'Shaheed Diwas' commemorating the Martyrdom of Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev Thapar and Shivaram Rajguru, great patriots and freedom fighters of our nation was observed in A&N Islands in a befitting manner today. As a mark of respect to the Martyrs' for their supreme sacrifices, the Department of Art & Culture, A&N Administration organized a function in the premises of the National Memorial Cellular Jail coinciding with the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. March 23, is observed as Shaheed Diwas all over the Country to pay homage to the great revolutionary freedom fighters who sacrificed their lives for the country.

The programme began with screening of a video featuring the speech of Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency highlighting the contribution of freedom fighters in India's



freedom struggle which was witnessed by the people present on the occasion. In his speech, the Lt Governor said that on March 23, 1931, the British rulers hanged all the three Freedom Fighters, Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev and Rajguru. This act of the Britishers made the Indian People more anguished and resulted in providing more energy, strength to the freedom movement of our Country. The Lt. Governor further said that the 75th anniversary of

India's Independence is being commemorated as the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' all over the Country. The main aim of this celebration is to instill patriotism among the general public and also to propagate the contribution of martyrs and freedom fighters among the masses. A&N Islands also played a significant role in Our Country's freedom struggle. March 23 is also an occasion to remember the Freedom Fighters who have undergone inhuman tortures during their imprisonment in the Cellular Jail. "I also pay my obeisance

to all the martyrs", the Lt. Governor stated adding that the supreme sacrifices made by the freedom fighters will not only inspire the younger generation but also give a new direction and strength towards nation building.

Thereafter, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain who was the chief guest on the occasion, led the islanders in paying rich tributes to the martyrs. The Chief Secretary lighted the lamp in the corridor of Veer Savarkar's Cell which was followed by the lighting of 75 earthen lamps by the school students in

the corridor of the three blocks of National Memorial Cellular Jail. A one minute silence was also observed as a mark of respect to the martyrs.

This was followed by paying of floral tributes by the Chief Secretary to the portrait of Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev, Rajguru, Veer Savarkar, Barindra Ghosh, Ullahaskar Dutt and Sachindranath Sanyal. Floral tributes were also paid by the Adhyaksha, Zila Parishad, South Andaman, Smt. Pramila Kumari and senior Officers of A&N Administration, A&N Police and others.

Addressing the gathering, the Chief Secretary recalled the significance of the day and the contributions of the heroes of our freedom struggle especially, the revolutionaries like Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev Thapar and Shivaram Rajguru who played a catalytic role in unravelling the British Empire. The Britishers never provided a normal Jail for the revolutionaries but always preferred to hang them till death to crush and dampen their spirits.

Referring to the National Memorial Cellular Jail, the Chief Secretary said it is the 'Holiest Shrine' in Indian Sub-

Port Blair, Mar. 23 During RAT conducted on 43 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 20 passengers, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 52 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. At helipad, 11 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Islands: Andaman and Nicobar Islands have immense tourism potential and in order to exploit it there is a need to develop better aviation facilities such as connectivity with other parts of India and Shri Sharma requested the Minister to award more routes from Andaman & Nicobar Islands under Udaan Scheme to enable Islanders to get air tickets at cheaper rates for their respective destinations.

To provide air subsidy to the Islanders as in the case of North East: The citizens of Andaman and Nicobar Islands have limited connectivity to other States due to its remote location and absence of any other mode of commutation except air and ship travel. In tourist season and due to limited flights there have been instances of extremely high airfare which burden the people including patients, students, businessmen and common Islanders, the Member of Parliament demanded air subsidy to Islanders on the lines of North-East.

To introduce Mini Aircraft: For facilitating better inter-islands travel, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma requested the Minister to start mini aircraft from Port Blair to Diglipur, Port Blair to Car Nicobar and Port Blair to Campbell Bay and vice versa for the convenience of the Islanders and also to promote tourism.

To provide air Ambulance for the Islanders: Andaman and Nicobar Islands being an archipelago has limited medical facilities and therefore the need of the hour is to start air ambulance facilities for critically ill patients in different Islands who are referred to Port Blair for treatment.

Immediately start International flights to South-East countries: The Member of Parliament requested the Government to start international flights from Port Blair to South East Asian countries like Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, Maldives and Mauritius due to proximity with these nations under the International UDAN scheme. The operationalization of these flights will promote and boost the tourism industry in the Islands and act as a catalyst in the economic development of Andaman & Nicobar Islands which has been adversely affected due to COVID-19.

Direct Flights to Madurai, Kochi & Ranchi from Port Blair: Andaman and Nicobar Islands have a heterogeneous population including Tamil, Malayalam and North Indian population. In order to provide better connectivity, the Member of Parliament requested that direct flights from Port Blair to Madurai, Port Blair to Kochi and Port Blair to Ranchi be started.

Start Night flight from Port Blair: The Member of Parliament, ANI requested that for the benefit of the Islanders and to promote tourism, night flights be started from Port Blair to other parts of the country.

To introduce Seaplanes: Shri Sharma demanded the introduction of seaplanes for the promotion of tourism and also to benefit the Islanders, a press release from MP Office said.

The GST, as applicable shall be charged extra. The Concerned Agency / Firm availing the services of Dry Docks/ Slipways should comply with the following Terms & Conditions:

- The Dry Dock/Slipway slot shall be allotted to Govt./ Private Agencies for a specified period only and extension of slot shall not be considered at any cost. If the allotted slot could not be utilized for completion of repair work, the vessel would have to vacate the Dry Dock/Slipway as per the Vacation Notice issued by this Directorate and the vessel shall be un-docked on 'as is where is' condition at the cost and risk of the Agency.
- In case the Agency so desires, they may apply afresh for the next slot to complete the remaining work. The same shall be considered based on the availability of spare slot and as per priority in the list of vessels awaiting Dry Dock/ Slipway allocation.
- In the event of requirement of Dry Dock/ Slipway on an emergent basis, the Directorate shall consider such allotment out of turn for which the Agency has to raise requirements with proper justification.
- The Dry Dock/ Slipway allotment to the other Govt./ Private Agencies will be subject to payment of advance Dry-docking/ Slipping charges as prescribed by the A&N Administration, as applicable on date.
- In case of any delay in Un-docking/ Un-slipping, per day charges of Docking/ Slipping will be twice the normal charges.
- An amount of Rs. 50,000/- (or as applicable as on date) shall be deposited by the user Agency in advance as security to ensure that the Dry-Dock/ Slipway is cleaned by the Agency after its use. The security deposit shall be returned after satisfactory cleaning up of dust, garbage and scrap metal generated during the repair of the vessel.
- The department shall charge Rs. 5,799/- per hour plus applicable GST for providing the services of mobile crane and Rs. 1,697/- per ton plus applicable GST (as applicable on date) for providing electric connections for Hot Work.
- In case the booking of Dry-Dock/ Slipway is cancelled without 48 hours advance notice, 50% of the Dry-Dock/ Slipway charges will be deducted from the advance deposit.
- If a vessel heels over to one side or the other at the time of Docking/ Undocking, contrary to the declaration made in the Tank declaration by the Master of the vessel, an additional charge of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) (to be revised annually) will be levied for correcting the same.
