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Vision of New India can only be realized through combined efforts of all states: PM Modi



New Delhi, Apr 23
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said the vision of New India can only be realised through the combined effort and cooperation of all States and Chief Ministers. In his opening remarks at the third meeting of the Governing Council of NITI Aayog in New Delhi, the Prime Minister said Team India has once again assembled today to discuss and reflect on ways to prepare India for changing global trends. He said the meeting is an opportunity to exchange views on policies and implementation. Talking about the passage of Goods and Services Tax, the Prime Minister said the consensus on it will go

down in history as a great illustration of cooperative federalism. He gave credit to all Chief Ministers for coming on one platform for this cause, keeping aside ideological and political differences. Shri Modi said the GST reflects the spirit of "one nation, one aspiration, one determination". He also called for carrying forward the debate and discussion on simultaneous elections. During the meeting, the Prime Minister said it is the collective responsibility of this gathering to envision the India of 2022-the 75th anniversary of independence-and see how the country can swiftly move forward to achieve these goals.

He urged States to speed up capital expenditure and infrastructure creation. He said the NITI Aayog is working on a 15 year long term vision, 7 year medium term strategy, and 3 year action agenda. He said this effort needs support of States, and will eventually reflect in benefits to States. Recalling the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi, on the occasion of the

centenary of the Champaran Satyagraha, the Prime Minister said NITI Aayog has been taking steps to transform India, with fresh vigour. He said the government, private sector and civil society, all need to work in sync. He noted that NITI Aayog is a collaborative federal body whose strength is in its ideas, rather than in administrative or financial

control. He pointed out that the Chief Ministers did not have to come to the Aayog for approval of budgets or plans. The Prime Minister noted that sub-groups of State Chief Ministers had given vital inputs on subjects such as Centrally Sponsored Schemes, Swachh Bharat, Skill Development and Digital payments. Govt extends date for filing tax declarations under PMGKY till May 10

New Delhi, Apr 23
The government has extended the date of declarations about tax payment and deposits under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana (PMGKY) till 10th of next month. This has come within days of extending the date for making deposits as part of the tax amnesty scheme till 30th of this month. An official release said, the declarations can be filed in cases where tax, surcharge and penalty under PMGKY has been

paid on or before the 31st March and deposit under the Deposit Scheme has been made on or before 30th of this month. The PMGKY, which opened on 17th of December last year provided the last chance to holders of undisclosed income to come clean by paying tax and penalty. The scheme closed on 31st of last month. It provided for payment of 49.9 per cent tax, surcharge and penalty and also a mandatory deposit of 25 per cent of

the black money was to be made in the zero-interest bearing account for four years.

CBSE warns schools affiliated to it against selling of books, uniforms

New Delhi, Apr 23
Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has warned schools affiliated to it against selling of books and uniforms. In its advisory, it has told the schools that educational institutions are not commercial establishments and sale of books, uniforms and stationery by them is a violation of norms. It came following complaints from parents that schools are indulging in commercial activities by way of selling books and uniforms within the school premises or through selected vendors. The board has taken a serious view of the complaints and directed the schools to desist from the unhealthy practice of coercing parents to buy text books, note books, stationery, uniforms, shoes and school bags. The CBSE norms mandate that schools are run as community service and not as a business establishment. The CBSE has also reiterated its directive to schools to stick to books published by the NCERT. Following complaints about shortage of NCERT books, the CBSE had asked schools to raise online indent for NCERT textbooks.

showcasing dioramas of jungles, convicts clearing the jungles and photos of Bathu community. The second floor is dedicated towards pre-independence struggle, freedom struggle movement of the country and history of the Islands. The fourth floor is dedicated towards preservation of some rare documents pertaining to the Islands. Screening of documentary films and archival films for the visitors are also done here.

Shri Lal said, some of the photographs were obtained from Austrian Museum while some are his personal collection and some have been contributed by researchers from different parts of the country.

The creator of 'Kalapani Museum' said, his sole aim of starting the museum was to connect people with the history of the country as well as the Islands. "People are the history and they must not disassociate themselves with history and we must never forget the struggle of our freedom fighters because of whose sacrifice, we are now enjoying the serene, unpolluted environment of the Islands", he said.

Giving details about the road ahead, Shri Lal said further efforts will be mounted to educate the people about the history of human scape and cultures of these Islands. Plans are also on the card to involve the locals, and make them a part of this museum. He further stated that that membership drives will be carried out and special packages will be provided for institutional membership, family membership as well as individual membership, so that people will be encouraged to visit the place and learn something valuable.
