Vice-President addresses Student Interaction Meet at MNIT, Jaipur

Think critically & analyse matters factually; do not be doctored and compartmentalised by others, Vice-President tells young minds

Young people should dominate social media with positive, growth-oriented ideas: VP

New Delhi, June 23 (PIB)

The Vice-President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today cautioned young minds against being doctored and compartmentalised by others. He also called upon the teaching fraternity to rise to the occasion to 'antidote and neutralise anti-national forces' in view of the highly impactful voice that they have in the wider social space. The Vice-President was addressing students and faculty members at the Student Interaction Meet and Educationists Interaction Meet: National Education Policy 2020, at the Malaviya National Institute of Technology in Jaipur today.

Emphasizing that no citizen is above the law, the Vice-President expressed his concern at people taking to the streets when served a notice for contravention of law,



rather than taking recourse to a legal route. "We can't claim to be a society governed by law if someone is above the law or has immunity from law. I am not a stakeholder with politics but I am concerned with the rule of law and societal growth," he

explained. Highlighting that India "is on the rise as never before", the Vice-President emphasized that the country's incremental trajectory will be further accelerated by the contributions of young people. "These are not the

times when India has to give out its opinion to the world. Times have changed; the world is looking at India," he said. It is important for citizens to believe in the nation and take pride in India's achievements, he further added.

Lauding India's internet penetration and drawing attention to the country's 700 million internet users, the Vice-President underlined the self-sufficiency of Indians in terms of acquiring skills. "We Indians have a strong DNA. We are like Ekalavya-even without any formal training, a citizen in rural India is capable of teaching himself what is required simply through his smartphone," he said.

Noting the significant role played by young people in the domain of startups and unicorns

New Delhi, June 23 The Bureau of Indian Standards has published - Food Serving Utensils Made from Agri By-Products - Specification, aimed at reducing plastic pollution and promoting sustainability. The standard provides comprehensive guidelines to manufacturers and consumers, ensuring uniformity in quality requirements across the

country. Consumer Affairs Ministry said, the implementation of this standard has extensive advantages as using biodegradable agri by-product utensils can contribute towards environmental safety, conserve natural resources, and promote a circular economy. These utensils are free from harmful additives and ensure consumer well-being. The standard also

creates economic opportunities for farmers and supports sustainable agricultural practices, contributing to rural development.

The rising use of disposable tableware worldwide is driving the global market for disposable tableware. The disposable plate market size was valued at 4.26 Billion dollars in 2020 and is projected to reach

PBMC to collect user charges for door to door collection of waste under SWM Rules-2016

Appeals residents, property owners & establishments to cooperate to enable the Council to provide better SWM services

Port Blair, June 23

The general public have been informed that all households and establishments under the jurisdiction of Port Blair city have to pay a user fee every month towards the waste picked up from their door step. The user charges shall be

collected as per the Schedule-III of PBMC's SWM Bye-laws, 2017 notified by the A&N Administration Gazette vide No. 21/2017/F.No. 3-53/2015-UD-II, dated 16th February, 2017.

For households the rate of user fee is Rs. 50/-, whereas for the commercial and other

establishments, it can go up depending upon the quantity of waste they generate. The user charges for street vendors is Rs. 20/- per day, which shall be paid monthly to avoid unnecessary daily approach for payment and keeping the view of 'Ease of doing business'.

Annual Audit reports, Details of PAN of the Society, Bank Account No. of the Society, list of the present office bearers as well as other members of the society with their address, Aadhaar No., Phone No. and e-mail ID if any to the District Office within 30 days. Further, it is also informed

that all societies registered with Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman) Office should mandatorily enroll the society in the NGO portal at <http://www.ngodarpan.gov.in> created by Gol and submit a confirmation to this effect within 30 days. Non compliance may result in action as per law against the society, a press release from DC (SA) said.

This will be in addition to the Conservancy Tax collected along with the Property Tax every year. The Conservancy Tax is applicable on every individual utilizing the public footpath and roads maintained by Municipal Council. Whereas, the user charges are to be collected from each household for door to door collection of waste specified under SWM Rules-2016 notified by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change vide S.O. 1357 (E), dated 08th April, 2016 and consequent PBMC's SWM Bye-laws-2017 notified by the A&N Administration.

The user fee will be collected in person or through online payment by PBMC or through CSCs. A surcharge of 5% per month shall be charged if waste generators fail to pay the amount within 3 months.

In this regard, PBMC has appealed to all the residents, property owners and establishments to cooperate whole heartedly to enable the Municipal Council to provide better SWM services.
