Govt takes steps to ensure hassle-free arbitration process: PM

Devote this Diwali to soldiers: PM to citizens



New Delhi, Oct 23 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said that the Government has taken several steps to ensure hassle-free arbitration process. Addressing the valedictory address at the first ever Global Conference to strengthen arbitration and enforcement in India in

New Delhi, Shri Modi said, over a 1000 archaic laws have been scrapped and the government has enacted Comprehensive Insolvency Bankruptcy code 2016. He said, the government has implemented National Company Law Tribunals and established a statutory monetary policy

committee. Saying major amendments have been made to Arbitration Conciliation Act, the Prime Minister said, his government has made arbitration process easy, timely and hassle free.

Shri Modi said the government has also enacted Commercial Courts, Commercial Division and Commercial Appellate Division of High Courts Act 2015 for speedy resolution. He said from cause-lists to case-laws, the lawyer's library is now just a click away on your mobile phone. Shri Modi said, an alternate dispute resolution ecosystem is a national priority and India's economic interests can be better served by an effective institutional arbitration system. He said, India is world's fastest growing big economy and is experiencing a digital revolution. He said, this is bridging digital and economic divide in Indian

society. The Prime Minister said there is need to facilitate vibrant eco system for alternative dispute resolution, including arbitration, mediation and conciliation. He said, there is a need to fully harness India's fundamental strengths of democracy, demographic dividend and demand. He said, this can happen only if businesses make long-term investments that create jobs and sustain economic growth. Shri Modi said, Government is enacting Goods and Services Tax law to create an integrated national market and it will further boost domestic demand and create more

New Delhi, Oct 23 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has made an appeal to the citizens to remember country's armed forces on Diwali. In a tweet, Shri Modi urged the citizens to remember the personnel who constantly protect the country. The Prime Minister said, he has sent his message to the jawans and invited everyone to do the same using the Narendra Modi app. He said, the wishes and greetings of the



citizens will certainly make the forces very happy. Since becoming the Prime Minister, Shri Modi has spent both Diwalis with the armed forces.

Five crore LPG connections to BPL families in 3 years: Minister

Amethi, Oct 23 Petroleum Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan said the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojna (PMUY) aims at providing five crore LPG connections to Below Poverty Line households in the country within three years. The Minister yesterday in Amethi said, the ambitious project, launched by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi at Ballia on first of May this year, would transform the lives of women of BPL families by reducing the drudgery of cooking with polluting fuels and go a long way in reducing

indoor pollution and other health hazards. Shri Pradhan said that PMUY aims at replacing the polluting cooking fuels mostly used in rural areas with more clean and efficient LPG. He said, that nearly 90 lakh LPG connections have been released to needy families under the scheme and the 'Pahal Yojna', another scheme initiated by the Petroleum Ministry which has received worldwide acclaim. The scheme directly credits cash into the beneficiaries' account and has put to rest the leakage of LPG subsidies.

INS Viraat sailing for the last time from Kochi



Kochi, Oct 23 After serving the nation for nearly six decades, India's aircraft carrier INS Viraat today sailed out for the very last time from Kochi, for the scheduled decommissioning. The mighty aircraft carrier, which entered into the service after its predecessor INS Vikrant was retired, is being taken to Mumbai for a formal

decommissioning at the end of the year. The Defence Ministry has offered to convert the INS Viraat into the museum with proposals sent to all the coastal states for the purpose. In the run-up to the decommissioning of the world's oldest aircraft carrier, the de-induction ceremony of its aircraft fleet of Sea Harriers was in held in May this year.

**Asian Champions Trophy 2016
India edge Pakistan 3-2 in a
nail-biting encounter**

Kuantan (Malaysia), Oct 23
Top-ranked India had to dig deep into their reserves to eke out a 3-2 victory over arch-rivals and defending champions Pakistan in a preliminary league match of the fourth Asian Champions Trophy hockey on Sunday. India exhibited their composed defence when under pressure from early Pakistan raids and worked hard to gain control of the showpiece encounter of the tournament at the Kuantan Hockey Stadium. Young striker Pradeep Mor scored his maiden goal in 13 international appearances to give India the lead in the 11th minute, but Pakistan then took charge through strikes from Muhammad Rizwan Sr. in the 31st minute and Muhammad Irfan Jr. in the 39th. Rupinder Pal Singh converted India's only penalty corner in the 43rd minute and Ramandeep Singh came into goal-scoring action the following minute by deflecting in a diagonal cross from Talwinder Singh. This victory gives India seven points from three outings. India had outplayed Japan 10-2 in their first outing, but were held to a 1-1 draw by South Korea yesterday. Starting as two-time defending champions, Pakistan suffered a 2-4 loss to hosts Malaysia and then prevailed 1-0 over South Korea in their previous matches of the six-nation league. Top four team from the round-robin competition will advance to the semi-finals. Pakistan forced the



first penalty corner in the opening minute when an Indian defender carried the ball in the circle, but goalkeeper PR Sreejesh blocked two shots to ward off danger. Sreejesh first padded the drag-flick from Muhammad Aleem Bilal and then dived to his right to clear the rebound attempt. Pakistan spelt danger again in the fourth minute when their strikers worked in

time. In the sixth round, Abhijeet won against Migchiel De Jong while in the seventh another victory against compatriot S Niitin followed with relative ease. All this while, Lalith was right besides making it look like a close race in offing between the two. In the sixth round Babu defeated Shyam Sundar while Dutch GM Sipke Ernst proved no match for the Indian in the seventh round.

Barcelona, Oct 23
Lionel Messi squeezed home a stoppage-time penalty to grab a thrilling 3-2 win for champion Barcelona in a controversial La Liga match at Valencia on Saturday. Talisman Messi scored against Valencia for the 10th season in a row to put the visitors

Valencia turned the game around in four second-half minutes, Munir El Haddadi equalising against his parent club and Rodrigo Moreno putting the hosts ahead in the 56th. She was diagnosed with cancer of the abdomen four years ago, and died in hospital in the city of Saitama. Her last ascent was of Mount Fuji in July, alongside high school students affected by the 2011 Japanese earthquake and tsunami.
