially, economically and physically sustainable regions. The Mission strives to strengthen rural areas by providing economic, social and infrastructure amenities. In this regard, the Detailed Project

Report (DPR Template) consisting of 109 Projects amounting to Rs. 106.56 Cr. (74 Projects under Convergence Component amounting to Rs 76.56 Cr. and 35 Projects under Critical Gap Fund (CGF) amounting to Rs 30.00 Cr. has been prepared and approved by the State Level

Empowered Committee (SLEC) chaired by the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration. Even during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Department has been able to complete the upgradation of 3 modern Gymnasiums in Chouldari, Mithakhari and Tushnabad Gram Panchayats and these are ready for use. With the continuous effort and support of other stakeholders, the Department has been able to start 2 works on ground under CGF i.e. C/o HDPE Floating Jetty and footpath beside seashore area (Veer Savarkar Park) at Chouldari and Fish Landing Centre at Guptapara. Supply order have been issued for installation of 8 Water ATMs. Further, the rest of the works/projects are in tendering/work awarding stage, which will be implemented soon, a press release from the Secretary, Rural Development said. Tackling COVID-19 pandemic: Adequate precautions taken in Nicobar District

All passengers arriving by ship/helicopter quarantined for 14 days

COVID Care Centers identified in all 3 Sub-Divisions

Port Blair, Aug 22 The Nicobar District has taken adequate precautions in order to tackle the COVID-19 pandemic. From June 15th, all passengers arriving by ship and helicopter were quarantined in their respective homes for 14 days. Further, passive and active surveillance (door to door) was initiated in order to find those persons having Influenza-like Illness (ILI) or Severe Acute Respiratory Illness (SARI) symptoms and such persons were placed under home quarantine. Such persons are also

given a kit containing paracetamol, azithromycin, Vitamin-C and ayurvedic medicine and regular review is done for such cases. COVID Care Centres have been identified in all three sub-divisions. A total of 195 beds have been identified for COVID-19 patients, if needed. Further, regular stock-appraisal of PPE kits, oxygen cylinders, masks, sanitizers etc. is being conducted. Teams had been formed and training imparted to teams for containment operations, contact tracing, monitoring and welfare of those placed under quarantine etc. long before the first case was found in the District. Apart from the above, from 30th July onwards, all passenger ships and regular helicopter services have been suspended in order to prevent spread of the virus in Nicobar District. From 2nd August, all shops except those providing essential goods/ services were directed to be closed. A weekend lockdown was also imposed in order to contain the spread. Further, from 11th

Public advised to adhere to Do's & Don'ts for fire safety

Port Blair, Aug 22 M o h a n p u r a . and the efforts were highly appreciated by the general public and the business enterprise. Due to the earnest efforts of A&N Police Fire Service personnel, the fire was put out completely within half an hour of continuous fire fighting operation and saved the entire cluster of business hub having many shops, a press release from SP (Fire) said here today.

The A&N Police Fire Service works tirelessly to promptly respond to any fire emergency 24 x 7, as it is evident from the recent past fire incidents. Yet again, the Fire Service proved good workmanship in saving property worth crores of rupees by averting a major fire mishap in the bazaar of the city. In the intervening night of Aug 21/22 at about 0002 hours, a fire call was received at Fire Control Room stating that fire broke out in a shop viz. Unique Mobile Servicing Center located in the shopping complex of

Immediately, Water Tenders from Fire Station Aberdeen, Marine and Chatham were pressed into action. On reaching the spot, it was noticed that dense smoke was emanating from the said shop. The shop was broken open as it was locked. Exhaust blower and Breathing Apparatus Sets were utilized to draw the smoke out. Short circuit in the main switch board was the cause of fire. Property worth crores of rupees was saved by Fire Service personnel who exhibited high sense of professionalism

Do's

- > Undertake wiring work through qualified/certified/registered firm or technical hands.
- > Use ISI certified appliances
- > Use good quality fuses of correct rating, Miniature Circuit Breaker (MCB) and Earth Leakage Circuit Breakers (ELCB).
- > Use one socket for one appliance
- > Switch off the electrical supply of the fire affected area immediately to minimize the damage.
- > Fuses and switches should be mounted on metallic cubicles for greater fire safety.
- > Replace broken plugs and switches
- > Keep the electrical wiring away from hot and wet surfaces.
- > Switch off appliance after use and remove the Plug from the socket.
- > Switch off the main switch while leaving home for a long duration.

