The Central Board of Secondary Education, CBSE, will conduct the second phase of CBSE 10<sup>th</sup> exam - 2026 from 15<sup>th</sup> May. The exam is optional for those students who want to improve their scores.

All passed students will be allowed to improve their performance in any of the three subjects out of Science, Mathematics, Social Science and



Languages. The board had announced the Class 10<sup>th</sup> results for the first main exam on the 15<sup>th</sup> of this month. This initiative aligns with the National Education

Policy 2020, which advocates for the alleviation of exam-related stress by providing students with a second opportunity within the same academic year.

## Revenue Camp Courts underway: Applicants urged to attend camp with original documents

techniques, freshwater ornamental fish breeding and entrepreneurship, and integrated approaches for disease diagnosis, monitoring, and aquatic animal health management. The economic viability of technologies such as biofloc-based aquaculture and cost-effective feed production systems was also emphasized.

Ms. Pallavi Sarkar expressed keen interest in the technologies presented and stressed the importance of their dissemination through last-mile extension mechanisms and state-led missions.

Scientists from CIARI, including Dr Kirubasankar, Shri Karunakaran, Dr. Praveen Raj, Shri Chittaranjan Raul, and Dr. Jess Maria Wilson, shared insights on ongoing research and development activities. Contributions included experiences from scientific knowledge hubs in Nicobar tribal regions, success stories in ornamental fisheries, disease diagnostics frameworks, biofloc-based P. vannamei shrimp farming, carp seed and feed production systems, and advancements in microalgae production and fisheries digitization.

Ms Jagtap Kalyani, Director of Fisheries, emphasized collaboration with CIARI for scaling up biofloc technology and crab fattening systems.

The meeting was conducted in hybrid mode, with around 30 participants, including officials from North & Middle Andaman, South Andaman, and Nicobar districts. 
