



## DMs of all three Districts of A&N Islands issue orders to prevent spread of COVID-19

- ❑ Parks/playground/stadiums/swimming pool, Sports events temporary closed for 4 weeks
- ❑ Public transport to ply at 50% seating capacity ❑ Auto/taxi to ply with max. 2 passengers
- ❑ Social functions and other congregations shall not be permitted ❑ Compulsory home quarantine for 7 days irrespective of being tested negative ❑ All establishments shall ensure strict adherence to COVID-19 Protocols

Port Blair, April 23

In pursuance of powers vested u/s 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in order to enforce strict compliance of the National Directives on COVID-19 in South Andaman North & Middle Andaman & Nicobar Districts and to prevent the further spread of infections, the District Magistrates of all three Districts has ordered that public transport/buses shall be allowed to ply at the maximum 50% seating capacity and any person/owner violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.5,000/-.

Similarly, auto/taxi shall be allowed to ply with maximum 2 passengers and any person/owner violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.5,000/-.

The Orders further states that social/academic/sports/entertainment/cultural/festivals/political functions and other

congregations shall not be permitted in South Andaman & Nicobar Districts. All parks/play grounds/stadiums/swimming pools/sports events shall be temporarily closed for 4 weeks in South Andaman & Nicobar Districts. All incoming passengers from mainland to Port Blair and from Port Blair to other two Districts have to undergo compulsory home quarantine for 7 days irrespective of being tested negative. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.5,000/- each time.

situation arising due to spreading of the corona virus. He said despite the repeated request to the citizens to limit their movement, overcrowding is continuing in market places which, is a matter of great concern. Mentioning the areas where violations are commonly noticed viz. Bathubasti, Garacharma, Aberdeen Bazaar, Junglighat, Ratnam Market, Mohanpura etc. the Secretary said, monitoring and challans has been intensified further in these places and strict action will be taken against the customers and the shop owners. He said that all the business activities are kept open so that the people do not suffer and the livelihood issues are not hindered. If the people are not willing to abide by the COVID protocols, then the Administration has to rethink for some stringent measures. He further disclosed that 8 flight passengers were tested positive when the Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) was done at ITF Ground on their arrival at Port Blair. He once again reiterated the need to strictly adhere to COVID-19 protocol and urged the people to come together to confront & defeat COVID-19.

The Secretary said that the vaccination drive is continuing and efforts are on to cover all the eligible persons above 45 plus age. Regarding availability of Oxygen, the Secretary said, we are in a comfortable position and the suppliers have been directed to keep the oxygen supply for medical purpose only. The Director (ANIIMS), Dr. A.K. Mandal, Deputy Director (Malaria), GB Pant Hospital, Shri Amitabha De also addressed the media and replied to the queries raised by them.

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar and Deputy Director, Shri RS Meena also attended the press conference.

All passengers proceeding to Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep and Little Andaman shall invariably undergo 10 days mandatory home quarantine irrespective of being tested negative. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.5,000/- each time. Marriage related gathering with a ceiling of guests not exceeding 50 persons and funeral/last rites related gatherings with number of persons not exceeding 20 shall be permitted. Any person/ organization violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.10,000/-.

All establishments shall ensure strict adherence of COVID-19 appropriate behaviours like wearing of masks and maintenance of social distancing/2 Gaz Ki Doori. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/in-charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance, failing which addition to criminal proceedings, the shops/business establishment shall be sealed for 14 days by the Executive Magistrate. Home delivery of medicines/grocery items shall be promoted.

Weekend (Saturday & Sunday) convoys in the Andaman Trunk movement to N&M Andaman District stands suspended till further orders, except for emergency cases. No tribal passes will be issued for Southern group of Islands till further orders except for official purposes. Movement on ATR as per convoy norms from North & Middle Andaman to South Andaman will be permitted only from Monday to Friday (05 days). On the weekend (Saturday), only essential commodities vehicles will be allowed to undertake the return journey.

All Sub-Divisional Magistrates, Executive Magistrates, Revenue officials of the rank of Patwari and above, Sanitary Inspectors of the PBMC, Panchayat Secretaries of the RD Department, Food Safety Officers, GST Tax Inspectors and police personnel of the rank of the constable and above have been authorised to impose and collect fines as mentioned above. However, this does not bar any other legal action that may be attracted due to violation of any other Act/Law/Rule in force.

The orders issued by all three District Magistrates shall come into effect from 24th April, 2021 and shall remain in force till further orders.

% of the actual strength shall be present at any given time, to avoid overcrowding in offices as indicated i.e. 8 am to 4 pm, 9 am to 5 pm and 10 am to 6 pm. The emergency staff/operational staff performing specific/ essential duties shall attend office on the timings fixed by their concerned HoDs/HOOs.

