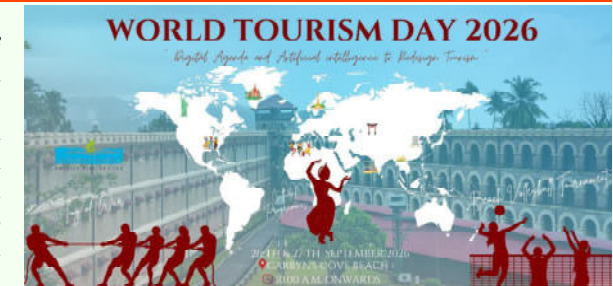

Indian men's skeet team clinch bronze after shoot-off win over Kazakhstan

Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 23
India's men's skeet team of Anantjeet Singh Naruka, Mairaj Ahmed Khan and Bhavtegh Singh Gill secured the bronze medal at the Aichi-Nagoya Asian Games 2026 on Wednesday after prevailing over Kazakhstan in a shoot-off.
The Indian trio finished level with Kazakhstan on 346 points in the men's skeet team event, but held their nerve in the shoot-off to finish third and claim the medal. Naruka also advanced to the men's skeet individual final after producing a strong performance in qualification. The medal came on a productive day for India in shooting, with the country's men's and women's skeet teams both securing bronze medals. Raiza Dhillon, Parinaaz Dhaliwal and Maheshwari Chauhan had



earlier finished third in the women's skeet team event with a combined score of 331. China won gold with 346 points, while Kazakhstan took silver. Olympic medallist Manu Bhaker also reached the women's 10m air pistol individual final but finished fifth in the medal round, while Suruchi Inder Singh and Esha Singh failed to qualify for the final.

Asian Games: Indian men's kabaddi team enters semifinals



Ichinomiya, Sept 23
The Indian men's kabaddi team successfully sealed its spot at the Asian Games 2026 semi-finals with a commanding 48-25 victory over Bangladesh at the Tokai Citizen Gymnasium in Aichi on Wednesday. In their third Group A contest, India, the reigning Asian Games kabaddi champions, controlled the game from the very beginning to rack up 18 out points and seven bonus points in the first half. With an all-round

performance from both the defenders and raiding units, India also completed two all outs in the first half. Bangladesh found it difficult to generate sustained momentum against the Indian defence, with just five out points and three bonus points to their name in the opening period. A solitary supertackle provided an additional point, but India's all-round dominance saw them race into a commanding 29-9 lead at half-time.

Mirabai Chanu wins Asian Games silver as Ri breaks weightlifting record



Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 23
North Korean weightlifter Ri Song Gum has broken three world records en route to winning gold in the women's 49kg (108lbs) competition, which saw India's Mirabai Chanu win an elusive Asian Games medal by finishing second.
Ri gave North Korea its first gold of the games in Nagoya, Japan, on Wednesday, joining

an elite club of four weightlifters who have won three Asian Games gold medals. The 28-year-old hauled 94kg above her head in the opening snatch discipline - the first official segment of the competition where athletes lift a barbell from the floor to an overhead position in a single motion. The lift was 1kg heavier than the previous world record of 93kg.

Decomposed male dead body kept for Identification

Asian Games 2026: Indian men's badminton team wins bronze after semi-final loss to China

Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 23
The Indian men's badminton team secured a bronze medal at the Asian Games 2026 after losing 3-1 to the People's Republic of China in the semi-finals in Aichi, Japan, on Wednesday.
Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty registered India's only win of the tie, defeating reigning world champions Liang Weikeng and Wang Chang 21-11, 22-20 in the men's doubles match.
In the opening match, Lakshya Sen went down 21-16, 21-18 to Shi Yuqi. Lakshya made a strong start, but Shi fought back to take the opening game. The Indian shuttler also challenged strongly in the second game, drawing level at 16-16, before the Chinese player closed out the match.

Satwik and Chirag then produced a strong performance against the world No. 3 Chinese pair. The Indian duo dominated the opening game and maintained their composure in the second after Liang and Wang saved two match points to level



the score at 20-20. Satwik and Chirag converted their third match point to win the game and level the tie at 1-1.

Jay Meena wins India's first-ever soft tennis bronze medal at Asian Games

Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 23
Jay Meena secured India's first ever soft tennis medal at the Asian Games, fetching a bronze after losing to Japan's Takuya Kurosaka in the men's singles semifinals on Wednesday.
Playing in his third Asian Games, the 26-year-old Meena produced a spirited fightback after falling three games behind but could not sustain the momentum, losing 2-4 (3-5, 1-4, 1-4, 4-1, 6-4, 1-4) to Kurosaka in the 45-minute clash.

interpretation and opportunities for local livelihoods linked to responsible tourism. The sessions were led by Shri Arun Singh, local bird expert and founder of Andaman Bird Tour, who familiarised the students with the Islands' endemic and other significant bird species and provided practical guidance on ethical birding and responsible wildlife observation. Adding a tourism and community perspective, the President, North & Middle Andaman Chamber of Commerce, shared insights into the scope for community-oriented eco-tourism and nature-based tourism, particularly in North and Middle Andaman. The second day took the learning into the field with a birding expedition to Chidiyatapu and Chidiyatapu Reserve Forest. Students gained hands-on experience in observing and identifying endemic, forest and coastal bird species while understanding the importance of habitat protection and responsible interaction with wildlife.



The workshop was supported by the Department of Tourism, Andaman & Nicobar Administration, as part of the activities being undertaken to mark World Tourism Day 2026, under the theme 'Digital Agenda and Artificial Intelligence to Redesign Tourism.' Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

5. **Power to Relax :-**
Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for the reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Savings:-**
Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Schedule Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
