Lt. Governor visits Car Nicobar & Nancowry Group of Islands

Directs Departments for timely completion of works for betterment of people of far flung Isles



Port Blair, Mar 23
The Lt. Governor, A & N Islands, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi, accompanied by the First Lady of the Islands, Smt. Prem Mukhi visited Car Nicobar and Nancowry group of Islands on March 22 & 23, 2017 and took stock of various developmental works. The Deputy Commissioner, Nicobars, Chief Engineer, APWD, Director of Shipping Services & SE, Electricity Department accompanied the Lt Governor during his visit to different Islands in Nicobars.

On arrival, the Lt. Governor and his entourage was received by the Deputy Commissioner, Nicobars, Smti. Neha Bansal, Superintendent of Police, Nicobar District, Shri. Deepak Yadav, Members of Tribal Council, Car Nicobar and other Head of Offices. A guard of honour was presented to the Lt Governor at APWD Guest House.

Thereafter, the Lt Governor proceeded to the BJR Hospital, Car Nicobar to see and enquire about the health condition of the

ailing Chairman Tribal Council, Shri. Aberdeen Blair. The Lt. Governor wished for his early recovery. He also visited the Hospital where the members of Tribal Council demanded for extending the services of Gynecologist and Anesthetist. The Lt. Governor assured to look into the matter.

The Lt. Governor also visited Tsunami Memorial and paid homage to the departed souls who lost their lives in the earthquake followed by Tsunami in December 2004. He also visited the traditional round hut at Chukchuka village where he witnessed the traditional dance performance of the tribal folk.

After concluding visit at Car Nicobar, the Lt. Governor proceeded to Chowra Island where he interacted with the members of the Tribal Council of Chowra Island. During the interaction, they raised the issue of the non-availability of BSNL connectivity. The Lt. Governor assured that he will personally pursue the

matter with BSNL. The Tribal leaders also demanded for maximum supply of power during school hours. The Lt. Governor gave on the spot direction to the SE, Electricity to maintain power supply from 9 am to 2.30 pm and from 5 pm to 4 am, which was applauded by the tribal members. The Tribal leaders also demanded boat service, exclusively for Nancowry group of Islands.

Thereafter, the Lt. Governor and his team proceeded to Teresa Island, where he was accorded a warm welcome by the members of Tribal Council and other local officers. Further, during the interaction with the Tribal Council members and residents, it was requested to improve the seaways connectivity within the Sub-Division which has been suspended due to non-availability of dedicated vessel for Nancowry Sub-Division. The Director (SS) assured to position a 100 Pax vessel MV Strait Island exclusively for Nancowry Sub-Division by March 31,

2017 for maintaining regular uninterrupted connectivity between the far flung islands including Chowra and Teresa. The members of Tribal Council asserted upon posting of Lady Medical Officer, Lab. Technician and required supporting/technical staff with facilities of X-ray at PHC Teresa which has been assured to be looked into.

After completion of visit at Teresa, the Lt Governor and team proceeded to Kamorta where he was accorded a warm welcome by the CTC, Nancowrie & CTC, Kamorta and other Heads of Office followed by Guard of Honour at APWD Guest House, Kamorta. During the meeting at EOC Conference Hall, wherein all the members of Tribal Council and Heads of Office of the respective Departments under Nancowrie, Sub-Division were present many issues were raised by the members of Tribal Council. After giving a patient hearing, the Lt Governor gave directions to respective Departments to address the issues

expeditiously. He stated that the issue of poor BSNL network has been noticed in all the Islands, which is a genuine issue, and assured that he will personally take up the issue with the CGM, BSNL to enhance the bandwidth for the Island. He further informed that he is actively pursuing the matter with GOI to have an IT Hub at Port Blair which will simultaneously provide employment opportunities to the youths. He further informed that the 07 years old plan for laying undersea cable from Chennai to Port Blair has been consented over by the Parliament as a special case, only after the interference of our Hon'ble Prime Minister and the whole exercise will be completed by 31/12/2018. Before the IT Hub is established, various training programmes in IT field will be provided and the youth of Nicobar group of Islands can also avail this opportunity, he said.

ISSF World Cup: Ankur Mittal wins double trap gold in Mexico



Acapulco (Mexico), Mar 23
Extending his good form, Ankur Mittal clinched the gold medal at the ISSF Shotgun World Cup in the double trap event, pipping his Australian rival James Willet in the final in a world record equalling effort.