All officials of the Office Superintendent/Section In-charge and above are to attend office on regular basis. Physical attendance of the office staff of the level of HOO or equivalent and below to be restricted to 50% of the actual strength. Secretary/HOD may regulate the attendance of officials and may, on administrative grounds, direct more officials to attend office. A roster may be prepared accordingly. All officials who do not attend office on a particular day are to make themselves available on telephone and other electronic means of communication at all times from their residence and work from home.

All officials residing in containment zones shall continue to be exempted from coming to office till the containment zone is de-notified.

Persons with disabilities and pregnant women employees may be exempted from attending office but they shall continue to work from home until further orders.

All officials who attend office shall strictly follow COVID appropriate behavior including wearing of mask, physical distancing, use of sanitizer and frequent hand washing with soap and water. Biometric attendance shall continue to be suspended and physical attendance registers to be maintained until further orders. Crowding in lifts, staircases, corridors common areas including refreshment kiosk and parking areas is to be strictly avoided. Meetings as far as possible to be conducted through video conferencing. Entry of outsiders/visitors to be curtailed appropriately, an Order to this effect issued by Secretary (Perl) said.

**UTPCR member inspects coaching institutes**

Smti. Sampa Banerjee, Member, UT Commission for Protection of Child Rights (UTCPCR) along with the staff of UT Commission for Protection of Child Rights inspected Akash Institute, Junglighat & Equalsign Coaching Centre, Middle Point to ascertain on ground compliance regarding care, protection and COVID safety modalities followed by the institutions for the students. During the inspection few negligence regarding the protocol of COVID -19 were found. In this regard, Smti. Sampa Banerjee, as a Member of UTCPCR has suggested few precautions of COVID-19 to protect themselves from infection, a press release from UTCPCR said.

**ICG apprehends Myanmar fishing boat with 6 crew for poaching in Indian EEZ**

Port Blair, April 23

In a swift operation, the Indian Coast Guard yesterday apprehended one Myanmar fishing boat with 6 poachers illegally fishing in Indian waters, approx 5 NM North West of Narcondam Islands. The boat was first sighted by Indian Coast Guard Ship Rajkamal on patrol off Narcondam. The boat did not respond to VHF calls by ICG Ship and tried to evade by increasing speed and random course alternations. However, the Coast Guard Ship successfully intercepted the vessel along with its crew. On boarding by ICG team, the boat was found to be of Myanmar Origin having 6 crew onboard. The boat was engaged in illegal fishing in the Indian Exclusive Economic Zone. The boat and crew were escorted to Port Blair and were handed over to A&N police on April 23 for further investigations. The Coast Guard PRO added that despite challenges posed by COVID-19 pandemic, Coast Guard ships and aircraft are on patrol 24 x7, monitoring activities in the Indian EEZ and protecting the sovereign rights of our country within the Maritime Zones, a press release from PRO Coast Guard said.

found satisfactory. The overall number of beds in Hospital/CCC have also been increased from 177 to 258.

A total of 29,988 persons have been administered COVID vaccine in the district. Special vaccination camps are being conducted to facilitate people of remotest areas. Bed-ridden and disabled persons are also being vaccinated at their homes under medical supervision.

Further, to prevent spread of virus from incoming people SOPs have been issued for movement of cargo vehicles and for general public seven days mandatory home quarantine provision has been made. Restrictions on all kinds of gatherings and strict enforcement of National Directives of COVID-19 management is being followed.

Control Rooms have been set up in all the three tehsils which will function 24/7. The contact numbers are: District Control Room, Mayabunder-03192-273011/262923, EOC Rangat-03192-274111 and Control Room, Diglipur-03192-272260. Provisions have been made for home delivery of medicines as well as pensions like old age, widow, destitute, disability etc. The District Administration is also regularly monitoring and ensuring that there is no shortage of any essential commodity in the district from the newly introduced restrictions and movement, a press release from DC (N&M) said.

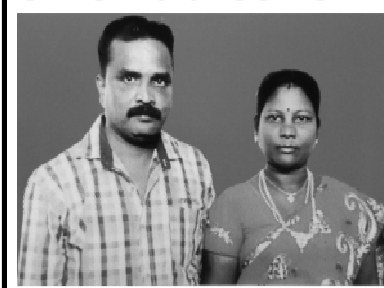

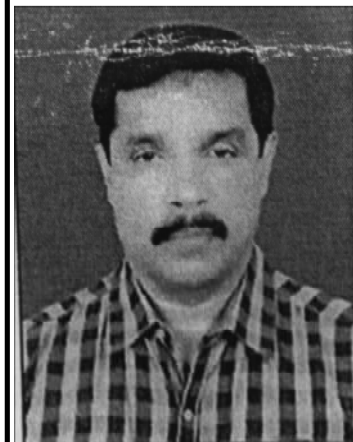
