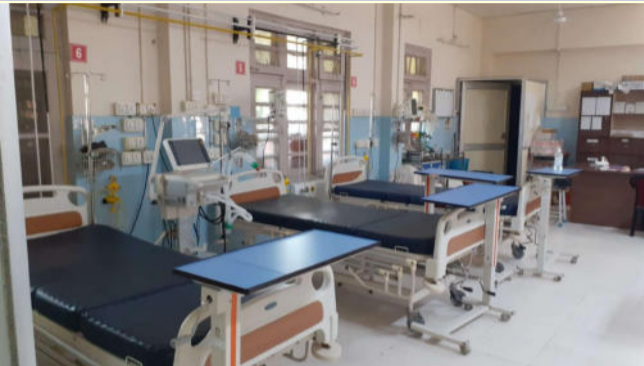

Administration striving to provide improved healthcare service Another Wing of GB Pant Hospital dedicated for COVID-19 cases; to cater to other medical requirements also

Three ambulances fitted with oxygen support stationed to provide round the clock service

Port Blair, Aug 23
 In its untiring efforts in the fight against the pandemic COVID-19, the Department of Health Services of Andaman & Nicobar Administration has initiated several steps to strive to provide improved health care services. Another Wing of GB Pant Hospital, Port Blair has now been dedicated for the care of COVID-19 cases. With 136 more beds consisting of a 16-bedded ICU with piped oxygen support and 60 beds earmarked for suspect case management, the Wing shall also cater to any other medical requirements for surgical procedures to such patients, in case of an emergency. This newly dedicated block has been barricaded & separated from the non-COVID service area. Other services such as surgical & gynaecological procedures shall continue to be provided at the hospital.



In addition to this, three ambulances fitted with oxygen support are stationed round the clock to cater to municipal areas of Port Blair and 4 vehicles especially retrofitted with oxygen support have been additionally made available at PHC Wimberlygunj, PHC Ferrargunj, CHC Bambooflat & Health and Wellness Centre, Rangachang. In order to support non-COVID essential services, the tele-consultation facilities of the GBPH have been extended with 25 doctors actively on the panel following up routine consultation for the patients. The medicines prescribed are delivered to the doorstep of patients or the nearest health centre for outlying areas of South Andaman. In addition, calls at the **Helpline 102** are connected to doctors for tele-

consultation and immediate dispatch of medicines is made for doorstep delivery in case of influenza like symptoms. Such persons are monitored regularly by teams for their condition and testing.

The Department of Bio-Chemistry, ANIIMS will also undertake this week, a seroprevalence study for the frontline and healthcare workers with ELISA based test kits to monitor the trend and prevalence of the virus.

The A&N Administration appeals to all citizens to strictly follow prescribed protocols of social distancing, wear face masks all the time when stepping out of homes and maintain personal hygiene like washing of hands regularly, covering face and mouth while sneezing or coughing, a press release from Health Department said.

Country will have vaccine against Coronavirus by end of this year: Health Minister



New Delhi, Aug 23
 The Union Health Minister, Dr Harsh Vardhan yesterday expressed that if everything goes well, India would get its first COVID-19 vaccine by the end of 2020. Dr Harsh Vardhan was addressing the media after inaugurating a 10-Bedded Hospital at NDRF 8th Battalion Centre in Ghaziabad and said, "Everyone across the world is trying to develop a COVID-19 vaccine. Over 26 vaccine candidates around the world have reached the clinical trial phases. In India, the work is currently progressing on half a dozen candidates, of which, three vaccine candidates are in first, second and third phases." Head of National Task Force on COVID-19, Dr VK Paul said, the vaccine candidate entering the third phase has yielded encouraging results in the initial phases of its trial. (Source: india.gov.in)

 The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, GoI has launched a scheme to provide free coaching to OBC students for various courses viz. Group A & B examination conducted by UPSC, State Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission and Railway Recruitment Board; Grade examination conducted by Banks, Insurance Companies and Public Undertaking; Entrance examination for Engineering, Medical, CLAT, professional courses like Management (e.g CAT) and any other such disciplines as Ministry may decide from time to time and eligibility tests/Examination like GMAT, SAT, TOFEL and GRE. The Scheme will be implemented through reputed coaching institutions/centres. The eligibility criteria for applying for empanelment of coaching institute are the Institute should be registered body or run by an organization examination for

