District Administration (SA) reclaims 5,425 Sq. Mtrs. Govt. land earmarked for PMAY beneficiaries from encroacher

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 23

The District Administration, South Andaman, as part of its sustained drive to safeguard Government land and ensure its utilization for intended public purposes, has intensified action against unauthorized encroachments across the District.

The Administration has been maintaining strict vigilance through continuous monitoring and enforcement measures to prevent illegal occupation of Government land and to



restore such land for public welfare.

A major eviction drive was conducted today at Chidiyatapu village. During the operation, unauthorized encroachments in the form of fencing erected over Government Revenue land earmarked for beneficiaries under the

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) were removed.

As a result of the eviction drive, an area of approximately 5,425 square metres of Government Revenue land was successfully reclaimed and restored to Government possession. Following the removal of

the encroachments, the Revenue authorities carried out boundary demarcation by erecting boundary pillars and clearly marking the reclaimed land on the ground to safeguard it against future encroachments.

Members of the public have been advised to refrain from encroaching upon Government land or undertaking any unauthorized construction thereon. The Administration has made it clear that any such violations will invite strict (Contd. on last page)

District Administration (N&MA) removes encroachment from Govt. land at Kishorinagar in Diglipur Tehsil

Diglipur, July 23

As part of the ongoing drive to safeguard Government land from unauthorized occupation, the District Administration, North & Middle Andaman conducted an anti-encroachment drive at Kishorinagar village under Diglipur Tehsil. The encroachment was done on Government land bearing Survey No. 427 of Kishorinagar Village, where unauthorized occupation had been made in the form of an arecanut plantation and a kutchha house.

An area measuring approximately 0.7500 hectare of Government land was successfully



retrieved from unauthorized occupation and restored to the Government records.

The District

Administration has reiterated its firm commitment to protecting Government land from encroachments and

ensuring its use strictly for public purposes. It has further cautioned that any unauthorized occupation of Government land is a violation of the provisions of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Land Revenue and Land Reforms Regulation, 1966 and that suitable legal action, including eviction will be taken against encroachers in accordance with law, a press release from DC, N&MA said.

Goods vehicle owners advised to refrain from plying overloaded vehicles

periods, accumulate in living organisms through the food chain, and pose significant risks to human health, wildlife and ecosystems. The Stockholm Convention, which came into force in 2004, is a global environmental treaty aimed at protecting human health and the environment from POPs. The Convention currently lists 37 Persistent Organic Pollutants, comprising pesticides and industrial chemicals, under three Annexes covering elimination, restriction, and reduction of unintentional releases of these hazardous substances.

India ratified the Convention in 2006 and has so far ratified 19 Persistent Organic Pollutants, namely Aldrin, Chlordane, Chlordecone, Dieldrin, Endrin, Heptachlor, Hexabromobiphenyl, Hexabromocyclododecane (HBCD), Hexabromodiphenyl ether and Heptabromodiphenyl ether, Hexachlorobenzene, Hexachlorobutadiene, Mirex, Pentachlorobenzene, Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs), Tetrabromodiphenyl ether and Pentabromodiphenyl ether, Toxaphene, DDT, Polychlorinated dibenzo-p-dioxins (PCDD), and Polychlorinated dibenzofurans (PCDF).

The remaining 18 chemicals, which are not yet ratified by India, include Chlorypyrifos, Decabromodiphenyl ether (commercial mixture, c-decaBDE), Decchlorane Plus, Dicofol, Alpha Hexachlorocyclohexane (?-HCH), Beta Hexachlorocyclohexane (?-HCH), Lindane, Long-chain Perfluorocarboxylic Acids (LC-PFCAs), their salts and related compounds, Medium-chain Chlorinated Paraffins (MCCPs), Methoxychlor, Pentachlorophenol and its salts and esters, Polychlorinated Naphthalenes (PCNs), Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA), its salts and PFOA-related compounds, Perfluorohexane Sulfonic Acid (PFHxS), its salts and PFHxS-related compounds, Short-chain Chlorinated Paraffins (SCCPs), Technical Endosulfan and its related isomers, UV-328, and Perfluorooctane Sulfonic Acid (PFOS), its salts and Perfluorooctane Sulfonyl Fluoride (PFOSF).