Mittal had settled for a silver at the recent International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) World Cup in New Delhi, where Willet had won the gold. Mittal ended with 75 points out of possible 80 in the six-man final to win India's first medal in the competition while Willet managed 73. Ankur shot strong throughout the day, ending second in qualification with a score of 138 out of a possible 150. He also got the better off China's Ying Qi 6-5 in a shoot-off to decide second and third spots after both had finished their qualifying rounds on the same score. In the ensuing 80-targets final

round, Ankur missed a total of five targets, including just two in his last 40 to equal the World Record and finish on top with a score of 75. His nemesis New Delhi, Willet missed seven targets while the Chinese Ying won bronze, shooting a score of 52, before being eliminated after 60 targets. Medal events now remain in the Men's and Women's Skeet shooting disciplines, scheduled to be held over the weekend. Rashmee Rathore will be India's sole competitor in the Women's Skeet while Angad Vir Singh Bajwa, Man Singh and Amrinder Cheema will carry India's hopes in the Men's Skeet.

Football greets Diego Maradona, Pablo Aimar to visit India ahead of U-17 World Cup

New Delhi, mar 23
Football legends will be visiting India for promotional purposes in the lead-up to the U-17 World Cup, much like Diego Maradona and Pablo Aimar did for FIFA's U-20 tournament draw in Korea recently. Argentine great Maradona and Aimar participated in the draw for the FIFA U-20 World Cup in Korea on March 15. "I just came following the draw in Korea for the U-20 World Cup, and we had Maradona and Aimar with us during the draw. We are thinking of some names, who we cannot say yet

as we still have time. We are thinking of bringing some of the top footballers in the history of the tournament not only for the draw but also for other activities leading up to the tournament," FIFA's head of events Jaime Yarzsa said today. Yarzsa is heading an eight-member delegation to inspect the six venues across the country. Today, they inspected the capital's Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium. "... For example the trophy tour experience, some activities with the 'Mission XI Million'. So, there will be four to five times

when we will have some of the top former players of the world visiting India," he said after the inspection. Maradona, one of the greatest players in football history, won the U-20 World Cup in 1979 before winning the FIFA World Cup seven years later at Mexico 1986 and reaching another final four years later at Italy 1990. Aimar won the U-17 World Cup in 1997. The upcoming edition of the mega-event is scheduled to be held in India from October 6 to 28.

Conservation of Biodiversity and various regulations were formulated such as wildlife trade and commerce etc. India has robust regulating frameworks, such as the Forest Conservation Act, National Biodiversity Act etc. yet it is still found that threats on the Indian biodiversity is continuing, which need to be checked, he said, underscoring the need for mainstreaming the coastal and marine biodiversity for appropriate conservation. Stating that there are various challenges in conservation, the Secretary said, there is need to find out a balanced plan of action to carry out the developmental works as also to conserve the biodiversity, in which the roles of institutions like ZSI, BSI etc are vital. Such institutes need to integrate the knowledge base, which they have collected as a result of survey works, disseminate them to the people and convey them to policy makers so that a balanced policy can be formulated, he said urging the scholars to leap forward and take up international leadership in augmenting knowledge and information about the rich biodiversity to attract foreign scholars interested in biodiversity research works.

Shri Jha expressed hope that the seminar will come out with a positive results which will help in formulating regulation for mainstreaming coastal and marine biodiversity for future conservation.

The chief guest and other dignitaries released five books, which are series of publication by ZSI. These included Glimpses of Marine Biodiversity of India, Gorgonians of Indian Seas, Reef associated common crustaceans of A & N Islands, Lakshadweep and Gulf of Mannar, Reef associated Ascidians of A & N Islands and Sponges of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Four pamphlets and ten charts were also released on the occasion.

Earlier, the chief guest and the Chief Secretary unveiled a plaque to mark the foundation laying ceremony for a National Repository Building for Islands Faunal Diversity in the premises of the ZSI Port Blair.

In his presidential address, the Chief Secretary, Shri Anindo Majumdar said that these Islands are biodiversity hotspots and need to be preserved in a scientific manner. The eco-system of these Islands is fragile and unique in nature as there are lots of endemic species here, of which many are endangered. It is a great challenge to protect the biodiversity and to carry out developmental works, which are required by the people. Various characteristics like growing population, growing economical needs, the need for jobs for livelihood, agriculture, fisheries also have impacts on the natural resources. He also underlined the need to carry out tourism activities while maintaining the Isles' biodiversity.

The Chief Secretary also stressed the need to educate the people about the wealth that are available in the Islands and the need to conserve them. He said that scientific knowledge on biodiversity and protection measures should be shared with the people, especially students through institutions such as ZSI so that they can become part of the conservation process. He also mentioned about the conservation methods the vulnerable tribal groups adopted in the Islands, which helps large area of biodiversity is being preserved.

Dr. Alok Saxena, PCCF & Principal Secretary Deptt of Environment & Forests, A & N Admn., Dr. B Meenakumari, Chairperson NBC, Dr. Anil Sant, Jt. Secretary, MoEF&CC and Dr. Kailash Chandra, Director ZSI also highlighted the significance of the workshop and the need for mainstreaming coastal and marine biodiversity.

Earlier, Dr. C Raghunathan, Officer in-charge, ZSI Port Blair welcomed the gathering and the inaugural function concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Madhumita Biswas, Director RE Division MoEF&CC.