Several steps taken to prevent spread of COVID-19 in N&M Andaman District

All inbound passengers & contacts of COVID-19 confirmed cases put under quarantine
 68 surveillance teams constituted Tehsil wise to closely monitor & supervise those under quarantine
 Number of isolation beds increased from 23 to 123

Port Blair, Aug 23
 The District Administration North and Middle Andaman has taken a lot of steps to prevent spread of COVID-19 in the district. All inbound passengers and the contacts of COVID-19 confirmed cases are being put under quarantine. Till date, a total of 2819 persons and 1105 Households have been quarantined. All the Ship Crew/passengers, drivers & helpers of cargo vehicle/emergency movement cases on ATR moving towards N&MA are being allowed to move only after being tested negative. Since 23/07/2020, testing has also been started locally as per the ICMR protocols through a TruNat machine installed in the District Hospital, Mayabunder. In total 68 surveillance teams consisting of Para-medical staff, Teachers, Forest and

RD Department have been constituted tehsil wise to closely monitor & supervise those under quarantine. Local elected representatives and volunteers are engaged in providing essential commodities to those under quarantine. Strict enforcement of COVID-19 prevention guidelines is being ensured by vigilance and levying of fines. Survey for ILI/SARI cases are being conducted on daily basis through door to door visits by ASHAs & ANMs. Medical consultations and medicines are being provided wherever required. The District Administration has also increased the total No. of isolation beds from 23 to 123, which are spread out across all major islands of the district. For preventing spread of infections within the hospital premises the District

Administration has started Fever Clinics. These are separate section in the OPDs of various CHCs & PHCs with isolated entrance and exits for patients with suspect symptoms of COVID to avoid intermingling with other patients and are being treated without any delay. Further, to protect the medical staff on the frontlines, those deputed in the fever OPD are provided with adequate protective gears. Supporting its Corona Warriors, the District Administration has made arrangements for alternate stay of medical staff on COVID duty who wish to not go back to their homes to protect their families. Moreover, to augment manpower, vacancies of medical staff under NHM have been promptly filled up. Besides, the private medical practitioners

 During the situation of pandemic of COVID-19 when the whole country has been locked down to control the spread of disease, many poor households of rural areas were badly affected due to shutdown of all works. Therefore, the Govt. of India decided to re-initiate the implementation of MGNREGA Scheme w.e.f. 20.04.2020 to provide wage employment to

Plans afoot to modernize existing helicopter fleet in Isles

4 more helicopters to be introduced to augment Inter-Island Air Transport capacity

Port Blair, Aug, 23
 In order to provide better connectivity in Inter-Island sector, the Civil Aviation Department under A&N Administration plans to modernize the existing helicopter fleet by inducting new helicopters. As part of this initiative, a proposal has been taken up by the Civil Aviation Department with the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), New Delhi for



modernization of existing fleet of 4 Dauphin Helicopters of Pawan Hans with more advanced and larger capacity helicopters to augment the Inter-

Island Air Transport capacity. To materialize the modernization plan, a Standing Finance Committee (SFC) proposal has already been submitted to MHA for Wet Lease of 2 numbers (18 seat capacity) and 2 numbers (10 seat capacity) helicopters at an estimated annual expenditure of Rs. 218 crores. The induction of 4 new increased passenger capacity helicopters will further strengthen the Inter-Island Air Transport capacity and it will benefit the islanders and the visitors to reach their respective destinations in shortest time.



present Rs.267/- per day is being paid in South Andaman and N&M Andaman District; and Rs. 282/- per day in Nicobar District.


The disbursement of wages is done on weekly basis through e-FMS and through Banks.