To regulate the ratified POPs, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has notified the Regulation of Polychlorinated Biphenyls Order, 2016 and the Regulation of Persistent Organic Pollutants Rules, 2018, which prohibit the manufacture, use, import, export and trade of the notified Persistent Organic Pollutants. Compliance with these regulations is being monitored by the regulatory authorities.

Further, A&N Pollution Control Committees (ANPCC) collects information on the 18 non-ratified POPs to assess their production, import, export, domestic sales, in-house consumption and stockpiles. The information will assist the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, in evaluating the status of these chemicals and facilitating informed decision-making regarding India's future obligations under the Stockholm Convention.

Accordingly, all industrial units, manufacturers, importers, exporters, traders, research institutions, laboratories, educational institutions, government organizations and other establishments dealing with any of the chemicals listed under the Stockholm Convention are requested to furnish the requisite information in the prescribed format to the Member Secretary, Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee, Department of Science & Technology, A&N Administration, Dollygunj, Sri Vijaya Puram, South Andaman, on or before 27th July, 2026. The information may also be submitted through e-mail at dstpcc-andamans@and.nic.in.

The detailed list of the ratified and non-ratified Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs), along with the prescribed reporting formats, is available on the ANPCC website at <https://dstpcc.andamannicobar.gov.in>.

The ANPCC requests the cooperation of all concerned stakeholders in furnishing the required information within the stipulated time to facilitate effective implementation of the Stockholm Convention and strengthen the management of hazardous chemicals in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, a press release from ANPCC said.

safety measures, and sequence of activities for the Oil Spill Mock Exercise - 2026 scheduled to be conducted on July 24 from 8.30 am to 12.30 pm at Corbyn's Cove Beach.

During the deliberations, the Indian Coast Guard presented the proposed oil spill incident scenario and explained the standard operating procedures for marine pollution response, deployment of containment booms, skimmers, shoreline clean-up operations and Shoreline Cleanup Assessment Technique (SCAT). The chair directed all participating departments to ensure timely deployment of manpower, equipment and logistics at the designated locations. Each stakeholder department presented its preparedness, confirmed the availability of resources, and discussed coordination mechanisms to ensure seamless inter-agency response during the mock exercise.

The Chair emphasized the importance of effective coordination, timely communication, responder safety, environmental protection, proper documentation of observations, and strict adherence to the approved exercise timeline. All participating departments were instructed to deploy their teams, equipment, and other resources at the exercise venue well before the scheduled commencement of the exercise to ensure its smooth and successful conduct. Subsequently, all participants visited the mock exercise site at Corbyn's Cove Beach to familiarize themselves with the location and review the operational arrangements for conducting the Oil Spill Mock Exercise.

Further, the residents and visitors have been informed that the activities to be carried out at Corbyn's Cove Beach on 24.07.2026 are part of a planned Oil Spill Mock Exercise - 2026 being conducted by the A&N Administration in coordination with the Indian Coast Guard, National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), and other stakeholder departments. Rs. 4,89,500/-. Vehicles found carrying loads beyond the prescribed limits will be liable for penalties and other legal action as per the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act. As per the provisions of section 194. (1) contravention of the provisions of section 113 or section 114 or section 115 shall be liable for a penalty of Rs. 20,000/- and an additional penalty of Rs.2000/- per tonne of excess load. 194. (1A) provides for a penalty of Rs. 20,000/- for any load or any part thereof or anything that extends laterally beyond the side of the body or to the front or to the rear or in height beyond the permissible limit. Section 194(2) provides for penalty of Rs. 40,000/- for refusal by any driver to stop and submit his vehicle to weighing after being directed to do so. The cooperation of all vehicle owners, transport operators, and the general public is solicited in promoting safe, responsible, and lawful transportation. By avoiding overloading, we can collectively contribute to safer roads, protect public infrastructure, and save lives, a press release from Transport Department said.

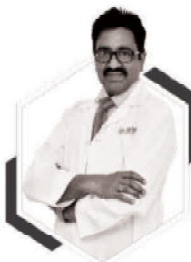