Don'ts

- > Do not use sub standard fixtures, appliance
- > Never have temporary or naked joint or wiring
- > Do not lay wires under carpets, mats or doorways. They get crushed, resulting in electrical short circuit.
- > Do not allow appliance's cords to dangle
- > Do not place bare wire ends in a socket
- > Do not keep appliance running when going out of house/office etc.

The Open API Service of Aarogya Setu, can be availed by organizations and business entities, who are registered in India with more than 50 employees, and they can use the Open API Service to query the Aarogya Setu Application in real-time and get the health status of their employees or any other Aarogya Setu user, who have provided their consent for sharing their health status with the organization. The Open API shall only provide the Aarogya Setu status and name of the Aarogya Setu User (with User's consent). No other personal data shall be provided through the API.

permission of respective Assistant Commissioners, in order to ensure that they do not spread the infection. All the National Directives are being implemented strictly. Penalties have been specified by the District Administration for violations of National Directive and other directives issued. Considering the vulnerability of Shompen, which is a Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG), special instructions have been issued, to ensure their safety including specification of protocol for AAJVS staff, direction to general public not to interact with Shompen etc. ANIIDCO shop has been shut down in order to prevent inebriation in the public. All the above direction are being strictly enforced by Police and Revenue Departments and violators are promptly being penalized.

Further, Containment Zones have been setup as and when cases emerge, in order to prevent further spread of infection. Doctors have also been trained for management of waste from COVID- 19 positive patients. Regular phone calls are made to those placed under quarantine and in containment zones in order to assess their requirement of essentials and to address their grievances.

Details of essential service providers are pasted on the residences of all those placed under quarantine for their convenience.

As on date, any person intending to visit Nicobar District has to compulsorily undergo COVID-19 test before he/ she is allowed to visit the District, a press release from Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District said.

Replying to media queries today during a video press conference, Shri Paswan informed that the Department of Legal Metrology, Guntur in AP has registered a complaint against the pharmaceutical distributor of medicine 'Seder OM'. Shri Paswan informed that as per the complaint received, the name of the Manufacturer, Helpline number and date of expiry are not visible. It further alleged that the size of the numerals and letters of the declaration is less than 1 mm and not easily legible on the above medicine packages. He said that raids were conducted on the premises of the distributor and seller under section 15 of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and packets of the above medicine have been seized.

Coronavirus: Indian greeting 'Namaste' goes global

In an effort to stop the spread of the coronavirus, more people, including global leaders, are using the Indian greeting of Namaste. Indian Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has promoted the 'Namaste', saying that the world is increasingly adopting the no-contact way of greeting.

People around the world are worried that shaking hands, hugging and kissing on the cheek might help spread the virus. In recent days, images of US President, Mr. Donald Trump and Prince Charles opting to use the Indian greeting over a handshake have gone viral.

Namaste has gone viral yet again, with French President, Mr. Emmanuel Macron having greeted German Chancellor, Ms. Angela Merkel with the Indian greeting to avoid shaking hands, which is the usual protocol. A growing number of influential people are adopting this method of exchanging pleasantries amidst the COVID-19 crisis that has gripped the world. Recipe for Kimami Sewaiyan



Ingredients:

- *1 cup semiya
- *1 cup khoya
- *1 cup sugar
- *1 cup milk
- *1-1/2 cup water
- *ghee (as needed)
- *1 tsp cardamom powder
- *1 cup phool makhana (lotus seeds), chopped
- *1/4 cup almonds (slivered, for garnishing)
- *1 tbsp whole cashews ((slivered, for garnishing)
- *1 tbsp raisins (for garnish)
- *2 tbsp dry coconut (kopra)

Method:

- * To begin making Kimami Sewai Recipe, heat a pan on a slow flame and roast dry sewai till it turns dark brown. Keep it aside. Make sure to avoid over-roasting the delicate sewai.
- * In the same pan, heat ghee and fry the fox nuts/makhana till it gets crunchy. It will take 5 to 6 minutes on low medium heat.
- * After 5 to 6 minutes, add dry fruits and saute it for about 2 minutes. Lastly, add coconut as it burns quickly, be very careful. Fry altogether and keep aside.
- * In a deep pan, add sugar, khoya, milk, water and mix it well. Put it on the flame and keep stirring till the first boil. Slow down the flame to cook the sugar syrup till it gets thicker and you feel heavy while stirring.
- * Add 1/2 cup water or milk to the thick syrup and give another boil.
- * Add roasted sewai, dry fruits, makhana, coconut mixture and cook on a slow flame for about 4-5 minutes and switch off.
- * Sprinkle green cardamom powder and mix well. Cover the lid and leave for 10 minutes. Switch off the heat, give it a mix and garnish with almonds, cashews and raisins. ❖