During the lock down period re-starting of implementation of MGNREGA has brought relief to many rural poor households as well as unemployed rural youth of these Islands. Since 20.04.2020, 5154 households have demanded and were provided employment leading to generation of 87666 Mandays in last 90 days which is 102% of the approved target till July, 2020. Nearly 400 works, such as construction of farm ponds, compost pits, cattle & poultry sheds, development of beaches & c/o eco-huts, horticulture plantation, katcha drains, katcha rural roads, c/o of gabion structures, C/o PMAY-G houses, etc have been taken up and out of it, 125 works have completed.


As per the Convergence Guidelines of MoRD, GOI, execution of works for development of livelihood opportunities of DAY-NRLM, SHG ladies are also being done during the current year. Works related to afforestation and development of forest nurseries in convergence with Forest Department as well as development of nutri-gardens for Anganwadi Centres are also being identified for execution under MGNREGA. For construction of Community Sanitary Complexes in rural areas, wage employment of 230 mandays to MGNREGA beneficiaries is also being ensured as per new joint guidelines of MoDW&S & MoRD, GOI.

During the current year, Project 'Unnati' is also being implemented under MGNREGA wherein training for skill development shall be provided with the support of DDU-GKY, RSETI & KVKs to the interested MGNREGA beneficiaries who have completed 100 days employment in the previous year.

Recommendations of AYUSH for positive cases of COVID-19:

- Food should be freshly cooked, warm, easily digestible, and in suitable quantity as per individual needs. Spices like Haldi (Turmeric), Jeera (Cumin), Dhaniya (coriander), Lahsun (Garlic), Adrak (Ginger), Pippali (Pepper) are recommended in cooking. Warm soups of lentils /pulses / meat can be taken as per preference. Avoid overeating.
 - Use warm water for drinking (in optimal quantity at suitable intervals).
 - Avoid foods/drinks like curd, banana, cold drinks, ice-cream, refrigerated items; and cold air which may trigger respiratory symptoms.
 - AYUSH Kaadha: Drink 150 ml of Herbal Tea /decoction [made by boiling Tulsi (basil), Dalchini (Cinnamon), Kalimirch, Shunthi (Ginger), Munakka (Raisin) in water] once or twice a day. Jaggery and fresh lemon juice may be added for taste.
 - PratimaarshyaNasya: Apply sesame oil /Coconut oil in both nostrils (Twice a day).
 - Oil pooling (Gandusha): Gargle with warm water twice a day (a tea-spoon full of Sesame oil, half tea spoon Haldi and pinch of common salt may be added to water).
 - Steam Inhalation: Thrice a day (Mint leaves or pinch of Ajwain (Carum seeds) may be added to the water in case of congestion)
 - Half tea spoon of Clove powder or Licorice powder may be used once or twice a day along with honey for dry cough /sore throat.
 - Have adequate sleep, preferably during night hours; avoid day sleep to the extent possible.
 - Use warm water for bathing; and dry your hair thoroughly after head-bath.
 - Stay calm and stress-free with daily practice of Yogasana, Pranayama, Meditation.
 - Most important, think positive. You will overcome this problem.
 - Consult concerned doctors at given numbers if symptoms persist/health condition worsens.

Simple Ayurvedic Procedures

- Nasal application - Apply sesame oil / coconut oil or Ghee in both the nostrils (Pratimarsh Nasya) in morning and evening.**
- Oil pulling therapy - Take 1 table spoon sesame or coconut oil in mouth. Do not drink, Swish in the mouth for 2 to 3 minutes and spit it off followed by warm water rinse. This can be done once or twice a day.**

During dry cough / sore throat

- Steam inhalation with fresh Pudina (Mint) leaves or Ajwain (Caraway seeds) can be practiced once in a day.**
- Lavang (Clove) powder mixed with natural sugar / honey can be taken 2-3 times a day in case of cough or throat irritation.**
- These measures generally treat normal dry cough and sore throat. However, it is best to consult doctors if these symptoms persist.**

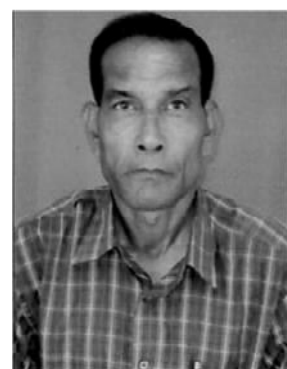
